

ArcelorMittal to respond to SACYD memorandum

Thabazimbi – Management of ArcelorMittal South Africa has undertaken to respond to a memorandum they received from South African Children and Youth Development (SACYD) members who staged a protest at Thabazimbi Mine on Tuesday 3 March.

According to a SACYD press release dated 4 March the organisation organised the protest to the ArcelorMittal Thabazimbi Mine following fruitless engagements predominantly on the issues of employment, business and infrastructure.

The protest addressed, amongst others, the following issues:

- Local beneficiation in the beneficiary project of the mine
- Social labour plan documents that should be made available to the public
- Termination of lease agreements of Kambaku Private School and Advanced College
- Iscor community hall
- Fronting on tenders and projects
- Bursaries, internships and learnerships
- Transparency of the procurement department of the mine
- Property of the mine
- Tourism
- Mining forum

In a statement, ArcelorMittal said: “ArcelorMittal South Africa can confirm that management at the Thabazimbi Iron Ore Mine (Pty) Ltd (a wholly-owned subsidiary of ArcelorMittal South Africa) received a memorandum from representatives of SACYD, a community-based organisation in the Thabazimbi area. “Mine management, together with members of management from ArcelorMittal South Africa, are reviewing the memorandum and will respond accordingly.”

During the process leading up to their takeover of Thabazimbi Mine in 2018, ArcelorMittal engaged extensively with community members and gave them a platform to express their views regarding employment and other issues such as the procurement of services.

ArcelorMittal continues to prioritise this open-door approach in their relations with host communities.

DAGGA-CULTIVATOR ARRESTED

The dagga plants were discovered at the man's home.

Police seized the plants.

The dagga plants are worth an estimated R3 000.

A total of 36 plants were discovered.

Thabazimbi – A 42-year old man appeared in the Bela-Bela Magistrates’ Court on a charge of illegal cultivation of dagga plants. The man was arrested on Thursday 27 February by police, who had discovered 36 dagga plants at his home in Hlalampya informal settlement. Police from the crime intelligence and visible policing

units followed up information about the existence of these plants,” police spokesperson brigadier Motlafela Mojapelo explained. “On arrival at the premises, dagga plants with an estimated street value of R3000 were discovered. The suspect was apprehended on the spot,” Mojapelo added.
