PRICE OF CIGARETTES TO INCREASE AFTER R1.4 MILLION ILLEGAL CIGARETTES SEIZED

Polokwane – Every time there is a huge bust in cigarettes, the local price of black-market cigarettes increase. Illicit cigarettes estimated at R1.4 million were seized by police in Musina on Friday 15 May during an operation also involving personnel from the South African National Defence Force (SANDF).

The suspects transporting the cigarettes managed to evade arrest after they abandoned their vehicles and fled in various directions just as they were about to be surrounded by the police. If caught I am sure the smokers of South Africa would line up to pay for their legal fees.

Police spokesperson brigadier Motlafela Mojapelo said a roadblock was set up on the day in question after information about the suspects and their illegal activities had been received by law enforcement agents - some would call mpimpis. He said four vehicles used by the suspects to transport the cigarettes – a Mazda sedan, a Nissan paddle van, a Toyota Quantum and a Chrysler SUV – were spotted travelling from Tshipise along the N1 highway.

“The driver of the Nissan refused to stop and turned into the nearby gravel road. A chase ensued which lead to the driver losing control of the vehicle, hitting a fence. The suspects got out and ran into the nearby bushes,” Mojapelo explained. “The driver of the Toyota Quantum also failed to stop. Instead, the driver and a passenger he was travelling with jumped out of the moving vehicle and managed to escape. The suspects inside the Mazda and that of the fourth vehicle also escaped after abandoning the cars they were travelling in.”

Police searched three of the vehicles and discovered boxes containing cartons of illicit cigarettes worth R1,454,428.

Although no cigarettes were found in the Chrysler, police suspect the car was stolen. Wow, all of this and the fact that everybody that smokes are still smoking, just less healthy cigarettes, and at inflated prices. Yet Dlamini-Zuma stands by her decision that the legal sale of tobacco products must be banned.

MAN CAUGHT WITH FAKE MONEY AND ILLICIT DRUGS

Modimolle – A 24-year old man was arrested by police in Modimolle on Wednesday 29 April for failing to pay for the diesel he acquired from a local filling station in the area.

Lenn Roy Jofner was nabbed while attempting to purchase tyres at a Supa Quick outlet in Modimolle. Police searched his vehicle and found him in the possession of fake diamonds, counterfeit R200 notes, jewellery and crystal meth.

Jofner appeared before the Modimolle Magistrates' Court to answer to charges of fraud, theft, possession of counterfeit money, drug trafficking, possession of suspected stolen property, and forgery.

“The police launched a manhunt for the alleged fraudster after a case was opened by a filling station on 28 April,” police spokesperson brigadier Motlafela Mojapelo said. “Preliminary investigations indicated that the suspect is linked to similar cases that were committed the previous month in the Vaalwater and Laersdrift policing areas.”

He urged anyone who might have been scammed by the suspect to come forward with information that could assist police investigations.

2 CHRONICLES 20

¹It happened after this that the people of Moab with the people of Ammon, and others with them besides the Ammonites, came to battle against Jehoshaphat. ² Then some came and told Jehoshaphat, saying, “A great multitude is coming against you from beyond the sea, from Syria; and they are in Hazazon Tamar” (which is En Gedi). ³ And Jehoshaphat feared, and set himself to seek the LORD, and proclaimed a fast throughout all Judah. ⁴ So Judah gathered together to ask help from the LORD; and from all the cities of Judah they came to seek the LORD.

⁵ Then Jehoshaphat stood in the assembly of Judah and Jerusalem, in the house of the LORD, before the new court, ⁶ and said: “O LORD God of our fathers, are You not God in heaven, and do You not rule over all the kingdoms of the nations, and in Your hand is there not power and might, so that no one is able to withstand You? ⁷ Are You not our God, who drove out the inhabitants of this land before Your people Israel, and gave it to the descendants of Abraham Your friend forever? ⁸ And they dwell in it, and have built You a sanctuary in it for Your name,

saying, ⁹ ‘If disaster comes upon us—sword, judgment, pestilence, or famine—we will stand before this temple and in Your presence (for Your name is in this temple), and cry out to You in our affliction, and You will hear and save.’ ¹⁰ And now, here are the people of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir—whom You would not let Israel invade when they came out of the land of Egypt, but they turned from them and did not destroy them— ¹¹ here they are, rewarding us by coming to throw us out of Your possession which You have given us to inherit. ¹² O our God, will You not judge them? For we have no power against this great multitude that is coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are upon You.”

¹³ Now all Judah, with their little ones, their wives, and their children, stood before the LORD.

¹⁴ Then the Spirit of the LORD came upon Jahaziel the son of Zechariah, the son of Benaiah, the son of Jeiel, the son of Mattaniah, a Levite of the sons of Asaph, in the midst of the assembly. ¹⁵ And he said, “Listen, all you of Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem, and you, King Jehoshaphat! Thus says the LORD to you: ‘Do not be afraid nor dismayed because of this great multitude, for the battle is not yours, but God’s.’

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
