IN FIRST HALF OF 2020

South Africa – Rhino poaching has decreased by almost 53% in the first six months of 2020, with 166 animals being killed for their horns across the country since the beginning of the year. During the first six months of 2019, 316 rhino had been poached in South Africa.

"After a decade of implementing various strategies and campaigning against ever increasing rhino poaching by local poachers recruited and managed by crime syndicates, efforts are paying off," said the minister of Environment, Forestry and Fisheries, Barbara Creecy. "We have been able to arrest the escalation of rhino losses."

The minister said with the COVID-19 associated countrywide law enforcement measures to restrict movement, the decline in rhino poaching compared to the same period last year is striking. This reprieve was specifically welcome in the Kruger National Park where during April, no rhino were killed in the intensive protection zone for the first time in almost ten years.

Between the start of the lockdown on 27 March 2020 until the end of June 2020, 46 rhino were poached

across the country. As the lockdown restrictions have gradually been lifted, so the rhino poaching incidents have slowly increased.

Despite attempts to smuggle rhino horn valued at around R115 million through OR Tambo International Airport in the first two weeks of July 2020, the decrease in rhino poaching can also be attributed to the disruption of the supply chain resulting from the national travel restrictions, including limitations placed on movement across the country.

In celebration of World Ranger Day, the minister paid tribute to the men and women whose commitment to protecting the country's natural heritage, sometimes at the expense of their own safety. "Our rangers have remained at the forefront of the battle against poaching, despite the national lockdown, contributing to the decrease in poaching. In this time, rangers have had to face not only the threats posed by poachers, but they, and their families, have also had to deal with the danger of contracting COVID-19."

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KIDNAPPED BABY RESCUED, SUSPECT IN COURT

Brits – A 53-year old woman accused of kidnapping a six-week-old baby appeared before the Brits Magistrates’ Court on Wednesday 5 August.

The suspect, Joyce Seobisa, will make another court appearance on Wednesday 28 October after the case was postponed. The baby was allegedly kidnapped from her mother, Suzan Kutumela, on Monday 20 July at Shoprite Centre in Brits.

Kutumela left the baby with Seobisa and went inside the centre to buy food. Kutumela could not locate Seobisa upon her return

and reported the matter to the police. Seobisa was arrested by the Brits Family Violence, Child Protection and Sexual Offences (FCS) unit on Tuesday 4 August. This was after the father of the baby was alerted to the whereabouts by an anonymous caller. “He immediately alerted the police who acted swiftly and made a follow-up on the information. On arrival at a residence in Oukasie outside Brits, the police found the baby and called the parents for identification,” police spokesperson Maria Nkabinde said. 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OFFICER KNOCKED DOWN BY RECKLESS DRIVER

Brits – The North West provincial member of executive council (MEC) for the Department of Community Safety and Transport Management, Sello Lehari, lauded the brave traffic cop who was knocked down on duty in Oukasie, Brits on Monday 27 July.

Provincial inspector Tshepang Masike pulled off a vehicle which motion suggested that the driver was about to stop. But as the 22-year-old female officer approached the vehicle, the driver suddenly sped off and in the process bumped the traffic officer pushing her to the side walkway.

The officer was immediately rushed to Mediclinic Brits where medical observation and X-rays were conducted on her. She was fortunate to be discharged after sustaining only minor injuries. She returned to work on 31 July.

MEC Sello Lehari appealed to motorists to be

respectful towards traffic officers as well as to cooperate with law enforcement officers in general. A case of reckless and negligent driving was opened and is being investigated by the Brits police station.

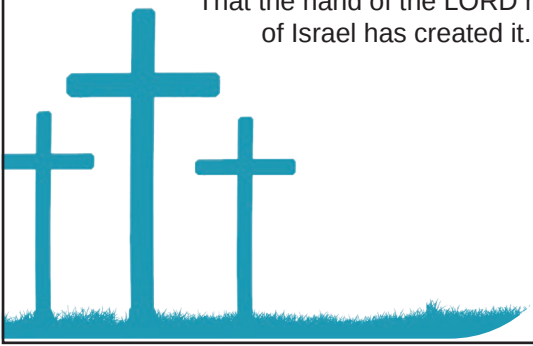

FARM ATTACKER ARRESTED SIX YEARS AFTER THE BRUTAL MURDER

Thabazimbi – On Friday 31 July 2020, the sixth anniversary of the brutal murder of Christine Robinson, her suspected killer was finally arrested.

Christine was a British national living on a farm near Thabazimbi when she was attacked and murdered on 31 July 2014. She was stabbed several times before the murderer cut her throat. A 30-year old employee was suspected of the murder.

Ian Cameron, who was head of AfriForum community safety and the original investigating officer at the time, colonel Sakkie Louwrens who retired and is now part of Bosveld Misdaad Ondersoeke, visited the murder scene of Christine shortly after it happened in 2014. Ian never gave up his pursuit to find the man who killed Christine and decided to share a photo of the suspect on social media. According to Ian, a member of the public contacted him and informed him that they recognised the attacker.

Further investigations indicated that he was currently residing in Johannesburg.

Ian relayed this information to Sakkie and the relevant members of the South African Police Service in Garsfontein. The suspected attacker was subsequently arrested and is currently in police custody. “This violent attack in the Thabazimbi area was one of a few that went unsolved for the past few years. We are relieved that Christine's suspected killer is finally behind bars,” said Sakkie.

Hy was 22 jaar betrokke by die Thabazimbi Landbou en Nywerheid Skou waar hy meeste jare op die komitee as vise-voorsitter gedien het. Sy kennis en insig met elke beesras en telers was fenomenaal. Hy was ook kundig by die saai boere. Dis ook nie waar dit geëindig het nie. Johan kon ‘n groot verskeidenheid industriële, nywerheid asook landbou uitstallers kry om hulle goedere te kom uitstal tydens die skou. Dit was sy passie. Johan was ‘n groot legende by die skou en sy mede-komiteelede het hom as ‘skou familie’ beskou.

Hy het verseker diep spore by die skou en in die gemeenskap getrap. Hy was baie lief vir praat en grappies maak en was baie betrokke by sy kerk en die ouetehuis.

Johan is ‘n klompie jare gelede met velkanker in die gesig gediagnoseer. Dokters het ongeveer vier jaar gelede ‘n melanoom verwyder. Ongelukkig is sy oog beskadig en het verdere verspreiding plaasgevind. Ten spyte daarvan het Johan so normaal moontlik aangegaan met die lewe.

Die merkwaardige man sal altyd onthou word, op sy gelukkigste met die mikrofoon in sy hand tydens die Thabazimbi Skou.

FARM ATTACKERS ARRESTED

Polokwane – Police in Limpopo have arrested three suspects in connection with house robbery and rape incidents which occurred on a farm in the Dendron area. It is alleged that on Wednesday 5 August, the three suspects brutally assaulted a 62-year old farmer and his 58-year old wife. They proceeded to rob the couple of their rifles, a Nissan Navara bakkie and a plasma television. It is also alleged that they raped the woman before they fled the scene.

Acting on information received about the whereabouts of the suspects, police spotted the white vehicle on Matlala and a car chase ensued.

“Police cornered two of the suspects on the N1 road south of Polokwane and apprehended them. The third suspect, who fled on foot, was later shot and injured after he attempted to shoot at the police,” police spokesperson brigadier Mottafela Mojapelo explained. “He was taken to hospital and admitted under police guard.” During the arrest, the police recovered two rifles, a television set, a two-way radio and the white Nissan bakkie. The suspects were also found in possession of five pistols.

The suspects are all set to appear before the Mogwadi Periodical Court on charges of house robbery and rape.

They will also appear before the Polokwane Magistrates’ Court on charges of possession of unlicensed firearms and ammunition as well as possession of stolen property.

Provincial commissioner of police in Limpopo lieutenant general Nneke Ledwaba commended Highway Patrol members for the arrests.

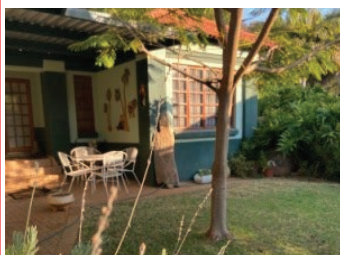
