– The Thabazimbi community took a stand against farm murders when the man suspected of killing Christine Robinson appeared before the Thabazimbi Magistrates' Court on Thursday 13 August. The matter was postponed until 29 October.

Christine was a British national living on a farm near Thabazimbi when she was attacked and murdered on 31 July 2014. She was stabbed several times before the murderer cut her throat.

The 30-year old employee who is suspected of the murder was finally arrested on 31 July 2020 on the sixth anniversary of the brutal murder.

During the court appearance, the community drove around the courthouse displaying signs and honking their hooters.

Enough is enough and they refuse to stay silent on the matter while farmers, farmworkers and landowners fall victim to these senseless, and violent attacks.

PLANNED BLASTING WORKS ON BAKWENA N4 ROUTE

Brits – Bakwena Platinum Corridor Concessionaire (Pty) Ltd, (Bakwena's), current upgrades include the addition of a 32km of a second carriageway on the N4 between the M17 and R512 (Brits interchange), with an expected completion date of June 2021.

Raubex, the construction contractor undertaking the upgrade on the N4 has encountered large rocks/boulders in the area between the R511 and R512 on the N4 which have proved challenging to remove. As a result, a series of blasting activities has been planned for Wednesdays and some Saturdays to remove the rock so that they can proceed with the construction of the eastern carriageway.

The blasting is planned to take place on 5, 8, 12, 19, 22 and 26 August between 14:00 and 16:00. During these

dates and times, the N4 will be closed for 15 minutes at a time to ensure the safety of road users in both directions. Traffic travelling westwards on the N4 will be stopped underneath or just east of the R511/N4 interchange. Traffic on the R511 that intends to travel westward will be redirected and the on-ramp on the westbound carriageway will be closed. Traffic travelling eastbound on the N4 will be stopped 14km after the R512.

Bakwena's commercial manager, Solomon Kganyago, says the safety of motorists using the N1N4 route is a priority to them and they would like to thank the motoring public for their patience whilst they undertake these blasts, so that Raubex can continue with the current 32km second carriageway upgrade which will not only improve motorists' safety on the

route but also enhance their driving experience, concludes Kganyago.

2019/2020 CRIME STATISTICS RELEASED

Limpopo – The national crime statistics for 2019/20 have been published. This was done ahead of the usual date in September, as the South Africa Police Service (SAPS) plans to release the statistics every quarter going forward.

There has been a decrease in contact related crimes, property-related crimes and other serious crimes. However, murders remain high with a 1.4% increase and sexual offences have increased with 1.7%. During 2019/2020, a staggering 21,325 murders were reported, indicating that around 58 people are murdered in the country every day. This shows an increase of 303 cases compared to the 21,022 in 2018/2019.

In his address on Friday 31 July, police minister general Bheki Cele said: "In contact crimes, particularly murder, we have recorded a trend of halving the case increase in the past three years. In 2017/18 the case difference was 1,320. In 2018/19 the case difference was 686. In 2019/20 we have recorded a case difference of 303."

Sexual offences have become a growing concern in all communities. A total of 53,293 sexual offence cases were reported in 2019/2020. "This category of crime has terrorised most households and communities as most of these crimes happen behind closed doors," Cele added.

He also noted that it is troubling that educational institutions are becoming hotbeds for sexual violence, 380 cases of rape were reported at either schools, universities, colleges, or day-care facilities.

In Limpopo, there has been a decrease of 3.5% with regards to murder cases. In 2019/2020, 882 murder cases were reported compared to the 914 in 2018/2019. Sexual offences decreased with 1,7% with a total of 3,990 reported cases compared to the 4,060 of the previous year.
