WHO LEAKED THE MATHS EXAM?

South Africa – The Department of Basic Education (DBE) said they will leave no stone unturned in their investigations to establish how a matric mathematics examination paper was leaked. The department became aware of the leak a few hours before learners were due to sit for the final examination on Monday 16 November. “The origins of the leak are not yet clear but the matric candidates who had access to the question paper appear to be located in the Limpopo and Gauteng provinces,” the DBE said in a statement. “The department verified the content of the question paper and found it to be the same as the one that was to be written at 09:00 am.”

Umalusi, the council for quality assurance in general and further education and training, and the DBE are investigating the matter to determine whether a rewrite is necessary. Preliminary findings indicate that the leak could be confined to a few learners from the Limpopo and Gauteng provinces.

“The department will enlist the support of the law enforcement agencies to assist with the investigation... An appeal is made to all candidates to remain focused on the examination papers and be assured that the culprits that are at the centre of this despicable act will be dealt with harshly. The department remains committed to ensuring the credibility and integrity of this important public examination,” the statement concluded.




Moruleng – Responding to President Cyril Ramaphosa’s call for private partners to address the challenges of water and sanitation at schools and improve access to quality primary health care, Siyanda Bakgatla Platinum Mine (SBPM) invested more than 15 million in the community to do just that. As part of the investment plan SBPM handed over four schools ablution facilities and two clinics as well as medical equipment on Friday 6 November.

During a prestigious ceremony, one of the facilities which was handed over, by SBPM Executive Head of Sustainable Development Hope Tyira, was Nkonong Secondary School. THREE ARRESTS AFTER HIGH-SPEED CHASE

Bela-Bela – Three men allegedly stole cell phones and an undisclosed amount of cash from a retail store in Bela-Bela on Monday 2 November. The police chased after them at high-speed and one of the suspects were injured in a shootout. The suspects were arrested along the R511 moments after committing the crime.

The police were notified of the robbery and swiftly responded. On arrival, members of the community provided valuable information about the description of the getaway vehicle and the direction it took," police spokesperson colonel Moatshe Ngoepe said. "Subsequently, the police in North West spotted the vehicle travelling along the R511 heading towards Brits and a car chase ensued with the assistance of a private security company.

The suspects started to fire numerous shots at the police who retaliated, and one suspect was shot during the shootout." Along with the arrests, the police recovered one firearm and five rounds of live ammunition, one toy gun, an undisclosed amount of cash as well as cell phones which are believed to have been stolen from the store in Bela-Bela.

MUNICIPALITY REPORTS BACK TO COMMUNITY

Northam – Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) officials held a public participation consultation meeting on the Integrated Development Plan (IDP) in Northam, ward 8, on Thursday 12 November. The main purpose was to consult with communities on service delivery related issues.

Many residents attended and requested feedback from the TLM on complaints previously raised on service delivery.

The TLM reported as follows:

- The clearing of illegal dumping sites and maintenance of landfill sites has started.
- They are investigating the provision of WiFi.
- The sports ground is being upgraded and security improved.
- Vehicles for traffic police officers will be purchased as funds become available.
- Repairing potholes, constructing speed humps, and attending to road safety matters is being done.
- A donation of a cherry picker will assist the TLM to repair and maintain streetlights.
- Pre-paid water meters are being installed to control and conserve water.

Community members responded by raising the following issues:

- There is poor maintenance of streetlights and insufficient high mast lights.
- There is a deficit of local jobs.
- Illegal businesses and informal traders are operating in the TLM.
- There is not enough visible policing in Northam.
- Renewal of driving licenses is not being done timeously and efficiently.
- Additional housing stands are needed.
- A local transport forum should be initiated.

The TLM responded by agreeing to clear illegal businesses and informal traders. Furthermore, the TLM prioritised appointing a satellite manager for Northam to address service delivery issues. TLM said that cable damaged by a contractor had slowed down the pace of repairing streetlights, but these would be fixed.

TLM mayor councillor John Michael Fischer assured the participants that the municipality is working around the clock to address the identified service delivery concerns.

"The mines are assisting the TLM where possible. We are engaging with the mines so that they can help us in a number of projects such as the Northam Wastewater Treatment Works." He also urged residents to report any ill treatment by municipal officials so that managers can quickly attend to any complaints.

POLICE OPERATIONS NET OVER 1,800 SUSPECTS

Polokwane – A total of 1,849 suspects were arrested across Limpopo province for various offences ranging from rape, murder, business robbery, possession of illicit cigarettes to possession of unlicensed firearms and ammunition.

The suspects were caught during operations by the police crime prevention unit, K9 unit, crime intelligence unit, border policing as well as the Limpopo Highway Patrol Team (LHPT). Roadblocks involving vehicle searches, tracing of wanted suspects and other operations covering all districts of the province, including the Beitbridge border, were conducted by law enforcement agents.

Over 34,500 people and 20,052 motor vehicles were searched during the operations.

A total of 617 undocumented persons were amongst those arrested for various offences. Items confiscated during the operations included 16 firearms, a rifle, 6 suspected stolen motor vehicles, 10 cell phones, counterfeit cigarettes, dangerous weapons, cash, drugs as well as liquor.

Additionally, 2,031 fines were issued to motorists who contravened the Road Traffic Act while 68 shebeens were closed.

STAY OF EXECUTION FOR BAOBABS

Makhado – Interested and affected parties on the Musina-Makhado Special Economic Zone (MMSEZ) have been granted additional time till Sunday 31 January 2021 to submit comments on the draft Environmental Impact Assessment report. The original deadline for submissions was Thursday 22 October and over 3,000 submissions were received. The botanical survey estimates that 5,657 baobab trees will be directly affected by the MMSEZ. Not only are these iconic trees of the Limpopo province landscape, but they have untapped socio-economic value in the organic health food industry. Baobab specialist doctor Sarah Venter says that baobabs take 200 years before they produce fruit! Baobab trees produce a fruit that can be processed into a 'superfood' known for its unsurpassed nutritional makeup

and becoming increasingly popular on the organic food market. In 2005, she started a company in Makhado to produce baobab products which sources directly from rural women and is an incentive to maintain natural habitats. A secondary product is a high value cosmetic oil, known as baobab seed oil. Sarah estimates that the combined value of the baobab powder and oil that can be generated from the baobab trees on the MMSEZ site alone totals R2,800,000 per annum. The Department of Economic Development, Environment and Tourism (LEDET) is the competent authority charged with deciding whether this controversial development should go ahead and whether alternatives have been adequately considered by the consultants.



PROTECT PETS FROM HEATSTROKE

Thabazimbi – Summer is here and so are the hot, long days. Pets often do not have the luxury of cooling off in a swimming pool or an air-conditioned room and can experience heat stroke. "Responsible pet owners make sure that their pets have enough water and shelter to protect them from the scorching summer sun," said Thabazimbi Animal Rescue (TAR) kennel manager Magda Steward.

A dog's body temperature is on average 38.5°C. A mere increase of two degrees in body temperature is all it takes for heatstroke to kick in. TAR cautions that it takes as little as 15 minutes for a dog to die of heatstroke. The average survival rate for dogs suffering from heatstroke is 50%.

How to keep your dog cool on hot days:

- Restrict exercise
- Never leave your pet in a vehicle, hot room, or suntrap
- Ensure that they have enough cool drinking water and a shaded spot during the day

- Walk your dog early in the morning or later in the evening
- Spray your dog with cool water

Signs of a heatstroke in dogs include:

- Brain seizures
- Glazy eyes
- Fearful expression
- Racing heart
- High body temperature
- Heavy panting
- Excess drooling
- Red or purple gums and tongue
- Vomiting
- Collapsing or staggering

Steps to take if heatstroke is suspected:

- Move the animal to a cool area
- Offer small amounts of tepid water
- Use cool wet towels to gently reduce the temperature - but don't stress the body further with cold water
- Use a fan to create airflow
- Contact your vet straight away


