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MANHUNT FOR ESCAPED PRISONER

Lephalale – A 31-year-old man escaped from the Lephalale Magistrates' Court holding cells on Monday 24 November. The incident is being investigated. The police have since launched a manhunt for Tawanda Trust, who escaped moments after he had appeared in court on a charge of theft.

He was due to appear again in the same court on 24 November and police are requesting the public to come forward with information about his whereabouts. "The escapee was also arrested for house robbery, escaping from lawful custody, possession of suspected stolen property as well as burglary," police spokesperson colonel Moatshe Ngoepe said.

TIPS TO PREVENT HIJACKINGS AND ROBBERIES

Thabazimbi – Too often members of the community fall victim to crimes like hijacking, house, and business robberies. The South African Police Service (SAPS) has a few tips that may help keep you safe.

HIJACKINGS

- Avoid travelling alone at night.
- Do not stop vehicles near hijacking spots or any secluded area.
- Always be alert when driving and if you suspect being followed drive to the nearest police station or call the SAPS emergency number 10111.
- Do not pick up hitchhikers – particularly when you are alone.
- Avoid distractions such as a mobile phone or drinking alcohol.
- Increase caution at intersections, watch people loitering near your car, and beware of any sudden activity around you.

HOUSE ROBBERIES

- Always be on the lookout for suspicious persons

and vehicles in the neighbourhood.

- Enhance security by fitting access doors with security gates and installing burglar bars on all windows.
- Request neighbours to keep an eye on your property if you go away for an extended period.
- Do not open gates and doors to strangers.
- Check references of domestic staff, gardeners, and contractors before granting access to the premises.

BUSINESS ROBBERIES

- Limit the amount of money kept on the premises.
- Be on the lookout for suspicious customers.
- Late opening hours are not recommended.
- Avoid being alone, especially at night.
- Do not open for anyone after business hours.

N1 TREE FELLING

Limpopo – The Limpopo province attracts domestic and foreign tourists for its plant and animal life. While driving from the Gauteng province the indigenous trees along the N1 remind travellers that they are coming to a special place where the wilderness is treasured. Unfortunately, unscrupulous, and large-scale tree felling has been taking place along the N1 and other roads. Tree stumps can be seen between the Mookgophong on ramp and the Kranskop Toll Plaza. No doubt this is partly due to the many people who find themselves in economic difficulties – but even so – disregarding environmental authorisation processes that has been put in place after careful consideration of climate change, air quality, species facing extinction and the functioning of ecosystems, should not be condoned or supported.

The environmental authorisation processes that is followed even by the South African National Roads Agency (SANRAL) before cutting down indigenous trees is done through the Limpopo Province – Department of Economic Development; Environment and Tourism (LEDET).

Expertise exists within LEDET to determine whether the tree species that will be removed is protected or has medicinal or cultural value in the area. LEDET should also be able to make recommendations on how felling should be done to induce regrowth, give inputs on what area could be cleared or selectively cleared to protect threatened and protected species, improve pasture or biodiversity and prevent soil erosion and ecosystem deterioration. There are many areas in the bushveld where the inappropriate use or control of veld fires or the introduction of cattle, has resulted

in overgrowth of one species of woody plant known as bush encroachment. It would be beneficial to remove such species for firewood.

Due to the large-scale poaching of indigenous wood from natural areas, people who appreciate trees must start to ask questions about the source of braai wood before they buy it. Even deadwood should not be removed from the environment as it provides a habitat for insects, food for birds and lizards and enriches the soil.

TWO TODDLERS AND A BABY PERISH IN FIRE

Northam – Moments after a mother left her children to buy food at a nearby shop, she received news that her home was on fire. The distraught mother ran back only to find the structure engulfed in flames. The incident occurred in Northam on Saturday morning at around 8:00 on 21 November. Two toddlers and a baby were killed in the fire. The community summoned the police, firefighters, and emergency services to the scene. They identified the deceased children as five-month-old Sinenhlahla Tsotetsi and two-year-olds Jabulane

Tsotetsi, and Katlego Mogale. The cause of the fire is still unknown. Expressing her shock and sadness after receiving news of the incident, acting provincial commissioner of the South African Police Service in Limpopo major general Christine Morakaladi urged parents to not leave their children unattended. TLM's councillors and mayor, cllr John Michael Fischer attended the funeral in Smashblock on Thursday 27 November. We extend our heartfelt condolences to the mother and family of the boys.



Head-on collisions surge

The provincial department of transport and community safety is concerned about the high number of weekend traffic accidents.

Limpopo – Twelve people were killed in road accidents in the Limpopo province during the weekend of Friday 13 to Sunday 15 November. This was a sharp increase from three deaths reported the weekend before. In one of the accidents, one person died and two were seriously injured in a head-on collision between a Toyota SUV and a Ford Bakkie along the R81 at Sekgopo. "Most of the accidents were reported in the Vhembe and Mopani districts. In one of the accidents, four people died in a head-on collision involving a Toyota Sedan and a Nissan Truck on the R36 Lefara road in Mopani," spokesperson for the provincial department of transport and community safety Mike Maringa said.

Four others died in two separate accidents in the Vhembe district on Sunday 15 November. In the first accident, the driver of a GWM bakkie lost control and crashed into a wall along the D3716 road. Two passengers were killed on scene while the driver and another passenger sustained injuries. In the other accident, which occurred along the N1 outside Makhado, a Toyota and a Nissan collided head-on. "The driver of the Nissan lost control of the vehicle and collided with an oncoming Toyota. Both drivers were declared dead on the scene," Maringa added. Our sincerest condolences to the family and friends of the deceased.

Regorogile – To meet the needs of less fortunate community members, Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) met with residents of Regorogile extension 2 on Monday 23 November to register people on the municipality's incentives scheme and indigent registration campaign for the 2020/ 2021 year. By law, municipalities are required to have an indigent policy to ensure that persons and households classified as indigent, within their jurisdiction have access to basic municipal services. The *Census Community Survey* report of 2016 showed that 12,431 indigent households resided in the TLM. The number of poor and needy households may have increased due to the job losses and salary adjustments caused by COVID-19 regulations.

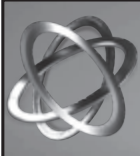

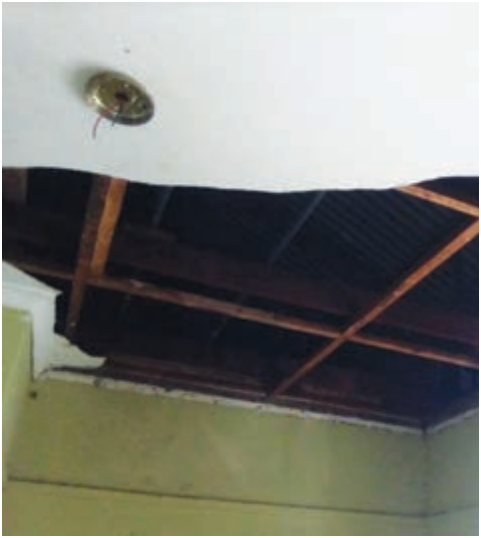
They have started sanding down the walls and filling in the cracks and their next challenge is to get the water tanks, pump and water pipes installed.
