CRIME STATS

Limpopo – Contact crimes and cases of malicious damage residential burglary by 24.2%. second quarter of the 2020/2021 financial year, according to the provincial crime statistics released on Thursday 10 December.

Provincial commissioner of the South African Police Service (SAPS) in Limpopo lieutenant general Nneke Ledwaba, pointed out that contact related crimes went up by 8.7% while malicious damage to property recorded a 10.9% increase. On a positive note, murder decreased by 14.7%, general sexual offenses by 9.3%, stock theft by 18.5% and

to property in the Limpopo province increased during the Ledwaba acknowledged efforts by SAPS units in Limpopo and provincial chairperson of the community policing forum board, Frans Kgasago, for enhancing safety and security within communities.

The overview of the crime statistics was focused on serious crimes such as murder, sexual offences, attempted murder, assault to do grievous bodily harm, common assault, aggravated robberies, arson, malicious damage to property, burglaries, theft of and out of motor vehicles, commercial crimes and theft in general.



10-YEAR SENTENCE FOR FRAUDSTER ATTORNEY

Brits - Isak Snyman a 46-year-old attorney was sentenced on Tuesday 8 December by the specialised commercial crimes court in Pretoria for theft of trust funds.

According to Hawks spokesperson captain Tlangelani Rikhotso, since 2010 the accused was employed in Brits to purchase and register properties on behalf of clients. The accused misappropriated about R4-million and deposited the money into his trust account to purchase properties. His clients reported him to the Hawks' serious commercial crime unit who investigated the allegations and had him summoned to court. Snyman pleaded guilty and was sentenced to 10-years, suspended for five years on condition that he repay the funds back in R50,000 monthly instalments.

- Always ensure that the driver and all passengers, even those on the back seat are wearing their seatbelts.
- Do not use medication or drugs that may impair your reflexes and driving ability.
- · Ensure that you take breaks at regular intervals especially when driving long distances.
- If there are other licensed drivers in the vehicle, alternate the responsibility of driving regularly.
- · Keep both hands on the steering wheel.
- Pay full attention when driving and take care not to be distracted by passengers, a cellular phone, or other electronic devices.
- · Ensure that children are occupied with an activity and will not distract the driver.
- Use main roads and never stop in isolated areas.
- Try to avoid driving at night.
- When driving to neighbouring states, try to do so in a convoy with trusted friends or family.
- Be vigilant that you are not being followed, especially before stopping at an intersection or for a break.

MUNICIPALITY MUST DELIVER ON PROMISES [LETTER TO THE EDITOR]

Northam – We are having a lot of integrated development planning (IDP) meetings in Northam, but as a community, we are beginning to wonder if

we are really benefiting from this.

Last year, for example, the mayor of Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) made many promises, but these promises are yet to be fulfilled. The streets of Northam are not clean at all and I cannot help but wonder if anybody cares. We also have several other issues that need urgent attention such as refuse dumping and potholes, that have been increasing on the roads because the municipality is not carrying out any repairs. Non-functional streetlights are also a major concern. They need to be fixed quickly because the current situation helps criminals to commit crimes under the cover of darkness. The current poor state of the traffic signs and road markings is also of critical importance because it can result in many accidents.

Without equipment such as tipper trucks and other heavy construction and maintenance vehicles, how does the municipality aim to resolve all the problems? Do they really care about Northam?

As residents, we demand a plan of action from TLM regarding how they intend to sort out this mess. We cannot wait until next year July when the IDP funds are allocated but end up being used for something else again.
