

Thabazimbi - Community members feel comfortable going to the Thabazimbi Police Station, where the police officers put their concerns first. Whether you visit them to report a case or get your documents certified, they make an effort to attend to your needs in a professional manner. Don't misjudge them by their friendliness, they are also hardened crime-fighting machines who are committed to protect their community and ensure that the rule of law is upheld. For the officers at the Thabazimbi Police Station, it is not a 9 to 5 job, but a lifestyle of service, holding hands with security groups and community members. *Platinum* Bushvelder caught up with some of the

officers, who shared their concerns and thoughts about the collective fight against residents to be alert and vigilant to avoid crime. Constable Ashley Maropola said: "I violence. As men, we have to care for women by protecting them. Please stop hurting women, children, and the elderly. Break the silence! If you are a victim, please do not hesitate to come to us so that we assist you."

Sergeant Edwin Papo reminded community members to keep within the confines of the law "If you commit a crime you will get caught and arrested. Prevention is better than cure. If you do not commit a crime, you to do not have to do time. Crime does

not pay." Constable Michael Molomo urged housebreaking incidents. "Get to know am urging the community to stop domestic your neighbours as well as the telephone numbers of the police station so that we can assist you when you need help.'

> The high incidents of alcohol and drug abuse in some areas in Thabazimbi is of great concern to constable Boitumelo Dibyane. "When I drive around Thabazimbi, often witness women walking around in a drunken stupor. What is particularly concerning is that some of them even have small children with them. Please think about how your actions impact your children's future. Please do not walk alone at night."

PETROL PRICE

The Department of Energy has published the official fuel price adjustments for March, showing a massive hike for both petrol and diesel. The following changes came into effect on Wednesday, 3 March 2021:

- Petrol 95: increase of 65 cents per litre
 - Petrol 93: increase of 65 cents per litre
 - Diesel 0.05%: increase of 54 cents per litre
- Diesel 0.005%: increase of 56 cents per litre
- Illuminating Paraffin: increase of 47 cents per litre

Thabazimbi – Thabazimbi Correctional Services and the South African Police Services (SAPS) are requesting the community to assist them to track down and re-arrest two inmates who skipped parole. Raphael Rimana, one of the escapees, had been sentenced to 12 months in prison after he was convicted for possession of ivory. Eric Mkhonza was sentenced to three years in jail for rape and robbery. Rimana and Mkhonza were both granted parole in 2001 and 2012 respectively but failed to adhere to the terms and regulations of their parole. Subsequently, they will face additional charges when they are re-arrested.


GENDER IDENTITY | Do you think children should be raised gender neutral?
