FUEL HIKE CONCERNS...



Northam – Motorists in Northam have expressed their concern over the recent fuel increase which they say came at a time they had not yet fully adjusted to the negative financial impact of the COVID-19 pandemic. On Wednesday 7 April, South African motorists woke up to a steep petrol increase. The R17.32 per litre inland price for 95 unleaded is a new record that surpassed the previous R17.08 figure of 2018. The wholesale price of high-sulphur diesel increased by 65c (inland) while low sulphur diesel also went up by 63 cents. Philip Swanepoel and Felix Khoza, though unhappy with the increase, are still hopeful that the prices will stabilise in the coming months.

The two motorists, who spoke to *Platinum Bushvelder* while filling up their vehicles at Viva Garage in Northam, said they were yet to fully come to terms with the increase. "This is not good news at all," Khoza said. "I do not know how people are going to manage to make ends meet because apart from fuel, we also have other bills to pay." Swanepoel said the increase could see the cost of food, school fees and consumer goods also shooting up. He said: "I think the increase might be linked to an attempt to recover the losses experienced in 2020. I hope the taxi operators do not increase their fares because this would create additional challenges for most people."

LIMPOPO EASTER ROAD FATALITIES

Limpopo – It seems as if ban on alcohol sales had no effect on road safety over the Easter weekend. Many road accidents recorded in the Limpopo Province over the Easter period resulted in several fatalities that have left government authorities scrambling for answers to prevent the needless loss of lives experienced each year during major holidays. In one of the accidents, four people were killed on Saturday 3 April in a head-on collision along the D856 road at Sekhukhune. Another person was seriously injured in the collision, which involved a Polo VW and a Mahindra. "Drivers of both vehicles and two passengers were certified dead on the scene. One passenger sustained serious injuries and was rushed to the hospital," spokesperson for the provincial Department of Transport and Community Safety

Mike Maringa said. "Reckless driving is cited as a possible cause of the accident," he added. In another accident, one person died in a head-on collision which occurred along the R81 outside Giyani. "It is alleged that the driver of a Hyundai sedan was overtaking on a barrier line and collided with an oncoming Toyota sedan," Maringa added. The driver of the Hyundai was killed instantly while the passenger he was travelling with escaped with minor injuries. The driver of the Toyota sedan as well as a passenger also sustained serious injuries and had to be taken to Khensani Hospital for treatment. Yet another accident on Saturday 3 April resulted in the temporary closure of the R101 road between Maubane and Pienaars Dekman Farm. Motorists were advised by traffic police officers to use the N1 from Pienaars as an alternative route

after a head on collision involving two vehicles stopped the flow of traffic. "For this accident, three people have so far been confirmed dead," Maringa said.



IVERMECTIN GETS GO-AHEAD

Doctors can now legally prescribe Ivermectin for the treatment of COVID-19
In January, Dr Naseeba Kathrada was one of 700 doctors who wrote a letter to the President, calling for the go-ahead to use Ivermectin. Kathrada says the drug can be used for prophylaxis or administered to patients who have various levels of COVID-19. The verdict has fallen in their favour and the respondents (without admission of any liability) were ordered to pay R1.8 million to the applicants. Says Dr Kathrada: "It can be used throughout for treatment. Dosages are different, depending on the weight of the person, when you use it (at which stage). Stay off the black market, go to your doctor." The order stipulated that:
• A pharmacist, medical practitioner and any other person registered under the Health Professions Act may sell a medicine that contains ivermectin to a patient on prescription.
• "Unregistered ivermectin-containing finished pharmaceutical products remain accessible under the present programme" through

authorised suppliers.
• A medical practitioner may initiate treatment with ivermectin at the same time as submitting an application for the individual to the South African Health Products Regulatory Authority (Sahpra). Those supporting and those opposing the use of Ivermectin are on totally opposite sides of the spectrum. Interesting comments was raised on social media. Quoting 'Money_Talks' who responded on a critic of Ivermectin on MoneyWeb, referring to the Jama study, which was but one of many studies done on both sides, he said: "The Jama study was fundamentally flawed:
– The study was sponsored by vaccine makers, for whom there is financial benefit to discredit the use of an effective treatment like Ivermectin.
– The target outcome of the study was changed during the study, resulting in the study proving effectively nothing – two groups of healthy young individuals with mild symptoms recover quickly anyway.
– The control group also received Ivermectin for

some period during the study by accident, thereby nullifying the total outcome of the study.
– The study was not properly controlled, since individuals were sent home with bottles of bitter tasting medicine. How can you be sure it was not poured down the drain?" In another comment "Money_Talks' said: Ivermectin has been proven beyond reasonable doubt by many clinical and observational studies around the world, to show a remarkable benefit in the prevention and treatment of all strains of Covid-19. The available data shows a great improvement in safety over other medicines, as well as the current "vaccines". There is also a huge censorship effort by various government agencies, Google, YouTube and other media platforms (all controlled by the Elite) in order to discredit and silence the use of Ivermectin as a possible treatment option for Covid-19. If you want to find out the truth, you sometimes have to surf the Dark Web.

Thabazimbi – Luci Gerber word vanjaar 13 jaar oud. Haar passie is krieket, swem, kuns en gimnastiek. Sy is só 'n aktiewe mense dat niemand ooit sou kon raai dat haar een been eintlik korter as haar ander een is nie.

Die probleem met haar been het in 2016 sy verskyning gemaak na 'n uitstappie saam met haar pa. “Ek het gesukkel om by te bly en my regter been het baie seer geword,” het Luci in 'n onderhoud met *Platinum Bushvelder* vertel.

Hulle het eers vermoed dat sy haar been verstuit het. 'n Paar dae later na sy op die trampolien gespring het, het sy soveel pyn gehad dat sy in die hospitaal beland het. Na twee lang dae van toetse is sy gediagnoseer met *developmental hip dysplasia*. Sy moes twee operasies ondergaan en daar was komplikasies met die eerste operasie wat veroorsaak het dat haar regterbeen stadiger gegroei het. Vandag is haar linkerbeen 6cm langer as haar regterbeen, wat veroorsaak dat sy nie 'normaal' kan loop of hardloop nie – en vereis dat sy 'n spesiale, opgeboude, skoene moet dra.

Na haar operasies het vele mense haar probeer keer om haar drome te volg maar Luci laat nie toe dat ander mense se opinies haar onderkry nie. “Baie mense het my al aangestaar, ek moes maar self besluit dat dit my nie gaan pla nie. Ek het ook al baie mense gekry wat vir my gesê het dat daar seker goed is wat ek nie sal kan regkry nie wat my laat besluit het dat ek hulle sal wys. Niemand behalwe ek self sal my sukses bepaal nie!”

'n Boelie is iemand wat ander bang-, seer-, of skrik maak en mense minderwaardig wil laat voel. “Ons skool doen hulle bes om boelies te keer, en die leerders staan op teen boelies. Ons weet dat ons enige tyd met 'n leier of 'n onderwyser kan praat en hulle sal dadelik help. Boelies is nie net by die skool nie, boelies is oral.” Sy wil ander aanmoedig om te praat as hulle geboelie word en nie toe te laat dat ander mense hul waarde bepaal nie.

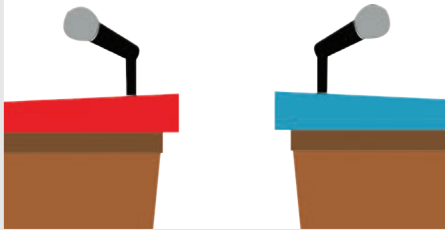
