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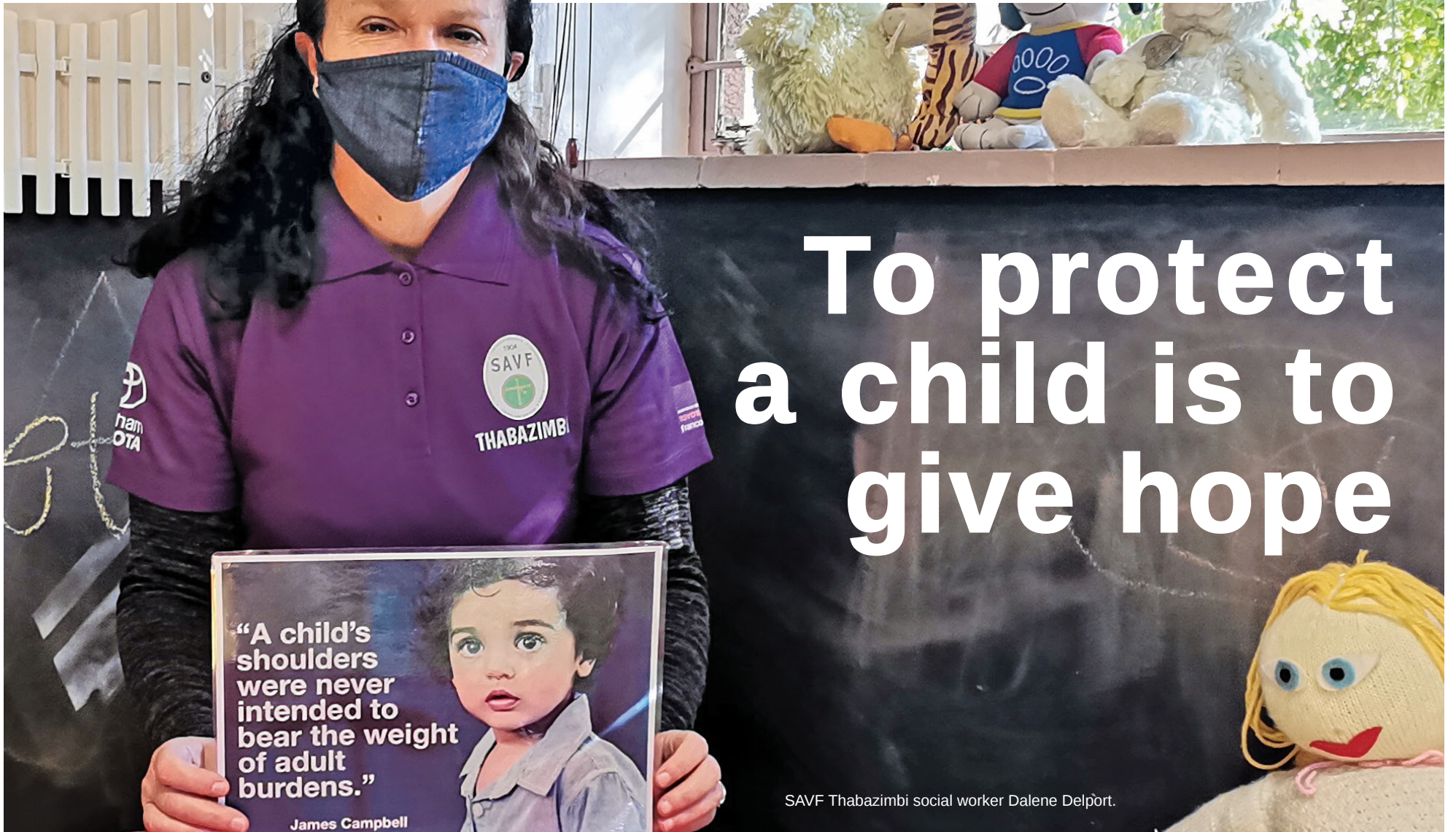

Two motorbike accidents in one night

Thabazimbi – Saturday evening 29 May at around 18:00, a man and woman were involved in a motorbike accident. They were on their way back to town, traveling on the Pondok road when the accident occurred. Moments later, not being able to stop in time, a second motorbike rider crashed into them. Bystanders were still attending to the injured in the first accident when the second accident occurred. Emergency services were summoned and the injured were stabilised and transported to hospital.



GIRL RAPED BY MOM'S BOYFRIEND

Thabazimbi – Amos Malete (22) was sentenced to life imprisonment before the Thabazimbi Magistrates' Court on 2 June on charges of raping a minor. Thabazimbi family violence, child protection, and sexual offences (FCS) commander warrant officer Temane welcomed the conviction. According to brigadier Motlafela Mojapelo, the mother of the 10-year-old girl left her in the care of her boyfriend. "When the mother returned home, her daughter told her she was raped by her mother's boyfriend. She immediately opened a case at the police station." Investigations led to the arrest and subsequent sentencing of the accused.

Thabazimbi – The purpose of Child Protection Week, observed annually in South Africa from 31 May to 6 June, is to bring about change in children's lives. Child Protection Week commenced in 1997 to mobilise communities and raise awareness of the need to protect children. The Constitution came into effect 24 years ago – 24 years of trying to protect our children. Yet, according to statistics, there is a horrific increase in child abuse, child neglect, rape, killing of children, exploitation, child trafficking, children growing up in unsafe environments, children being bullied, children who are failed by the system... Section 28 of the South African Constitution states: *The best interest of the child is paramount. Every person and community have the responsibility to protect the rights of the child. Children have the right to protection, to be raised in a healthy, happy home, to be educated, to be fed and cared for and to live in a safe environment with walls, safe toilets, and safe playgrounds.* This huge challenge can be addressed in different ways: prevention, early intervention, and statutory intervention. SAVF is involved in prevention by means of awareness campaigns and poverty alleviation. During lockdown alone, SAVF delivered 44,000 food parcels to struggling families. **Early intervention:** SAVF trains parents in the Botswadi parenting programme. They strengthen

the role of the father in the child's life through our Ubaba Unathi programme. Other programmes aimed at parenting are the SAVF Rebuilding Dreams programme for pregnant teenagers and teenage parents as well as the Active Parenting of teenagers' programme. Their bullying and child protection programmes were established to enhance their effective early intervention actions. **Statutory intervention:** Children are placed in alternative care, such as foster care and Child and Youth Care centres (CYCC), of which SAVF has four, plus two foster homes and one place of safety. Over the past year, SAVF touched the lives of 90,000 children and 500 of them live in the CYCCs. Communities have a role to play. First, when they know about unjust conduct against children, they have to report it. Secondly, they can support organisations such as the SAVF by becoming volunteers or by contributing money, food, clothes, toys, sanitary products for girls, or anything else which could add to the well-being of the child. "Prevention, paramountcy, partnership, protection and parental responsibility – these five P's are the key principles in protecting our children. Children must come first, they are the future," said SAVF Thabazimbi social worker Dalene Delpont. **For more information contact the SAVF Thabazimbi office on 014 777 1093.**

Northam – Aitsa! Catelyne Coetzee is ‘n 18-jarige matrikulant wat haar eie besigheid geopen het op Dinsdag 4 Mei, genaamd Boekkekoffie. Ek voel daar is ‘n mark vir dié tipe besigheid in Northam,” aldus Catelyne. Catelyne is dankbaar teenoor haar ouers vir hul ondersteuning. Die aspirante jonge dame bak alles in die winkel self en tussendeur is sy ook nog besig met haar skoolwerk. Soggens het sy al ‘n klompie werk afgehandel lank voor die son begin water trek. Sy werk verbete om op datum te bly met haar studies. “My droom is dat my besigheid ‘n kettingwinkel word, ‘n naam op almal se lippe.” Die gesellige koffiewinkel het ‘n rustige atmosfeer waar jy kan wegbreek, rustig raak, en neus-in-‘n-boek wegval. Daar is ook konferensie fasiliteite waar jou personeel vergaderings kan hou. **Besoek Boekkekoffie by Haffsons Centre, winkel 98, eerste vloer, Botha straat, Northam – kom lees ‘n boek, drink ‘n koppie koffie, en geniet nog ‘n versnapering daarby.**

Water meter theft on the increase

Northam – Seven water meters were stolen in the same street (Kelly Street, extension 6) within two weeks. Apart from costing the Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) a pretty penny, precious potable water is going down the drain. TLM communications manager Joshua Motsomane urges community members to report these criminals. “We ask

our residents and scrap metal dealers to be our eyes and ears so that we are able to bring to book what we suspect to be a criminal syndicate operating in the area,” he said. He added that more than 30 water meters had been stolen recently in various parts of Northam. “We will have to replace all of them with plastic ones,” he added.

The people stood their ground on E-tolling Waiting on government to say yea or nay



SA – The Organisation Undoing Tax Abuse (OUTA) reacted with cautious optimism to the announcement by Gauteng Transport member of executive council (MEC), Jacob Mamabolo, that e-tolls were scrapped. Mamabolo made the announcement during an interview with Stephen Grootes on SAFM. The MEC said: “They’ve been scrapped. The people of Gauteng should not be burdened for paying for national roads that serves all of us, that serves neighbouring states, that serves the whole economy of our country... That is unfair to leave it to the people of Gauteng.” Barely an hour later, Mamabolo backtracked on Twitter, saying: “We reaffirm that the announcement on scrapping of e-tolls (sic) is imminent and must be made soon. The tweet by @SaFmRadio distorts that conversation.” Wayne Duvenage, OUTA’s chief executive officer, welcomed the initial statement by

the MEC, but said the organisation awaits confirmation via the right channels before celebrating the news. “If true, it would mean a massive win for OUTA and all Gauteng motorists who defied the system. However, this is a matter that will need to be confirmed by either cabinet or the Minister of Transport, Fikile Mbalula. If indeed this decision has been made, MEC Mamabolo may have let the cat out the bag and stole Minister Mbalula’s thunder. Hence the retraction on social media.” OUTA says SANRAL will also have to withdraw all legal cases on e-tolls. “At this stage we have more questions than answer on this morning’s announcement, but we are treating this breaking news as being early signs of an imminent announcement on the future of an irrational scheme that was forced onto Gauteng motorists.” **OUTA press release extracts, 27 May 2021**

Ls Thaba close for 7 days - Covid-19

Thabazimbi – On 2 June, parents of Laerskool Thabazimbi received a circular, informing them that they want to close the school due to an alarming increase of Covid-19 cases.

The school management and governing body, in collaboration with the Department of Health and the circuit manager, made an urgent request to the Limpopo Department of Education to close Laerskool Thabazimbi for a period of seven school days.

The rapidly increasing rate of Covid-19 infections in Thabazimbi and the school left the school with no other option. There are currently 258 learners who do not attend school because they tested positive for

Covid-19 or are adhering the Covid-19 isolation related incidents.

Dates, school closing...

- Laerskool Thabazimbi will be closed for all learners from 3 to 11 June (Grade R to 7).
- Laerskool Thabazimbi will reopen on Monday 14 June for all learners.
- The school will reopen with week 1's timetable for Grade 4-7 and Group A for Grade R-3.

No parents or visitors are allowed to enter the school premises during this time.

Citizens come last in Eskom's wage dispute

SA – Tensions are rising with Eskom's labour unions asking for 10 times more than what is offered. They want a 15% increase while a 1.5% offer is on the table.

Eskom's wage negotiations commenced on 4 May and is still ongoing. During talks in the Central Bargaining Forum, Eskom is engaging with the National Union of Mineworkers (NUM), the National Union of Metalworkers of South Africa (NUMSA) and Solidarity to determine the conditions of employment and wages for all non-managerial employees. These unions are the recognised labour representatives of Eskom's Bargaining Unit employees. By law, Eskom provides a critical essential service. Whose got the upper hand in this game?
