SA – It is important for all South Africans to be involved in the development of new legislature. The last day for you to make any comments on the Prevention and Combating of Hate Crimes and Hate Speech Bill is **Friday 1 October**.

What is a Bill?

A bill is a draft version of a law. Most bills are drawn up by a government department under the direction of the relevant minister or deputy minister. This kind of bill must be approved by the Cabinet before being submitted to Parliament. A bill becomes an Act of Parliament and Law of the Land when the President signs it, declaring it as law.

Section 4 (2)(d) 'Offence of hate speech' of the bill states:

the bona fide interpretation and proselytising or espousing of any religious tenet, belief, teaching, doctrine or writings, to the extent

that such interpretation and proselytization does not advocate hatred that constitutes incitement to cause harm, based on one or more of the grounds referred to in subsection (1)(a).

It is the interpretation part of this section that concerns several religious leaders, because a clear intention for one person can be interpreted as something totally different for another person.

- WHAT TO DO IF YOUR FIREARM IS STOLEN:
- Report the incident at the local SAPS station immediately.
 - A person is guilty of an offence in terms of the Firearms Control Act, 2000 (Act No 60 of 2000) if he or she fails to report the loss or theft of a firearm within 24 hours.
 - Section 120(11) of the act places an obligation on the holder of a licence, permit or authorisation to possess a firearm, and any other person who was in the possession of or who had control of a firearm when it was lost, stolen, or destroyed, must report such loss, theft or destruction within 24

- Failure to comply with section 120(11), could lead to criminal prosecution with the possibility of imprisonment for up to 10 years in terms of schedule 4 of the act.
 - After reporting the firearm as having been stolen, the South African Police Service will most probably open a criminal docket against you and will start the process of investigation into the matter.
 - You may possibly be charged with a criminal offence in terms of section 120(8) of the act.

Thabazimbi – The Swanepoel family’s sense of safety was shattered after a break-in at their home on Saturday 18 September. Deon Swanepoel woke up at around 04:00. As he walked towards the living room, he noticed that the window was broken, and the burglar proofing had been cut. “I immediately ran to my children’s rooms to see if they were safe. Because we lock our corridor, the intruders couldn’t get to the rooms,” Deon said. Without even waking the dogs, the burglars fled the scene with various electronics. Deon added: “Our sense of security is also out of the door.” The Community Policing Forum (CPF) and police responded swiftly. Police spokesperson constable Titus Khumalo confirmed that the incident was reported and that police have intensified patrolling the affected areas. With the help of community structures like the CPF and neighborhood watches, security is tightened, and high visibility is maintained during the night.

Thabazimbi station commissioner lieutenant colonel Bodibe condemned the burglaries and urged home owners to complete the vacant house register at the station when they are on holidays or away so that regular visits and patrols can be done. Buckle up baby!

[Letter to the editor]

Thabazimbi – While driving down Van Der Bijl Street last week, a young family of four came driving past. I couldn’t help but notice that their toddler was standing in the centre of the backseat and a baby was sitting on her mom’s lap. How irresponsible! First of all, it is against the law! According to the *regulation 213 (6A) of the National Road Traffic Act instituted on 30 April 2015, the driver of a motor vehicle operated on a public road, shall ensure that an infant travelling in such a motor vehicle is seated on an appropriate child restraint...* Secondly, studies have shown that child safety seats that are correctly installed for use by children aged zero to four years, can reduce the need for hospitalisation by 69% after an accident. I know what you’re thinking: “I carry my three-year-old everywhere, I’m strong, and I always make sure that they are safe in my arms. Surely I would be able to hold on to them in an accident.” Did you know that in an accident your body weight is multiplied by the speed at which you travel – this is called crash force. Which means that if you are in an accident traveling at 60km per hour your 10kg three-year-old’s crash force would be 600kg, would you be able to hold onto three full size gorillas? If you are lucky enough to have an airbag, the force at which the airbag releases, is equivalent to hitting the ground after falling from the third floor of a building. Your safety belt protects you from that. Your next excuse would probably be: “But what if I put the safety belt over both of us?” Well, imagine the crash force of your body pressing your child against a safety belt. Think long and hard about these numbers and then decide if a quick drive to the shop at 60km per hour with other reckless drivers on the road is really worth being too lazy to not buckle up your child? **Buckle Up!**

Dr. Marius Higgens, prophet, preacher and now writer

Swartklip – Dr. Marius Higgens, a former Swartklip local, visited his hometown for a moving sermon on Sunday 19 September. His parents moved from Krugersdorp to Swartklip in 1972. In 1976 a prophet named David Griffith, led a service at Swartklip.
