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## Extracts of PFTC industry notice: 8 October 2021

### PFTC serves QCTO and SASSETA with an urgent interdict application

We find ourselves in a situation where our industry has once again been purposely omitted from stakeholder consultation, and decisions have been made on our behalf that affect our industry and our training centres – without any consultation.

For those of you who have been active in our industry for longer than 10 years, you will lay testament to the tremendous growth our industry has achieved. Many may not know that the PFTC was the second professional body to be recognised in South Africa when Professional Bodies were brought into 'legislation'.

The establishment of professional bodies has been the mechanism put in place to recognise 'members' within a specific industry as professionals and awarding them professional designations. There are now more than one hundred registered professional bodies. We have worked tirelessly as an industry to meet all the requirements laid out by the regulatory bodies to both earn and maintain these designations and to have the firearms training industry recognised as a professional one. The PFTC has fought and will continue to fight to ensure that this hard work does not go to waste, ensuring that the standards in our industry are upheld and continue to stand up against international comparability studies and that the rights of our training providers and learners are upheld. We have earned the right to be called professionals, and we expect to be treated as such.

Unfortunately, this was not the case last week when I received a call from the PFTC offices requesting that I attend an urgent meeting with the QCTO "in the next 40 minutes". This was an unorthodox request as no previous correspondence had taken place surrounding this meeting or any other meetings for that matter. I was unable to attend the meeting as I was traveling out of province.

I was then simply informed that a decision has been

and revert back to SASSETA who had previously held this mandate. I informed and reminded the QCTO, that the PFTC have a delegation agreement that has set terms and conditions.



The qualification is registered until 30 June 2023. The terms I am referring to are as per the below extract (Delegation agreement dated 5<sup>th</sup> April 2013):  
c) *This delegation commences on the 01 April 2013 and expires once the qualification listed is reviewed and replaced by a qualification developed and registered on the Occupational Qualifications Framework (OQF) or until the qualification reaches its registration end date and teach out periods or when the qualification is withdrawn by the QCTO.*

It was apparent that an agreement had already been entered into with SASSETA without any written notification, transparency, consultation, or stakeholder participation prior to this decision being made.

made by the QCTO that they will no longer work with non-regulated statutory bodies such as the PFTC nor any other professional bodies. Therefore, they have decided to cancel our mandate for quality assurance (delegation)

After consultation with Martin Hood our attorney, we agreed that we would not attend any meeting until this new agreement has been withdrawn and proper procedures are followed as prescribed in *The Promotion of Administrative Justice Act, 2000 (Act No. 3 of 2000) (PAJA)*.

**The intention of this Act is to change the way in which Government interacts with the people it serves.**

PAJA seeks to protect the public from unlawful, unreasonable, and procedurally unfair administrative decisions. The PFTC therefore consider this decision null and void and will continue with business as usual.

Based on the above, we requested that the agreement entered into by the QCTO and SASSETA be cancelled within 48 hours, or we will seek and serve them with an urgent interdict to prevent them from doing so.

The 48 hours cancellation was not complied with, and we are therefore in the process of serving the parties with notice of an urgent interdict.

Depending on urgent court availability this first matter, we hope, may be heard by end of this month, thereafter we can begin with the next steps of ensuring that decisions such as these are not made without stakeholder consultations. I.E. allowing us having the opportunity to ask questions, obtain clarity, make suggestions and ultimately object as is our right as a professional and a professionally mandated body.

This withdrawal of our agreement with QCTO can have dire consequences not only to us as the firearms training industry but to the firearms industry at large. Consider the potential delays in the processing of firearms applications while applicants await certifications etc. We can only speculate about what the future would look like with SASSETA as the "quality assurer".

The challenges we previously experienced would almost certainly recur, including a complete breakdown in industry consultation and trust.

The PFTC is first and foremost a Professional Body and is the largest representative of firearm training industry stakeholders. The PFTC needs to do what is best for all stakeholders in our industry with careful consideration for the firearms industry at large. I ask that we all remain calm, focused and deal with this "malfunction" as we would any other, in other words let's assess the problem, find a solution, and fix the problem.

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## NEASA's SUBMISSION TO THE NATIONAL MINIMUM WAGE COMMISSION

SA – On 10 September 2021, the National Minimum Wage Commission ('the Commission') published an invitation for written representations by the public, regarding the review of the National Minimum Wage (NMW) for 2022, and possible adjustments thereto. These representations are considered by the Commission, prior to the drafting of its annual recommendation report to the Minister of Employment and Labour.

NEASA has, after publication of this invitation, conducted a survey among employers, in order to determine what the effect of any possible adjustments to the NMW will be on their businesses, and the extent of their ability and capacity to absorb or withstand an increase. The results of this survey were processed and included in NEASA's submission to the Commission on 1 October 2021.

In NEASA's submission, it clearly indicated to the Commission that, in view of the current economic climate in South Africa, the effects of the Covid-19 lockdown, as well as the

recent losses due to violent lootings of mid-2021, an increase to the NMW will be catastrophic to South African businesses and the economy in general.

As aptly stated in their submission, NEASA said:

*"The effect of any adjustments to the NMW should not, and cannot be considered lightly. In a country such as South Africa, that is already struggling with unprecedented rates of unemployment, extreme poverty, overburdened employers and business owners, and a veneer-thin trust in Government and its ability to care for its most vulnerable citizens, an unaffordable NMW will completely maim the already crippled economy, leaving employers, business owners, their employees and their dependants destitute."*

NEASA strongly believes that South Africa requires a dispensation which fosters a conducive environment for economic and business growth, as well as one which welcomes the implementation of laws that encourage employment.

## Supposed to protect the rhino Conservation official and businessman arrested for illegally dealing in rhino horn

Rustenburg – A suspected rhino horn dealing duo consisting of an official from the North West Department of Economic Development, Environment, Conservation and Tourism (DEDECT) and the owner of a security company were arrested in connection with illegal rhino horn trade on Thursday 7 October. The DEDECT official was arrested in Rustenburg. They are both charged with contravening the *National Environmental Management: Biodiversity Act, the Rhino Norms and Standards*.

Their vehicle was also seized by a multi-departmental team comprising members of the Department's Green Scorpions, the Hawks, the DEDECT and the Northern Cape Department of Environment and Nature Conservation (DENC).

According to the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment spokesperson Albi Modise, the suspects are alleged to have moved 17 individual detached rhino horns from the Northern Cape to North West in contravention of permit conditions of both provinces.

The suspects appeared before the Mmabatho Magistrates' Court on 11 October.



## BURNING TYRES CAUSE FOR CONCERN

Northam – In an all too familiar scene, a cloud of black smoke covered the Northam sky on Tuesday 12 October.

The signs of tyres burning near the landfill could be seen from afar. When *Platinum Bushvelder* arrived on scene, there was not a soul in sight and the cause of the smoke was found to be a few tyres that was set alight... small but potent tyre fire.

These fires can be seen in the area often and what might just seem like an insignificant fire can quickly spread, causing extreme damage. With the fire index for Northam still in orange, the burning of any open fires is not allowed. The burning of tyres is also a great health risk as the emissions include chemicals that are extremely dangerous when inhaled. The darker the smoke, the more polluting and dangerous to health it tends to be. Dark to black smoke typically comes from burning plastic, rubber or cables.

# Fix the economy!

**Thabazimbi** – The Confederation of South African Trade Unions (Cosatu) members and affiliates staged a protest in Thabazimbi on Friday 8 October.

The demonstration was part of a nationwide push by the federation for a better economy and improved job opportunities. As part of their nationwide demands, Cosatu urged government and the private sector to fix the economy, stop the wage freezes in the public sector, to investigate the assassination of whistle-blowers and the collapse of key public services. Cosatu also called for a reversal of budget cuts.

The protestors marched at Thaba Mall before handing over a memorandum to the Department of Labour and the Thabazimbi Local Municipality.

The National Employers Association of South Africa (NEASA) was critical of the Cosatu-led strike and fears the damage such protests could have on the economy. Dismissing the protest, chief executive officer at NEASA Gerhard Papenfus said Cosatu had run out of ideas and no longer had an impact on the national discourse.

NEASA will carry out a survey to establish the extent of the protest's impact on businesses. Employment and labour minister Thulas Nxesi noted that dialogue between all the parties is important, especially in this sensitive period of mass unemployment and retrenchments.

# SHAKING THINGS UP

**Thabazimbi** – Thabazimbi experienced a light earthquake at around a quarter to one on Sunday morning, 10 October. A light magnitude earthquake of 3.0 on the Richter scale, about 2.2km west of Thabazimbi at a depth of about 10km woke up several community members. A few took to social media to confirm if it was an earthquake they felt and shared their experiences.

In interviews the *Platinum Bushvelder* was told:

*“I woke up just past midnight with my dogs barking nonstop. They usually only bark when there is danger, so I immediately went to investigate. As I walked towards the door, I heard a few loud thumps. It sounded like someone running past my window. I could not see anything. The following morning, I learned that there was an earthquake. It could very well have been the reason behind my dogs’ barking.”*

*“I was still awake and watching television when it happened. The windows and doors started to rattle, and I immediately knew that it was an earthquake,”* another community member said.

Another report about the tremor said:

*“I was camping in my yard with my 6-year-old daughter. A heavy wind started blowing so I decided to wake her up and go inside. While I was busy packing up, the tent started to flap!”*

Medivet Dierekliniek vet Dr Jamiela Barnard confirmed that animals can hear an earthquake long before it strikes, because some of their senses are much more developed and in tune than ours. They feel the magnetic movement before we can and hear the sound of the vibrations.

Thabazimbi Crisis Control's Henk Havenga confirmed that no damage has been reported.

# New loveLife Trust promoting healthy living

Major developments are planned for the Waterberg Coalfield that are located in the Lephalale area. As water demand in the Lephalale area is expected to increase in the future, the Mokolo Crocodile River (West) Water Augmentation Project (MCWAP) was commissioned to investigate options for meeting the aforementioned water requirements (MCWAP Phase 1) and augment the supply of water from the Crocodile River (West) near Thabazimbi to the Lephalale area, Limpopo Province (MCWAP Phase 2A). Environmental Authorisation for the pipeline and associated infrastructure between Lephalale to Thabazimbi Local Municipalities, Limpopo, was granted by the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and Environment (DFFE). As per Condition 14 of the Environmental Authorisation (EA), the authorised Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) must be amended and submitted to the DFFE for approval prior to the commencement of the project. The GIBB Bigen Nyeleti Joint Venture (GBN-JV) has been appointed by the Trans-Caledon Tunnel Authority (TCTA), on behalf of the Applicant to undertake the amendment of the EMPr.

## APPLICATION FOR THE AMENDMENT OF THE MCWAP 2A ENVIRONMENTAL MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME

Notice is hereby given of a public participation process in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 (Act No. 107 of 1998) (NEMA), as amended, and Regulation 41 of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, (as amended).

The EMPr is currently approved in terms of the Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations, 2014, (as amended) on condition that the following activities are implemented. (Condition 14 and 15 of the EA):

**Condition 14.** The Environmental Management Programme (EMPr) submitted as part of the Application for EA must be amended and submitted to the Department for written approval prior to commencement of the activity. The recommendations and mitigation measures recorded in the EIAR dated November 2018 must be incorporated as part of the EMPr. Once approved, the EMPr must be implemented and adhered to. 14.2. All recommendations and mitigation measures recorded in the EIAR and the specialist reports as included in the final EIAR dated November 2018; and

14.3. A final development layout plan (with micro-siting of the pipelines' route) and all mitigation measures as dictated by the final development layout plan.

**Condition 15.** The final development layout plan to be included in the EMPr must indicate the following:

15.1 The final position of the pipeline within the approved sections of the 1 00m corridor;

15.2. The specific and final position of the major scheme components and associated ancillary infrastructure e.g. gauging weir, river management system, access roads, offices, construction camps etc ;

15.3. All existing infrastructure associated with the development particularly along the pipeline route;

15.4. All sensitive features e.g. wetlands, pans, drainage channels, and heritage sites that will be affected by the pipeline; and

15.5. All "no-go" and buffer areas.

## ROBBERY OF FIREARMS

Ordinary citizens are being harassed, assaulted, and robbed in broad daylight.

**WHAT TO DO IF YOUR FIREARM IS STOLEN:**

- Report the incident at the local SAPS station immediately.
- A person is guilty of an offence in terms of the Firearms Control Act, 2000 (Act No 60 of 2000) if he or she fails to report the loss or theft of a firearm within 24 hours.
- Section 120(11) of the act places an obligation on the holder of a licence, permit or authorisation to possess a firearm, and any other person who was in the possession of or who had control of a firearm when it was lost, stolen, or destroyed, must report such loss, theft or destruction within 24 hours after having become aware of the loss, theft or destruction of the firearm – to the nearest police station.

- Failure to comply with section 120(11), could lead to criminal prosecution with the possibility of imprisonment for up to 10 years in terms of schedule 4 of the act.
- After reporting the firearm as having been stolen, the South African Police Service will most probably open a criminal docket against you and will start the process of investigation into the matter.
- You may possibly be charged with a criminal offence in terms of section 120(8) of the act.

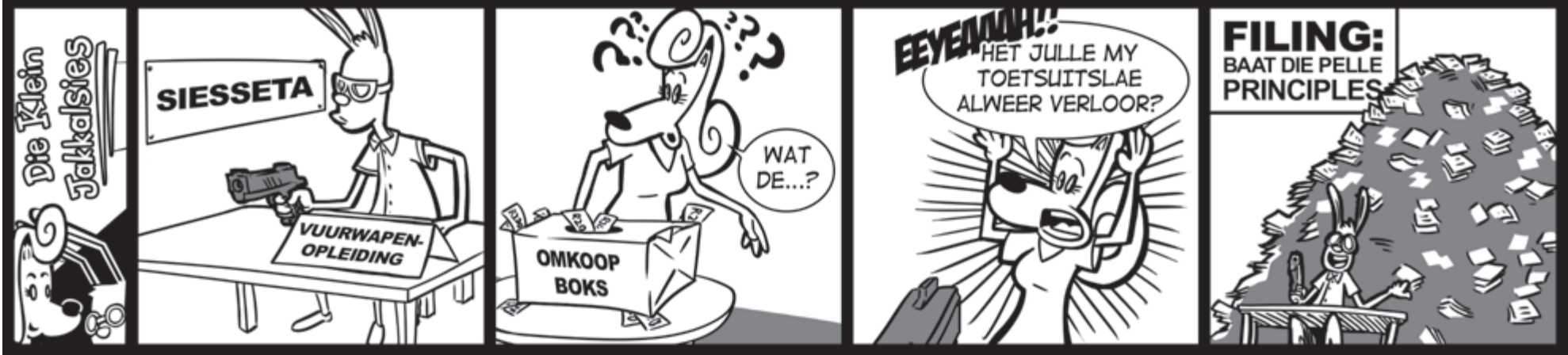
