Thabazimbi – Medivet Direklyniek successfully released two rhinos of which one was orphaned by poachers. The release of Lucky and Clyde was a bittersweet moment for the personnel of Medivet, who were happy that these beautiful animals got a second chance at life, but also sad, as they have become very attached to them.

After his mother failed to produce milk, rhino baby Clyde came to Medivet Direklyniek on Sunday 8 August. He arrived in a small green crate and weighed a mere 60kg, and he barely had a sign of a horn. A few days later Bonnie arrived, smaller and much weaker. No one knows how long she has been next to her dead mother's carcass where she was found. She tried to drink from her mother and swallowed a lot of sand in the process. Sadly, Bonnie died a few days later.

After a rough first week, struggling to win his trust, Clyde started drinking and got stronger. He almost immediately started growing and gaining weight. A few days later, Lucky came to keep Clyde company after his mother was shot. She survived but Lucky, who was a few weeks older than Clyde, needed a temporary home. He was stronger and much wilder than Clyde. The Medivet team put in a lot of effort and worked in shifts to encourage the two males to drink, eat and grow.

"It was such a privilege to bathe and feed them every day. We wanted to tell everyone about them so that the whole community could share in our wonderful and humble experience, but we had to keep it quiet for the safety of the animals," said Medivet Direklyniek vet Dr Jamiela Barnard.



Rescued, loved and released

With each of them weighing at least 200kg, they were finally strong enough to go to their new home. It took six men to load them into a wildlife trailer.

Helping these beautiful animals makes their work all the more worthwhile. It was a bittersweet but satisfying experience to see their rhino children go on 14 October. "We are proud and grateful for the experience, and we will miss our 'boys' but we are happy that they are back where they belong," Dr Jamiela says.

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Parents anxiously waiting to hear from kidnappers

FOUR POLOKWANE SIBLINGS STILL MISSING

Limpopo – According to police, the family of the abducted Moti brothers has not yet received any ransom demand from the kidnappers.

The police in Westenburg outside Polokwane launched a massive manhunt for the group of suspects who abducted the brothers at gunpoint from the BMW in which they were transported to school on Wednesday 20 October at about 07:00. The seven suspects were all armed with rifles. Apparently the 64-year-old driver fetched the children from Nirvana and was driving along the R37 near the N1 bypass when he was suddenly blocked by two vehicles, a white Kia Sorento and a black Mercedes Benz. As the gunmen, dressed in white overalls, got out they started firing sporadic shots in the air.

The suspects then forced the four children out of the vehicle into their Mercedes Benz and drove off towards the direction of the R81. According to brigadier Motlafela Mojapelo, the police traced the children's cellphones, it was found dumped at Flora Park. The provincial commissioner of police in Limpopo lieutenant general Thembi

Hadebe ordered a high-level search operation that also involves the airwing. The nation's thoughts and prayers are with the boys and their family.

New online service to allow motorists to renew and pay for license disks

SA – The Road Traffic Management Corporation (RTMC) has launched a new payment gateway enabled by First National Bank (FNB) that will allow motorists across South Africa to register, renew and pay for their license discs through the NaTIS online platform.

With over 2,4 million motorists renewing their license discs annually, this innovative service will enable them to save time by avoiding long queues, fines, penalties for late renewal and help to mitigate the spread of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The Road Traffic Management Corporation encourages motorists to use the online facility on the NaTIS platform to verify and update their addresses to ensure that the licence discs are delivered to the correct residential address.

Electrocuted while tampering with live transformer

Northam – Late Wednesday evening, 20 October, social media was abuzz when an 11kVa transformer on an Eskom pole exploded just outside town, resulting in a power outage in the area. An Eskom employee was on his way back from Rustenburg and witnessed the flash at one of the poles and immediately went to investigate. He came across a man, burnt beyond recognition, at the top of the pole and immediately alerted the police.

After back-and-forth calls, it was established that Thabazimbi Crisis Control was the only local emergency team with the necessary equipment and personnel who are trained to deal with this kind of scenario – a high-tension line rescue and removal.

“Our team was on scene at about 1am on Thursday morning, 21 October,” said Thabazimbi Crisis Control Centre (TCCC) operations section chief and director Henk Havenga. They planned their task carefully and after Eskom confirmed that the electricity was turned off on the grid, started with the recovery of the body.

The remains were handed over to the police's forensic pathology unit. Northam SAPS, Northam emergency medical services (EMS) and Provincial EMS were also on scene to assist.

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STABBED TO DEATH IN MATIKIRING

DUO REMANDED IN CUSTODY

Thabazimbi – Two men accused of murdering Jabu Mokhumo in Matikiring (informal settlement) were remanded in custody when they appeared before the Thabazimbi Magistrates' Court. Circumstances surrounding the death of 32-year-old Mokhumo, who was stabbed to death at around 04:00 on Sunday 3 October, are being investigated. Police spokesperson Titus Khumalo revealed that the two were arrested on 4 October and charged with murder. "The two suspects will be back in court on 26 October for a formal bail application. Ongoing investigations will shed more light on the murder," Khumalo said.

Northam – Hennie Venter was last seen in Northam on Saturday, 11 September. He was wearing black tracksuit pants and a red t-shirt. He took his dog and left his home on foot without telling anyone where he was going. Several leads were followed up which only came to a dead end, with Hennie still missing. "Nobody knows how heart breaking it is, we don't know whether he is dead or alive. Has he eaten? Is someone mistreating him? There are so many questions and no answers, yet we remain hopeful," a family member said. **Anyone that has information regarding his whereabouts should please contact sergeant Selolo on 082 319 9435 or the case handler Jaun van Staden on 076 553 4494.**

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Month-end fuel price hike could be ‘catastrophic’

SA – Current data is predicting fuel price hikes of catastrophic proportions at the end of October for November. This is according to the Automobile Association (AA) which was commenting on recent exchange rate and commodities data.

The current picture is showing petrol up by 99c a litre, and diesel and illuminating paraffin higher by a whopping R1.42 a litre. This will push 95 ULP inland above R19/l (close to R19.30/l), and R17/l for diesel. Taking this potential increase into account, the price of a litre of fuel inland (95 ULP) will have increased from R14.86/l in January to R19.30/l in November – a 30% increase over 11 months.

“The hikes in diesel and illuminating paraffin would be the largest in South African history, bearing in mind that this is only based on half a month’s data. R20 a litre for petrol is now a realistic scenario before the end of 2021,” says the AA, adding that it sees little hope of improvement before the end of October.

“Brent Crude has broken through the 85 US dollars per barrel mark and the basket of oil prices used to calculate South Africa’s oil price are following Brent higher. We note the concern this is generating in the USA, where President Biden was reported to have called on the OPEC+ cartel to increase oil output to stabilise prices. This has not generated a response from OPEC+, and our view is that a response is not likely, since the current price pressures are beneficial to the cartel’s members,” the AA notes. The Association says it does not expect the oil price squeeze to ease in the short term, especially as the demand for oil will increase as the north enters its winter season.

The AA further notes that over the first half of October, the average Rand / US dollar exchange rate jumped from around R14.55 to the dollar to R14.90. It says the Rand is still far above its June level of below R13.50 to the dollar but that the strengthening trend lasting nearly 15 months was abruptly reversed in June.

The AA says there is also uncertainty regarding changes to the Slate Levy. “The under-recovery to date this month has been vast, and the government will, in our view, have no option but to increase the Slate Levy to recover this deficit, making for a bigger hike,” it comments.
