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Northam – During a heavy downpour, a passer-by heard the faint cries of a baby in a veld just outside Northam on Monday 8 November.

Upon closer inspection, the community member came across a baby girl, wrapped in a plastic bag, crying her little heart out.

The police and an ambulance were summoned to the scene where the little girl was dumped in the bush, still lying in her bloody placenta. Her little shivering body was wrapped in a warm blanket supplied by a community member and she was taken to Thabazimbi Hospital.

“We are so happy she survived. I can’t understand how someone can abandon their helpless little baby like this. I pray that God blesses her in abundance. She might have had a rough start, but with her fighting spirit, she might go out and do great things,” a community member who was on the scene said. The mother of the child has not yet been found and police are investigating a case of child abandonment. In preparation for COP26, South Africa submitted a revised Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC) to reduce domestic carbon emissions within a target range for emissions of between 420 CO2-eq and 350 CO2-eq by 2030. This revised target is compatible with the ambitious goals of the Paris Agreement and represents our country’s best effort to confront climate change, which will have a devastating impact on sub-Saharan Africa without large-scale mitigation and adaptation efforts. Through the Political Declaration issued on 2 November, to establish this partnership, partner countries will mobilise an initial \$8.5 billion (R131 billion) over the next three to five years through a range of instruments, including grants and concessional finance, to support the implementation of our revised NDC through a just transition to a low carbon and climate resilient economy. Bold and ambitious actions are required from all countries to confront climate change and South Africa has consistently argued that developed economies must support a just transition in developing economies. Today’s Political Declaration represents a first-of-its kind partnership to turn these commitments into reality, and a model for similar forms of collaboration globally. At the heart of this partnership is the importance of a just transition, which includes support for workers and communities affected by the transition away from coal and enables the creation of quality green jobs. For the transition to be just, decarbonisation must be implemented in a manner that promotes and sustains employment, livelihoods and economic inclusion for historically marginalised communities and sectors of our society. A joint taskforce will be established to take forward the partnership over the coming months. Presidency (extracts of press release)

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Scammers are at it again!

[Letter to the editor]

Northam – I received an interesting call from a bank on Monday 22 November. At first, I didn't think much about it as I have an account with them.

The man on the line said that they've been looking into my account and that their records show that a company is deducting money from my account without my authorisation. According to him, because I have a contract with a well-known electronics company, they will assist me in having the amount reversed.

Being just before month end, I was thrilled to find out that the amount of R1,750 would be paid back into my account.

I was then informed that they will need my ID number, account number and card expiry date. Once I gave him this information, he told me to press *35*0000*16#.

Luckily, I had network problems, so the process failed. But he said that I should check my phone for an SMS that will confirm I will receive the reversed amount in the next 2 to 48 hours. He hung up and I didn't receive any foul play until I received an SMS notifying me about a failed online purchase due to insufficient funds in my account.

My savings are paid into another account and because it was just before payday, this account was empty. If they tried this trick two days



later, they would have succeeded in stealing all my hard-earned money. I immediately stopped my card. December is almost here, and scammers are doing whatever they can to score from what you have saved for the year. I want to urge the community to please be careful and not share any information over the phone.

Almost Scammed

By dialling *35*0000*16# some service providers block all incoming SMSs. This will prevent the victim from receiving the payment notification and then blocking the card before the scammers empty out the account.

We are all tired!

Thabazimbi – As 2021 is drawing to an end, people easily experience end-of-year fatigue. Many have reported that this year was exceptionally tough – or even the worst ever. Times have changed, and Covid-19 is not making things better. But what if this extreme tiredness is not just because it's this time of the year...?

Platinum Bushvelder spoke to doctor Anell Groenewald on what you can do to curb extreme tiredness and the reasons behind chronic fatigue...

Medical causes:

- Bacterial, viral and parasitic infections.
- Malignant conditions like cancer.
- Endocrine abnormalities such as an underactive thyroid gland.
- Autoimmune diseases such as rheumatoid arthritis and systemic lupus.
- Psychiatric conditions such as major depression and anxiety disorders.
- Organ failure such as heart and kidney failure.
- Low blood pressure.

Lifestyle: Factors that promote fatigue

- Poor, interrupted and too little sleep.
- Sleep apnoea is a condition in which the tongue falls back into your throat during sleep and blocks the airway. The person wakes up from time to time, in an attempt to keep his airway open and breathe.



Anell Groenewald shared some insight into chronic fatigue.

- Stress causes your body to secrete adrenaline and cortisol. Adrenaline is also known as the 'fight-or-flight hormone'. It's released in response to a stressful, exciting, dangerous, or threatening situation and prevents you from sleeping peacefully.

Diet
A diet high in sugar and refined starch can make you feel moody, drained of energy, and quickly hungry again. In contrast, a diet rich in fresh fruits, vegetables and proteins are a definite energy injection. Try to eliminate sugar and feel the difference.

Dehydration
Vomiting, diarrhoea, bleeding, excessive sweating and too little fluid intake will cause dehydration and leave you feeling drained. Try to take in two litres of fluids daily, especially in summer.

Chronic medication
Some medications cause fatigue as a side effect.

Environmental factors
In Thabazimbi, the heat definitely plays a role in people's energy levels. Heavy metal poisoning due to heavy metals in water and mercury in tooth fillings can also present with fatigue, among other things.

Poor absorption of vitamins and minerals
Some chronic medications cause ingested vitamins to not be adequately absorbed. We see this especially in diabetics and long-term use of birth control pills. Soft drinks and tea also lessen the absorption of iron. Intravenous vitamin therapy is extremely beneficial in these cases.

Intake of toxins
Alcohol, nicotine, drugs and caffeine only provide energy for a short period of time. Once it is depleted in can certainly cause chronic fatigue.

Lack of exercise
The fitter you are, the more energy you have. Make exercise a part of your weekly routine.

Too little off time and too little vacation
You are not a machine. If you don't make time to recharge and enjoy other activities besides

work, you will eventually burn out. Chronic fatigue is a symptom of burnout.

Thoughts
Thoughts are extremely important. If you have chronically negative and ungodly thoughts, you will be tired, tense and depressed. Examples are thoughts of unforgiveness and bitterness, thoughts that you are rejected by others and are not good enough. Fearful thoughts or thoughts that South Africa is perishing and that there is no hope for its people...
