

Brave little fighter

The snake bite marks on Martin Pretorius' head.

> Thabazimbi Nine-year-old Martin Pretorius of Spitskop, near Thabazimbi, was sleeping on the floor in their living room when he woke up with an excruciating burning sensation on his head on Tuesday 16 November.

He looked around and noticed a snake in the room. Martin woke his parents and calmly told them what happened and took them to where the snake was.

Martin's parents had him at Mediclinic within 10 minutes, together with the snake which they had to kill so that it could be identified at the hospital for the correct treatment.

The brave little boy had a terrible headache, stomach pain and nausea, but the worst was the agonising burning pain where the snake bit him.

Upon arrival he was treated by doctor Anell Groenewald. "I'm very grateful for the fantastic care he receives at the hospital. From the moment we arrived they made my son feel at home and ensured that he was a priority. Doctor Groenewald was very patient and took very good care of him," Martin's mother Coreen Pretorius said in an interview with Platinum Bushvelder.

It was determined that he was bitten by a full-grown Mozambican spitting cobra. He responded very well to the antivenom, with minimal swelling and no respiratory problems. He still complained about a headache, but was in good spirits.

Platinum Bushvelder went to visit him in hospital for an interview about the ordeal and he shared some advice: "I would tell kids to listen to their parents when they tell them not to walk alone in the bushes. I know this happened to me in my home, but the chances are much greater of it happening in the bush. I would also rather sleep in my bed next time and not on the floor."

Martin also jokingly said that he doesn't even mind that his hair had to be shaved off. "The hair of Petoorse grows quickly," he said. "And my mom has to cut my hair almost every week, so it should be back to normal soon."

On the evening of 17 November his condition seriously deteriorated. The wound started swelling and the doctors were really worried about him. At the time of going to print, his condition improved again, but he is not out of the woods. Keep this brave little boy in your prayers.

Doctor Groenewald shared a few tips on what to do if you find yourself in a similar situation:

- · Try to identify the snake that bit you. Being able to identify the snake can make a big difference. Different types of snakes require different antivenom and knowing what to give the patient can ensure that effective treatment can start immediately.
- Remain calm. If your heartrate rises, your blood starts pumping faster, which also means that the venom spreads faster.
- · Get to a hospital as soon as possible.

BAKKIE STOLEN, RECOVERED SAME DAY



Thabazimbi - Police are investigating a case in which a Toyota Land Cruiser bakkie was stolen from a farm outside Thabazimbi before it was recovered about 5 hours later in the Koedoeskop area.

The owner of the bakkie said he was not at the farm when an unknown number of suspects entered his property.

The foreman of the farm woke up at around 4am and discovered that both gates of the farm were broken and that the bakkie was missing.

Said Tracker consultant Alida Goodayle: "The vehicle was stolen at around 2am. Tracker SA as well as police officers from Makwena and Matlabas were involved in the search for the vehicle, which was eventually discovered at around

Police are investigating the incident and no arrests have been made yet.

Community members have been urged to safeguard their vehicles ahead of the festive season, which usually results in a surge of car theft incidents. "If you can, have a tracker installed in your vehicle," Goodayle urged.

Taken too soon

9-year-old boy drowns

Thabazimbi - The life of a family was forever changed when their nine-year-old boy drowned in a freak accident on Saturday afternoon, 13 November.

He was enjoying his afternoon with other children in the water when his arm apparently got stuck in an underwater outlet suction pipe. It is unknown how long the boy, who is said to be a strong swimmer, was stuck before the other kids noticed what was happening. They immediately raised the alarm. The boy's parents immediately started Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) after struggling to free him from the pipe.

Doctor Wynand Kruger met the parents halfway on their way to hospital and took over giving CPR to the boy (from them). Even with all the efforts by his parents, Dr Kruger and the personnel at the hospital, they sadly, could not

Dr Kruger, who is saddened by the death of this young boy, shared valuable tips for when tragedy strikes. "Time is of the essence, every second counts," he says.

He shared the following:

With a drowning or near-drowning, feel for a pulse.

- · If there is a pulse, but no breathing, give the patient one breath every 5 to 6 seconds.
- If there is no pulse, start with CPR immediately.
- · While performing CPR, get the person to a hospital as soon as possible.

"It is very difficult to be sure about the heart activity of a patient without a heart monitor. Sometimes you might not feel a pulse, but you would be able to pick it up on a heart monitor. Then only can a doctor assess if the patient needs to get an electric shock to restore normal heart rhythm." Dr Kruger went on to explain.

He says that even with a near drowning, it is extremely important to take the patient to the nearest hospital as soon as possible, as they always be part of you and those who were part are not out of danger and need to be monitored.

He gave the following tips on CPR:

- · To do CPR, use both of your hands in the middle of the chest of the person, and do compressions.
- You should do 100 to 120 compressions per minute. After every 30 compressions, you need to do 2 breaths.
- Doing CPR on a baby, a child and a grown up differs in approach, but the 30:2 - thirty compressions for two rescue breaths are the same.
- Remember, the chest needs to be compressed to compress the heart to pump blood.
- You need to open the airways of the patient, lift the chin, close the nose, and cover the persons mouth with your mouth. Look at the chest, the air must enter the lungs and not the stomach.
- Because a child's airway is more fragile than an adult's, use caution when providing rescue breaths and be careful not to tilt the head back too far. When providing chest compressions, use one or two hands, depending on the size of the child. The depth of compressions should only be three and a
- Great care should be taken when performing CPR on an infant. Although a baby's bones are more flexible, they're also much more delicate. Firstly, confirm that the baby is unconscious. Do not shake the baby; instead, shout and tap or flick the soles of the infant's feet. Do not tip the head back too far! Be very gentle when providing rescue breathing; don't use the full force of your lungs to expel air. Instead, use your cheeks and puff air into the infant's mouth and nose. When providing compressions, use two fingers at the centre of the baby's chest. Compressions should be about three and a half centimetres deep, also at a rate of 30:2 rescue breaths.
- In all cases, unless the patient comes to continue with the CPR until trauma personnel can take over.

"It is extremely important to get first aid training. It can be the difference between life and death," Dr Kruger added.

Leakages at both Regorogile reservoirs

Thabazimbi/ Regorogile - There are two reservoirs in Regorogile; the newly built 10 million litre (10ML) reservoir (called the Regorogile 10ML Reservoir) and the second is called 'the old Regorogile Reservoir'. The new reservoir was built next to the existing reservoir, which was connected to the existing infrastructure.

On Tuesday 16 November, the Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) issued a statement that unplanned water interruptions will take place due to "a severe leakage" at the

Regorogile Reservoir. The statement also said: "no restoration time given".

In an interview with Platinum Bushvelder on 18 November, TLM communications manager Joshua Motsomane confirmed: "The main leakage at the old reservoir is now fixed. The team is finalising the small leak at the new reservoir today."







WHAT'S THE CHEAPEST CIGARETTE OUT THERE?

SA - In a national study commissioned by the British American Tabaco South Africa (BATSA) published on 5 November, research was carried out into the cheapest purchase prices in the tobacco cigarette market. The study took place from 8 October to 3 November.

Researchers were briefed to ask the following question: "I want to by the cheapest 20 pack available", and/or "I want to buy the cheapest carton available". No price negotiations were allowed.

- The cheapest pack purchased was R8.00 and was purchased in Gauteng Wholesale. The R10.00 price point was prevalent in Western Cape, Free State, and Gauteng Provinces, with the Wholesale, Spaza, Tabletop/ Hawker channels where it was most prevalent.
- The foreign brand, Remington Gold (owned by or licensed to GLTC Zimbabwe) is the most widely accessible full study results.

- brand at the cheapest price point, at 59% selling below R21.60 and a purchase universe of 441 stores out of 748 stores.
- Pine (owned by or licensed to KTNG), had a higher incidence of R21.60 and below, although off a lower base, when in comparison to Remington Gold.
- Pall Mall (owned by or licensed to BAT) has a high prevalence in sample stores, however the brand is not sold at the cheapest price points.
- New brands, not purchased in the previous studies in 2021 and new to the cheapest prices purchase list, include Liberty (R18.00), Roxbury (R10.00 and R15.00), Chief (R10.00 to R18.00), Ecco Nano (R18.000), and GMB (R10.00).




