ALLEGED RAPIST REMAINS BEHIND BARS

Thabazimbi - It was a win for the Thabazimbi community as 20-yearold Stoffel Phole was denied bail on Tuesday 7 December.

Phole, who stands accused of raping a woman who was eight months pregnant at the time, as well as a 58-yearold woman, appeared before the Thabazimbi Magistrates' Court.

His attorney accused the state of only opposing bail to punish the accused and for political reasons such as 16 Days of Activism Against Woman and Child Abuse. The state made it clear that this was false, as the suspect had been arrested and started to appear long before the campaign began.

When asked, before court, about prior offences - the accused stated that he had none, which was a false statement. When questioned about it for a second time, he claimed that he forgot it.

Phole will remain in custody until his next court appearance on 20 January 2022. The Thabazimbi Local Municipality mayor Tokkie Swanepoel commended the police for the breakthrough on the case as it's an indication of government's

incidents violence inflicted on the vulnerable in our society.

Thabazimbi - A Thabazimbi resident arrived home on Saturday 4 December after a short trip to Rustenburg, only to find that his home was ransacked.

When he moved to Thabazimbi with his family, about 18 years ago, their house was broken into and looted. That's when they pulled out all the stops to upgrade their security. Over the years, they got an alarm system, installed burglar bars at all the windows, the fencing was upgraded, they got security beams and even a high-tech camera security system which they can access at any time to take a peek and see what's going on at their premises.

When the family left for Rustenburg – they even asked the neighbours to keep a watchful eye.

After all this, two suspects still gained access to their home.


Said TLM communications manager Joshua Motsomane: "Litter picking was done in partnership with Community Workers Programme (CWP) workers and reclaimers."

SA – Sweetheart scams are escalating in South Africa. Victims are groomed over long periods - lured into believing that they are involved in genuine romantic relationships and scammed out of hard-earned money, pensions and inheritances. Elderly ladies and widows are contacted via social media and online dating sites, enticed by handsome photos of stolen identities, religious phrases and sweet but empty promises.

Once they have ingratiated themselves with their victims and won their trust, the perpetrators usually fabricate poignant stories about why they would need money from their victims:

- · Taxes to release an inheritance.
- Essential overseas travel.
- Crippling debt.
- · Sick/dying child.
- · Travel money to meet the victims.
- Money for fleeing a country at war, where they were press release extracts

doing voluntary work, etc.

The fraudsters eventually intimidate and berate their victims when the money dries up. Some threaten their victims with exposure to family and friends. The perpetrators ruin their victims' lives and then disappear as soon as the payments stop. The victims are left financially devastated and emotionally humiliated and scared.

Early warning signs of a romance/ sweetheart scam:

- · They live in another country or far from you.
- The profile seems too good to be true.
- They ask you for money.
- There are always excuses for not meeting you in
- · They write in poor English.


