

Not being fitted with lights like provisional protection of the Madimatle Mountain and its caves because of the site's cultural and religious significance. Talks of an appeal made the rounds in 2017..

And then in 2020... SAHRA, which is tasked to sites, determined on 14 October 2020 that the land should be considered as a provincial heritage site by the Limpopo Heritage Resources Agency. Upon investigation, it found that the cave and the mountain have unique attributes that make them culturally and spiritually significant and that it ought to be protected. The process to grade the site is

Meanwhile, Aquila (an Australian held and owned mining company) sold the land and ceded its mining rights to a BEE company, Motjoli.

On 17 December 2020, the High Court ordered Motjoli to immediately stop its mining activities application of the site and the court remarked about the lack of public participation and community engagement that preceded the grant of the mining right.

The contested piece of land is also highly regarded as sacred land by not only the people of Madimatle but by people across Africa seeking healing or taking part in traditional initiation practices.

Peet van Breda, who is a regular visitor at the caves over the past 15 years, cautions visitors that the cave is deep and slippery. "It is important that if you pay it a visit, you don't do it alone." The entrance leads downhill and if you want to go deeper, you will have to climb down. "Wear shoes with a good grip and make sure your flashlight is fully charged," he added. "And beware of the bats!" You have to take safety precautions and tell someone if you head there... Who knows how many days can pass by before the cave gets its next visitor?

There are also old letters in the cave, written by visitors over a long period of time to their ancestors and thirteen old grave sites on the mountain. Referring to the countless broken clay pot shards in the cave, Breda said: "It's a traditional practice to - if a man's wife dies, he breaks a pot in the cave and prays. His new wife then has to make a

He graduated from South African School of Theology in 1986 and served for a short period of time under the missionary ministry of the International Assemblies of God, where his love for missions was elevated to new heights. He began a new life of prayer and preaching. He was 18 when he delivered his first sermon.

He married Messina Ouma Mokgope in 1985 and together they have three children Isaac, Yolande and Ezra. Their ministry together has allowed them to plant churches in four countries. Today the ministry - New Covenant Fellowship International – boasts more than 10 satellite churches and has birthed countless Pastors and Leaders across the country. Mokgope is also the founder of NCA high school and primary in Northam - which are all accredited institutions with the Department of Education and Umalusi He is survived by his three children, one grandchild,

Myra Mokgope, and a multitude of spiritual sons and daughters. His children will forever remember him saying: "Once my assignment is done, I will go home to my Heavenly Father," he said. "I look forward to that with great peace and joy, leaving behind my legacy to

CHILDREN RAPED

Thabazimbi – Another rape (two in this case) reported to Thabazimbi authorities... A 13and 16-vear-old started the new year with hurt, anguish and pain. According to police spokesperson constable Titus Khumalo, the accused, Letlhake Lebogang (21) stands trial for two counts of rape, kidnapping and pointing a firearm. The incident was reported on 1 January 2022 and Lebogang was arrested later that same day. Lebogang appeared before the Thabazimbi Magistrates' Court on 10 January. The case was postponed to 19 January for a formal bail application. At the time of going to print, the court's decision was not yet available.

Constable Khumalo urged: "I implore the community to be whistle blowers and report these types of crimes to the police immediately." He also warned: "If you are committing any violent crime, you will land

ALLEGED RAPIST REMAINS BEHIND BARS

Thabazimbi – It was a win for the Thabazimbi community as 20-year-old Stoffel Phole was denied bail on Tuesday 7 December before the Thabazimbi Magistrates Court. His next court appearance is set for Thursday 20 January.

Phole stands accused of raping a woman who was eight months pregnant at the time, as well as a 58-year-old woman. When asked, before court, about prior offences - the accused stated that he had none, which was a false statement. When questioned about it for a second time, he claimed that he

CAT BURGLARS BUSTED

Thabazimbi - Two suspects were nabbed on Tuesday 11 January and charged with several house burglary cases. Several cases were opened at the Thabazimbi Police Station and the startling number of burglaries were also reported to Dinare Security. One of the residents alerted Dinare Security when they saw suspicious-

looking individuals. They, together with CPF and the police, rushed to the scene and arrested the alleged burglars. When searching the area, they recovered some of the stolen items and also confiscated illegal firearms, ammunition, game carcasses and drugs. Investigations continue.
