



Thabazimbi/ Northam – The tragic loss of life in accidents over the past year on the R510 prompted a multi-disciplinary team to run road safety campaigns in Thabazimbi on Tuesday 5 April and in Northam on Friday 8

The team is making an all-out effort to create awareness and to address issues causing accidents on the R510. The Limpopo Provincial Traffic department teamed up with representatives from the Thabazimbi Traffic Police, the Department of Transport and Community Safety, the Thabazimbi Local Municipality, the Road Traffic Infringement Agency (RTIA), the Thabazimbi Police, the Northam Police, the Administrative Adjudication of Road Traffic Offences (AARTO) outlet, the Department of Home Affairs, Marakele National Park and Anglo American Platinum's Amandelbult Complex protection services

The joint road safety campaign left several drivers red-faced. More than 220 vehicles were pulled over and 21 fines were issued for unroadworthy vehicles. One vehicle was also impounded because the driver had no permit and two Pakistani nationals were detained for being in the country illegally. All of the vehicles which were pulled over were checked for roadworthiness and licenses, and the licenses and permits of the drivers were also checked. The vehicles were also searched for illegal items – including rhino horn.

Said RTIA programme manager Grace Mogashoa: "Road safety is everyone's responsibility. This partnership is vital to curb the carnage on our roads."

Nduvheni Mummai, station commander of the Department of Transport and Community Safety pointed out: "Many fatal accidents are caused by unroadworthy vehicles."

SERIAL SCAMMER

PART 2

Background

Rustenburg – *Platinum Weekly* was made aware of a man pretending to be a lodge owner in our area, so we set out to investigate. We ended up going down a rabbit hole of scams. The audacity of this serial scammer is mind boggling. We are placing only one or two of his scams per week in our newspapers. At the time of going to print, we already interviewed several of his victims. This serial scammer is also extremely dangerous and armed. He was recorded online, taking out his gun and threatening to shoot another man.

His scams almost play out like a movie... except it's not. It's real life and it's real people who lost real money. It is a pity, however, that only some of his victims have opened criminal cases at SAPS. In some of the cases his scams appear to be nothing more than a power play... a need to impress the ladies...

More and more victims are coming forward and *Platinum Weekly* aims to expose all of his scams in the weeks ahead. We hope to warn people about his *modus operandi*, so that they don't get caught in his web of lies. Hopefully he will be brought to book soon so that we can reveal his identity.

How low can you go?

Farmers in the Northern Cape are still struggling because of long periods of droughts. Various initiatives are run nationwide where farmers or organisations assist struggling farmers with fodder for livestock. The Helpful Farmer (victim 3) who also assist struggling farmers, was referred to Mr Scammer as a person who might also be able to assist.

He corresponded with Mr Scammer who told him that he is willing and able to help him — he apparently had more than enough fodder to give away and a truck to deliver it with. All he asked the farmer was the delivery costs from Rustenburg to the Northern Cape. The cost of this trip, Mr Scammer said, "amounts to about R15,000" but the "generous" Mr Scammer said that they only have to pay over R11,000. Desperate to help those in need, the Helpful Farmer (victim 3) agreed and paid over the money. The fodder never arrived.

Scamming the scammer

There are many people who are currently looking for Mr Scammer, whether it is to get a summons delivered or to give the details to SAPS. Victim 4 was almost successful in tracking him down. She managed to get Mr Scammer's latest contact number and reached out to him. However, the person on the other side said that he is not Mr Scammer but that he knows where Mr Scammer is.

He told her that Mr Scammer is part of the mafia and that he is always surrounded by bodyguards but that if she pays him R500, he will go and take photos of Mr Scammer and forward it to her to track him down.

She immediately knew it was a scam but decided to play along. When she asked for his banking details, she was asked to send the money via a money transfer at a local store, as he apparently does not have a bank account. He then contacted Victim 4 again and again, asking for the money, but she just kept telling him that the money is on the way. Frustrated with having to wait for the money, he told her that "it is clearly not that important for you to find Mr Scammer and that you are lying about the money". Her response: "This is just a taste of your own medicine Mr Scammer"... Needless to say, he immediately blocked her number on his phone.

In part one Mr Scammer manipulated one of his victims by telling her that his daughter has died. Not only was the 'daughter' he was referring to alive and well, but the *Platinum Weekly* was told that the daughter is not his daughter, but the daughter of his girlfriend.



CHRISTINE'S MURDERER ON TRIAL

Thabazimbi – Christine Robinson (59), a retired British teacher, was brutally attacked, raped and murdered on 31 July 2014. The Thabazimbi community took a stand against farm murders when the man suspected of killing her appeared before the Thabazimbi Magistrates' Court on 13 August 2020.



She was stabbed several times before the murderer cut her throat. Police reports said she was raped and stabbed to death in her bedroom.

The 30-year-old employee, her gardener, who is suspected of the murder was finally arrested on 31 July 2020 on the sixth anniversary of the brutal murder. During the court appearance, the Thabazimbi community drove around the courthouse displaying signs and honking their hooters.

Christine's niece tracked down the suspect in a honeytrap operation.

Andrew Ndlovu, 32, who now goes by Andrea Imbayarwo, appeared before the Polokwane High Court on Monday 11 April 2022. He pleaded not guilty to rape and murder before the case was adjourned until the trial on Wednesday 13 April 2022.

But prosecutor George Sekhukhune said that Ndlovu's semen was found in Robinson's room, placing him at the scene of the crime. Ndlovu (from Zimbabwe), fled to his home country after the attack but returned to SA several times under false names.

An accident waiting to happen

Thabazimbi – Over the past few years, several truck accidents at the T-junction at Total Garage on the R510 were recorded. In some of these accidents, the drivers of the trucks were killed.

According to a local truck driver, the road leading to this T-junction takes serious negotiating, especially if it is carrying a heavy load. He says that drivers who don't know this treacherous piece of road, often misjudge it.

In *Platinum Bushvelder's* issue of 12 April 2019, we reported on a truck accident on 8 April at the same spot in which the driver was killed. He also lost control of his truck for reasons 'unknown'. That was the second truck accident that year at that spot. There were six truck accidents at the same spot in 2018.

In the latest truck accident at this spot, the trailer of the truck was fully loaded with scrap metal. The driver lost control of the truck, which went straight through the T-junction ending up on the railway line. The driver's cabin dislodged and ended up on the other side of the railway.

We spoke to Thabazimbi's Traffic Department acting traffic manager Isaac Pheto, who said: "We cannot confirm the reason for the accident. There are some allegations about the vehicle's roadworthy status, fatigue and human error that might have caused the driver to lose control." He says that the newly-erected road traffic signs were damaged or vandalised and that the department is having talks about the feasibility of constructing an arrestor bed.

"I ask truck drivers on this road to comply with the laws of the road. There are several signs when you come down the R510, asking heavy duty vehicles to gear down. Remember, if you push your truck to go faster down this road, you are pushing your death warranty also," Pheto said.

Owner of Eagle Mountain Spur and Total garage, Jacques Blaauw, whose businesses are a stone throw away from the accident spot says: "This is a ticking time bomb. The liability on the government's part is significant, especially if a life is lost. They need to take action."

Snake in the grass

Critical shortage of antivenom

Thabazimbi - Reptile Inc co-owner Petrus van Breda in Thabazimbi had a busy month. During March he caught a Mozambican spitting cobra, three snouted cobras, three mambas, one puff adder and a boomslang. Some of them were caught in town and others on smallholdings surrounding Thabazimbi

As humans expand their territory, they start moving into the territory of other species. Inevitably, snakes will end up in yards and houses on smallholdings and the suburbs - a thought that makes most people a bit uncomfortable.

Regardless of how you feel about snakes, what is truly worrisome is the fact that there is a critical shortage of antivenom in South Africa, should your snake encounter end up in a bite.

South African Vaccine Producers (SAVP) are the only manufacturers of antivenom in South Africa. African Snakebite Institute's Johan Marais said that no stock is available from the manufacturers... "There is more than enough venom to make

the antivenom, there is just not enough antivenom currently being produced," Marais

There is enough antivenom for emergencies only. Now that hospitals can't keep stock on hand, they will have to order from the SAVP and wait for it to arrive - when they encounter an emergency.

"Polyvalent antivenom, which costs just under R2,000 per vial, covers the venom of mambas, most cobras, the rinkhals, puff adder and gaboon adder. Black mamba victims are usually started off with 12 vials but may require as many as 20 vials," Marais said. This is also troublesome for vets that have to treat animals that are bitten by snakes.

The Platinum Bushvelder spoke to the SAVP about the antivenom shortage. They said that they are currently performing mandatory Good Manufacturing Practice validations and that routine production will commence once these validations are completed.

Puff adders and Mozambican spitting cobras are two snake species that are commonly found in our region.



SA - The Department of Health published new regulations under the National Health Act which will effectively act as a long-term permanent replacement to South Africa's state of disaster Covid-19 regulations.

Mozambican spitting cobra The Mozambiqan spitting cobra is fairly common and classified as very dangerous Being spitting cobras, these their venom at a distance of about 2 meters. The venom of a Mozambique spitting cobra is cytotoxic, meaning those who are bitter experience tissue damage accompanied by pain. However, a more serious condition arises if their venom comes into contact with a person's eyes as it can lead to blindness.

Puff adder

A puff adder relies on its excellent camouflage. It gets its name from the way it inflates itself and hisses when threatened. Consider the hissing sound of a puff adder as a warning. It has one of the fastest strikes of all snakes. Their venom is potently cytotoxic, causing severe pain, swelling, blistering and in many cases severe tissue damage. Polyvalent antivenom is effective and should be administered immediately.

The African Snakebite Institute's website explains the intricate process of making antivenom. The snake venom used to make the antivenom is sourced from individuals and companies locally and elsewhere in Africa. The SAVP make antivenom by hyper immunising horses, a process that takes around nine months during which small quantities of snake venom are injected into horses, not enough to harm the horse, but enough to trigger its immune system.

The amount of venom injected is gradually increased as the horse becomes more resistant to the venom.

Once immune, blood is drawn from the horse at two-month intervals and the serum is removed from the blood, the latter is returned to the horse and the serum purified. It is bottled in 10ml vials in liquid form.
