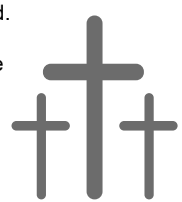

Thabazimbi – Tania Stone lost everything when her house burned to the ground in the early morning hours [1am] of Thursday morning, 21 April. Despite Tania losing her home and all of her belongings, she thanks God that she and all her animals made it to safety unscathed. She sifted through the remains and the ashes to see if she could salvage anything and the assessor is still to determine the financial and structural damage to the house.

In an interview with *Platinum Bushvelder*, she told us of the chilling account: "I couldn't sleep the night before the fire, because we had no electricity due to loadshedding," she said. "It went off at about 23h00 and came on again at 1am."

Shortly after I smelled smoke. "The fire started on the second floor in a spare bedroom I use to store equipment and goods for Thabazimbi Animal Rescue (TAR). When I opened the door to this room, I saw flames coming out of the aircon, reaching the ceiling. Although the official cause of the fire is unknown at this stage, I suspect that it was the aircon that short-circuited when the electricity came on again."

In haste, she phoned her colleagues Magda Stewart and Annelie Pelser to make the emergency call to the fire department and others that might be able to help, while she was running up and down, making sure her four-legged animals were unharmed.

Fire Department late and problems with their pump

The Waterberg Fire Department's unit is stationed in Thabazimbi because we don't have our own fire department.

"The fire department took about 30 minutes to pitch up and it took them another 30 minutes to try and get their pump to work. In the end, they used my swimming pool's water to try and douse the flames, but by then, it was too little too late," Tania says.

Evacuating her pets to safety

Tania is the founder of TAR. She and her team take in strays (and in some cases wild animals) and they help people to adopt these animals which are kept in kennels at TAR. They mainly rescue, rehabilitate, and rehome animals in need.

It only came natural to Tania to take in strays herself because of her love for animals. She made sure all her pets were taken care of when the fire broke out. Her little darlings include four baby tortoises, two baby doves, one baby squirrel, seven parrots, one cockatiel, five Yorkie crossings and five cats. "Three of my cats ran away but returned unharmed on Monday 25 April. The baby animals needed a place to stay while being rehabilitated."

"Most importantly, I thank our Heavenly Father for keeping me and my animals safe. I can replace earthly belongings, but a life cannot be replaced," Tania said.

TAR needs equipment, food and winter blankets

When Tania and her team ask the community for help, they always heed her call. "I feel terrible about the items which were donated and purchased, which were destroyed in the fire. It leaves a sombre picture for the cold winter ahead," Tania told *Platinum Bushvelder*. "Any animal food, blankets or assistance will be greatly appreciated. THABA FIRE AND RESCUE IN KZN

Thabazimbi/ KZN – Five Thabazimbi Fire and Rescue volunteers travelled to Kwa-Zulu Natal on Tuesday 19 April and returned back home on Saturday 23 April. They assisted in the search and rescue operations.

“A big thank you to our sponsors who made this trip possible,” said volunteer Kobus Malan.

The team joined forces at the joint operation centre (JOC), stationed at Virginia Airport in Durban – from where the search and rescue ops were ran by volunteers, police officers and the army. Everyone at the JOC were split up into teams and deployed.

“Our team focused on reported missing persons. The K9 unit assisted to help indicate where we had to start digging,” said Malan.

On Wednesday (as seen on photo) the team discovered a mom and her young daughter (age estimated at 8 years). The girl was declared dead on scene and the mother passed away in hospital shortly after. The father of this family was found deceased by another team the day before. “It’s difficult to talk about it, I can’t even imagine what the survivors are going through,” Malan said.

“In total, we recovered six missing bodies – all of which we had to dig up,” Malan added. “Although we worked well together, I try to remember as little as possible about the ordeal.”

The Thabazimbi Fire and Rescue volunteers also joined the SAPS airwing on Friday scouting down the coast for bodies.

Much to their surprise, the team returned to a hero’s welcome in Thabazimbi on Saturday. They were met with open arms by the Police, Traffic Department, GPF, TRF, Dinare Security and mayor Tokkie Swanepoel.

Relentless bushveld rain

Thabazimbi/ Northam – In Thabazimbi, Northam and surrounds [the heart of the bushveld], several people reported that they already measured more rain for 2022 to date than they measured for the whole of 2021.

According to Thabazimbi Local Municipality disaster manager Gerrie Visage, the road leading to Kromdraai (the R516) was inaccessible on Wednesday 13 April and three bridges were damaged and flooded.

On the Klipgat road, direction Rooiberg, the low-water bridge was flooded. Emergency personnel was dispatched to rescue a woman stuck between Rooiberg and the bridge.

On the road leading to Verdrag, when passing Marakele, the bridge was also under water.

In Northam, there were reports of several RDP houses and streets that were flooded on 16 April. “In Northam, six bridges flooded,” Visage confirmed.

On 17 April, the following rain metre readings were reported:

- Koedoeskop: 82 mm
- Thabazimbi, ‘Jan Plaas’: 98 mm
- For this season alone, Jan Plaas documented more than 1,000 mm rain.
- Kromdraai: 70 mm
- Leeupoort: 110 mm
- Rhino Mine: 110 mm

“We urge the community not to underestimate the power of water. Don’t go near fast-flowing water and never enter it. Videos being sent around included kids playing in the water that dammed up in Northam – in the flooded streets. This poses a serious drowning risk. Please take care!” said Visage. Several floods across South Africa over the past few weeks left thousands stranded. More than 400 people sadly lost their lives in KwaZulu-Natal in the floods and massive multi-disciplinary team efforts from government and private sectors have been rolled out to assist.

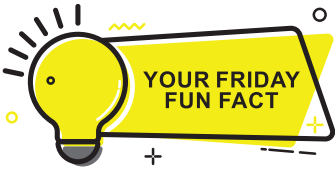
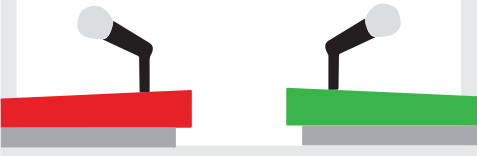
