According to the Department of Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs (COGTA): 'The work of the council is co-ordinated by a mayor who is elected by council. The mayor is assisted by an executive or mayoral committee, made up of councillors. The mayor together with the executive also oversees the work of the municipal manager and department heads.' Now that is a hot seat. Everyone expects results from council and the mayor and they are usually also first in line when there is a need to blame someone.

Ten years ago, it looked as if all was lost for Thabazimbi Local Municipality. The municipality was bankrupt. Total mismanagement of the municipality's assets, its employees and its funds by former officials and/or council led to the municipality's assets being seized daily. The Platinum Bushvelder even reported on their computers and chairs being carried away by debt collectors.

In 2017 The TLM had to negotiate their way into a reachable payment plan for the rest of the historic debt of R 225 million due to Eskom. Without these negotiations, Thabazimbi would have been left without electricity.

It was a succession of small miracles and a lot of effort and the help of local mining companies and industry which brought the municipality to where it is today. The municipality has come a long way, but there is still much to be done. On social media and WhatsApp groups, it is clear that the people of Northam and Thabazimbi expect the Thabazimbi Local Municipality... and most of the times council and mayor Tokkie Swanepoel to come up with quick fixes for service delivery problems caused by decades of neglect of infrastructure.

On Wednesday 15 June, members of the South African Municipal Workers' Union (SAMWU), marched from the municipalities technical department, past the mall, down Warmbad Weg to the municipal offices where they read a 'Memorandum of Demands' to mayor Tokkie Swanepoel, before handing it over to her.

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Extracts of the memorandum:

SAMWU demand that the municipality settle the debt of COIDA with immediate effect or at least the 20% that which is required.

SAMWU demand that the municipality should fill the vacant positions as soon as possible.

SAMWU demand that employees in the Planning and Economic Development be treated equally by the current acting Municipal Manager who is a Director PED by appointment.

SAMWU demand that any sort of victimization to its members should cease with immediate effect.

SAMWU demand that employees should be taken for medical examinations within seven days.

SAMWU demand that all politicians/councillors should stay away from administration.

SAMWU demand that municipality adhere to the Occupational Health and Safety act by providing employees with PPE.

SAMWU demand that employees be trained.

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Molorwe (close to Moruleng) –
For two years, National Council of Societies for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals (NSPCA) inspector Matome Semenya and inspector Oageng Mosito remained steadfast in obtaining justice for a dog they rescued during the investigation of an animal abuse case that the NSPCA will never forget. On Thursday 9 June 2022, NSPCA inspectors Matome and Oageng honoured their duty as inspectors, when they won the NSPCA case against Samuel Modise, a man who has brutally beaten a dog and buried the animal alive in his backyard. On 13 April 2020, the NSPCA responded to a gut-wrenching complaint in Molorwe village, North West. The owner of the dog informed the NSPCA that her dog had been brutally attacked by her neighbour, Samuel Modise, and that Modise refused to let the owner see her dog after the attack. The NSPCA was accompanied by members of SAPS to Samuel Modise's property, where Modise admitted to violently beating the dog with a spade and a brick. He further claimed that the dog had died. Modise attempted to conceal the body from the NSPCA stating that the dog had already been buried. Eventually, with the assistance of SAPS, the NSPCA was able to obtain the location of where the dog's body was being kept by Modise - a bush behind his property. When the shallow grave was dug up by the NSPCA inspectors, they made the shocking discovery ... the dog... was still alive! The dog was found severely injured, covered in blood and certainly breathing her

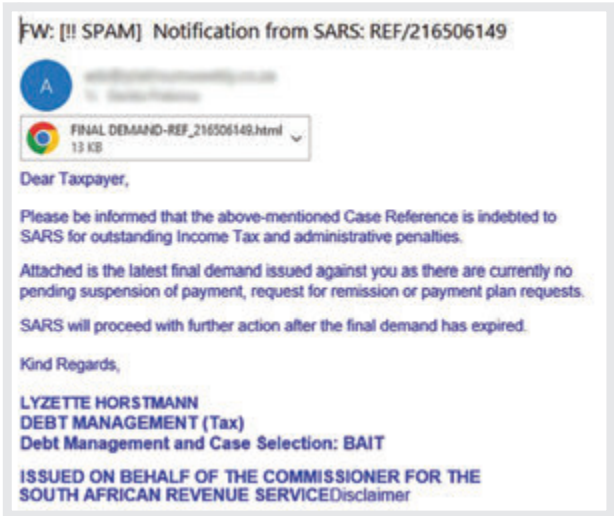

last in excruciating pain. Given the extent of the injuries that she sustained, the only kindness the NSPCA could extend at that point was to humanely euthanise her, surrounded by people who would never forget her torture, and would fight for justice to be served!

A case was then opened against Samuel Modise by the NSPCA. Both, NSPCA inspector Matome and inspector Oageng remained dedicated to obtaining justice for the dog, and pursued this case religiously for the past two years. Modise even attempted to have the case withdrawn from Court, claiming that he was trying to protect his goats from the dog, but NSPCA inspector Matome fiercely defended the NSPCAs case to keep it in Court. Magistrate Herbert Modiba, from the Mogwase Magistrates' Court, found Samuel Modise guilty on all counts. Modise was fined R1,000 for his crime, and now has a criminal record. The NSPCA hoped that Modise would have faced direct imprisonment for his crimes. Samuel Modise used a spade and a brick to beat the dog so violently that her eye even popped out of its socket. Modise then, knowing the dog was alive and in pain, intentionally inflicted further suffering to the dog by burying her alive – condemning her to a slow and torturous death. These acts of violence by Modise can only be regarded as premeditated, inhumane and barbaric. There should be no place in society for humans that display such aggression to helpless victims! BEWARE: Cybercriminals targeting taxpayers



SA – Cybercriminals typically pretend to be reputable companies in a fake message, which contains a link to a phishing website... or worse. Fake SARS phishing emails is currently doing the rounds. People randomly receive emails made to look as if these emails were sent from SARS using words like 'final demand' or 'admin penalty' and ask you to either click on a link to view the letter or have an attachment to click on. However, the moment you click on the link, it takes you to a malicious website address designed to steal personal, financial, or account information.

How can you protect yourself from phishing scams?

- Do not open or respond to emails from unknown sources.
- Beware of emails that ask for personal, tax, banking and eFiling details like login credentials, passwords, pins etc.
- According to SARS's website, they will never request your banking details in any communication that you receive via post, email, or SMS. However, for the purpose of telephonic engagement and authentication purposes, SARS will verify your personal details. Importantly, SARS will not send you any hyperlinks to other websites – even those of banks.
- SARS does not send *.htm or *.html attachments.
- SARS will never ask for your credit card details.

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Smith's attackers' court case postponed AGAIN

Rooibokkraal – Ten suspects who stand accused of attacking Elmarie Smith with an axe and a panga on Thursday 13 January 2022, appeared before the courts again on 1 June 2022. They were supposed to appear before court on 18 May, but the case was postponed. The case was postponed again to 20 June for formal bail applications.

The suspects, Leonard Nyathi, Behiso Nyathi, Nkiwane Zibagiso, Musagwawi Ndlena, Leroy Ndebele, Thandzawe Sithole, Nhlahla Ngwenya, Sibanda Nkanyise, Muhuahua Wetti and Vises Khumalo are facing charges of possession of a firearm and robbery with aggravating circumstances.

Smith was seriously injured when she was attacked by the men shortly after 5pm on 13 January. Her partner, Kruger, is the owner of Kukama Lodge, which is an 85km drive [north-west] from Thabazimbi, just North of the Atherstone Nature reserve – in the Rooibokkraal area.

Apparently, Elmarie was in the garden, busy discussing work to be done the following day, with one of her employees, when she was attacked from behind. Her daughter was watching TV and Kruger was in their bedroom. Their daughter and Kruger were not injured.

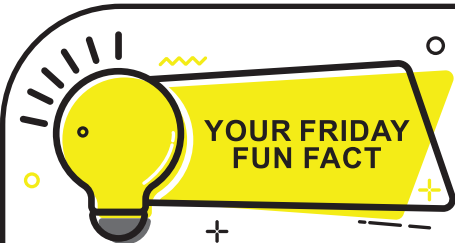
