When doing so, make sure you keep an eye on the snake, as they can easily disappear, which would then take up a lot of time for the snake catcher, which is usually a voluntary service, to find it."

"The bigger pythons will start getting out of their holes and some of their eggs will either start hatching now, or has already hatched. They will start looking for a place in the sun," Van Breda says.

Prevention is better than cure. Be alert and gain as much knowledge of local snakes as possible. If you find yourself in an uncomfortable situation with a snake, or you want to organise an educational outing for people or learners, contact Petrus van Breda on 079 897 5611.

Truck veered off the road

The driver of a truck travelling on the R511, to his leg and a head injury, but the passenger lost control of his truck when a front wheel tyre burst. The truck veered off the road, down the embankment, hitting a tree before capsizing.

The accident occurred on Tuesday 9 August at around 12:30 midday, between the Northam turnoff and the Pienaarsrivier bridge, about 80km from Thabazimbi. The truck was on its way to Johannesburg when the accident occurred. The driver sustained moderate injuries, with a cut

was seriously injured. The passenger sustained internal injuries, an open wound to his back and feet and a gaping wound to his chest.

Thabazimbi Fire and Rescue (TFR) also responded to the scene. They said that Trauma Rescue quickly responded to the accident scene, where they stabilised the passenger before taking him to the Thabazimbi Hospital.


Do you know your neighbour's name?


