DC van Eeden is part of the Matlabas Plaaswag and Marchell van Eeden is a volunteer at Thaba Fire and Rescue. Their courage and medical knowledge were put to the test when Marchell had to give birth in their vehicle on Wednesday 17 August, while they were away on vacation in Sodwana Bay.

Marchell was 24 weeks pregnant and because it was a healthy pregnancy so far, they decided to go on vacation before baby Ulrich's arrival, expected in November.

They arrived in Sodwana on 13 August, hoping to get a good rest and quality family time. A few days later on 16 August, just as they were getting ready for bed, Marchell started to complain about a pain in her side. Marcell woke DC up at around 00:30 and said that she wasn't feeling well. She suspected that she might be in labour. They contacted their doctor and he advised that they get to a hospital as soon as possible. However, the nearest hospital was Mseleni Provincial Hospital, and it was about 40 kilometres away.

They were on the road for about 6 kilometres when Marchell calmly asked DC to stop the vehicle, because she just gave birth to their baby boy. DC immediately stopped the vehicle and assisted Marchell to get the amniotic sac off the baby's head. Marchell started patting the baby on his back, to get the fluid out of his lungs and started Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR), as DC continued on to the hospital.

They were greeted with open arms when they finally arrived at the hospital, but unfortunately the hospital did not have an incubator and Ulrich had to be put on a normal bed, with a heat lamp on him. Little Ulrich weighed only 595 grams and was 26cm tall and his chances of survival was not looking good. DC and Marchell comforted their newborn and each other and started to pray. A miracle happened while praying – his oxygen shot up from 64% to 94%. The doctor came running in, saying that Ulrich was clearly fighting for his life.

A drip was inserted into his bellybutton, while

they waited six hours for an ambulance with an incubator to arrive. Ulrich was transported to Netcare The Bay Hospital in Richards Bay. Almost a month after Ulrich was born, he started breathing better on his own, his brain function was at 100% and his chest x-rays came back clear.

The excitement was short lived as later that night he stopped breathing three times because his tongue kept slipping back into his throat and his vocal cords were swollen. He was put back on the ventilator on 16 September because he stopped breathing when they gave him milk. His blood count was a little low and he had to be put back on an intravenous fluid drip.

The drip was taken out on 18 September, and he was put on anti-biotics, because they found a minor infection count in his blood. Things finally started to look up for little Ulrich by 19 September. He started lifting his head and his skin is getting thicker, so his veins are not as noticeable anymore.

The hospital staff started calling him *Inkosana*, which means 'little prince' in Zulu and the doctors are happy with his progress.

The family would like to thank Trauma Rescue's Ryno Dempers who assisted them through the whole process telephonically. Dempers has also put them in contact with all the right people.

In an interview with *Platinum Bushvelder* Thaba Fire and Rescue's Pierre Loots said that they are all very excited to meet Ulrich. "He is a true fighter and needs to continue getting strong, so that he can start taking the reins at Thaba Fire and Rescue," Loots said jokingly.

Matlabas Plaaswag also shared a special message: "Little Ulla, you a true example of being strong and persistent. You are a real little fighter and you have become an inspiration to all of us. You reminded us that the Lord's Grace is beyond comprehension. Daddy, DC and Mommy Marchell, we know that the Lord will give you strength during this time and our prayer is that little Ulrich will grow from strength to strength and that you will all come home soon. We pray Psalm 91 over you, but we pray Psalm 91:16 especially for little Ulla."

Platinum Bushvelder spoke to Demper about what to do if you don't have any medical experience and find yourself in a similar situation.

- Most of the times there will be warning signs, but it can happen unexpectedly with no signs at all.
- It is important that the mother lies down on a clean surface, clean towels are a good go-to item.
- Make sure that the patient is comfortable.
- This is a natural process, and the body will deliver the baby naturally.
- It is important to keep supporting the baby's head and the baby's body.
- Do not pull on the umbilical cord.
- If the umbilical cord is around the baby's neck, try to get it off as carefully as possible, but do not tear it!
- As soon as the placenta is out, take something like a shoelace and tie the umbilical cord about the width of your hand away from the baby's tummy.
- Measure two fingers away from the shoelace and make another knot.

- The umbilical cord can then be cut between the two tied knots.
- It is important to make sure that the umbilical cord does not have a pulse anymore, its only safe to cut the umbilical cord when no pulse on the cord is present.
- It is important to take the baby with the placenta to the hospital.
- Dry the baby off as soon as possible, they lose heat very quickly, so make sure the baby is kept warm. Especially the head.
- If the baby is not breathing, you will need to give the baby CPR until he/she breathes on its own.
- There may still be some of the fluid in the baby's mouth, nose, and lungs. This need to be sucked out.
- Tap the baby under his feet or bum to help stimulate him to breathe.
- As soon as the baby is awake, try to breastfeed immediately.
- At the end of the day, you need to go to the hospital as soon as possible.

The fact that DC's baby is born this early and survived is a miracle!

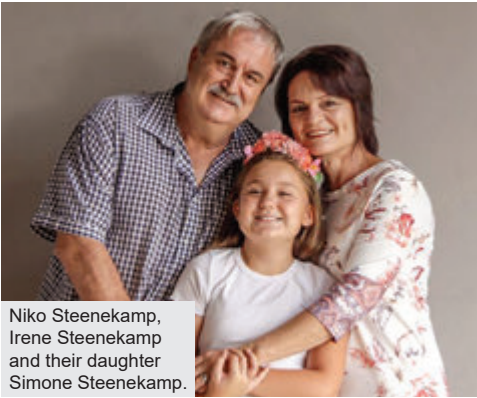

Suspects in Steenekamp's murder remain in custody

Maroelasfontein/ Northam – Two suspects, Thabang Koos Moruwa (30) from Mokgalwaneng village, and Bhekimpilo Trevor Ncube (38), a Zimbabwean national, both appeared before the Northam Magistrates' Court on Friday 16 September. The duo is suspected of being involved in the murder of Niko Steenekamp and are facing charges of murder, house robbery and theft of a motor vehicle. Steenekamp's bakkie was found abandoned on the Maroelasfontein [gravel] road on 6 September. His stepdaughter Christine Abreu de Jesus raised the alarm on social

media and several organisations launched a search and rescue operation to help find Steenekamp. It was later established that some items from Steenekamp's farmhouse were missing which indicated foul play. At around 3pm Steenekamp's body was found on his farm. Investigations led to the arrest of five suspects. According to a close family member, the first suspect (Thabang Koos Moruwa) who was an employee of Steenekamp, implicated three other suspects but later changed his story. Police spokesperson sergeant Fortune

Madisa confirmed that the three suspects could not be linked to the murder and have since been released. Moruwa then pointed the finger to a fifth suspect, who was then arrested. The case was postponed to 26 October and the accused will remain in custody until then.

32% Eskom increase?

SA – “It is cold comfort to many South Africans to hear news of stage 5; the economy, especially small businesses which are supposed to create 90% of jobs in 2030, is suffering from the rolling blackouts,” says John Dlodlu, SBI CEO. “Load shedding is undermining everything we are trying to achieve as a country – from growth to jobs and poverty reduction,” he added. On the first day of hearings on Eskom's tariff application to the National Energy Regulator of SA (Nersa) on Monday 19 September, Eskom's chief financial officer Calib Cassim said that even if Eskom is relieved of R200 billion in debt, the company will soon be back in the same position if it doesn't significantly raise tariffs, cut costs, and get people and municipalities to pay their bills. Eskom is asking for a 32% increase for 2023/24. NERSA invites members of the public to submit comments on the Consultation Paper on the Eskom's proposed Retail Tariff Restructuring Plan. NERSA would like to encourage all stakeholders and the public to actively participate in this process by submitting written comments, in line with the issues raised in the consultation paper, to ERTSA@nersa.org.za. **The closing date for written comments is Friday 8 October 2022.**

Suspect on most wanted list arrested

Brits – The long arm of the law finally caught up with a man who was on the police's top 50 list of most wanted suspects in the North West province. Chris Sithole – who also used the alias Leon Nkomo – was arrested on Tuesday 13 September on the Musina border in Limpopo. He was then transported to Brits to face seven separate cases of rape, three of robbery as well as one of housebreaking and theft. Sithole appeared before the Brits Magistrates' Court on Wednesday 14 September 2022 and was remanded in police custody. He will make a second court appearance on Friday 7 October. Police spokesperson brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone confirmed that Sithole committed these crimes from January 2012 to February 2021, in and around the Brits area. “In one of the cases, the accused allegedly raped a woman in May 2012. A couple was travelling along the N4 close to Bokfontein, near Brits. Bricks were placed on the road, but as the driver tried to avoid it, the car overturned. Three men helped them out of the car wreckage, and then took turns to rape the woman,” Mokgwabone added.

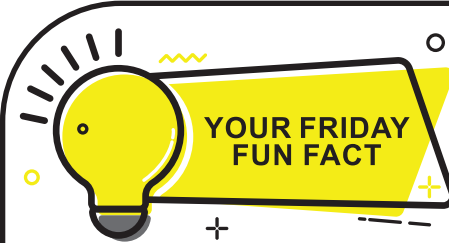

If you see a fire, report it immediately!

Thabazimbi – Raging fires are not an uncommon sight in Thabazimbi and surrounds during the months of August and September. The shortage of rainfall over the past two months increased the risk of wildfires. Thaba Fire and Rescue had their work cut out for them and was up and about these past few weeks. The team is made up of volunteers. Some are permanently employed at other establishments and yet, they never hesitate to lend a helping hand.

Recently, they had to deal with the following incidents:

- On 11 September a fire started at Anglo American Platinum's Amandelbult 2# shaft and started to spread to Northam Platinum mine. The fire spread for five to six kilometres. Thaba Fire and Rescue left at about 1pm from Thabazimbi and fought the fire in cooperation with the mine's firefighters. The fire was brought under control shortly after 5pm. The cause of

the fire is unknown. Fifteen volunteers assisted to stop the blaze.

- On 12 September, a call for help was sent all the way from Matlabas on the Sentrum Road, 80 kilometres from Thabazimbi on the R510 Ellisras Road. The cause of this fire is also unknown. The fire was right next to a farm and at the time the call came in, there were four bakkies with people already struggling to control the fire. Unfortunately, a lodge burned down in the process. Thaba Fire and Rescue departed from Thabazimbi at around 2pm and 13 volunteers assisted.
- On 17 September, the community of Kromdraai was discouraged when another fire broke out after they have been fighting and controlling fires in Kromdraai on 15 and 16 September. It was massive and uncontrollable and it quickly spread through four plots and was on its way to the fifth. Kromdraai is close to Leeupoort and is about 103 km from Thabazimbi on the Brits Road. Thaba Fire and Rescue was called

to help fight the fire. They left Thabazimbi at approximately 2pm and the fire was brought under control at around 21h47. Thirteen volunteers assisted.

Pierre Loots, founder of Thaba Fire and Rescue, pleads with the community to be careful not to cause runaway fires. "It not only leads to structural damage, but the lives of people and animals are at risk."

In an interview with *Platinum Bushvelder*, councillor Tokkie Swanepoel, mayor of Thabazimbi Local Municipality said that Thaba Fire and Rescue is always ready to step up to the mark when help is needed. "I would like to thank each and every one of the volunteers. I am extremely proud of you," she said.

Mike Bolhuis comments on the Unlawful entry on Premises Bill, 2022



SA – On 12 August 2022 the Department of Justice and Constitutional Development issued a notice in the Government Gazette, inviting public comments on the proposed *Unlawful Entry on Premises Bill, 2022* (the Bill).

The deadline for public comment closed on 16 September. Refer to our previous articles published on our website and Facebook page regarding the unlawful entry on premises bill.

In the interim, Mike Bolhuis, Specialist Investigators into Serious Violent & Serious Economic Crimes, gave additional comment to our readers as food for thought.

He said: “The main concerns of the proposed bill are...”

- Law-abiding citizens are prescribed what to do in the event that there is an ‘intruder’ on their premises. It seems to be prescribed for instances where there is no real and/or immediate danger.
- My question posed is, therefore, what effect does this act have on emergency situations such as burglaries and life-threatening events?
- Does it take away the personal defences and right to protect yourself, others, your property and/or someone else’s property?
- My suggestion would therefore be that a clause be included to explicitly protect the abovementioned right and personal defences in that it does not preclude same.
- It is furthermore unclear what the legislator intended when proposing section 8 in that an authorised member of SAPS will be the person to deal with these instances where an intruder refuses to evict themselves. This seems to be impractical especially in the event that the act is intended to affect personal defences.
- It is lastly unclear as to what is meant by an experienced SAPS member. It also poses the question as to whether this will then preclude any other SAPS member from dealing with these matters as they will be seen as unauthorised. This in my view will have a negative impact on the administration of justice and the authority a police officer holds.
- It is unclear as to how many ‘authorised’ SAPS members there will be per district and how this will be established.

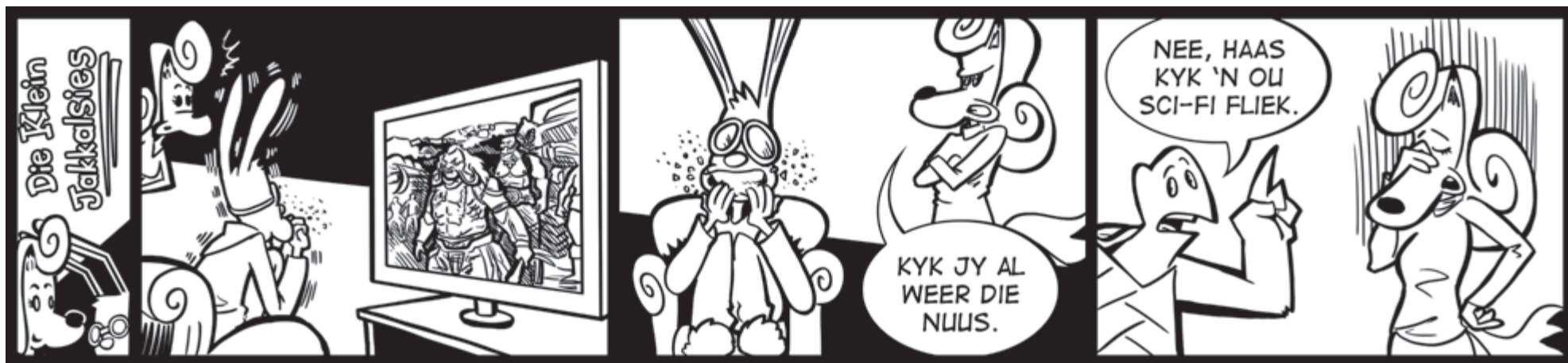

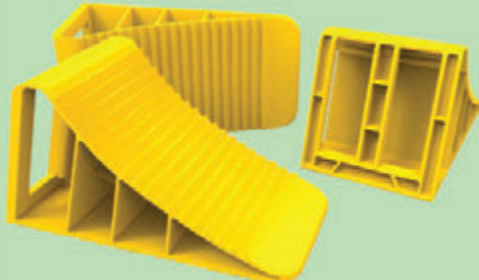

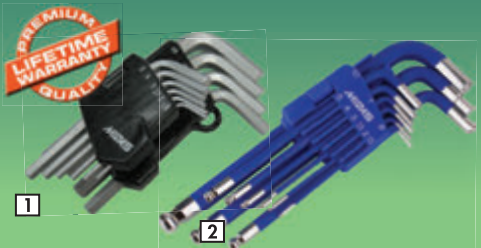
