SJ Malan shares his recipe to effectively and cost-efficiently fix a pothole.



Thabazimbi – All South African road users are working towards their PHDs in becoming professional pothole duckers, and Thabazimbi is no different.

We dodge them in the mornings on our way to work while our coffee flasks spill over, and we keep an eye on them when dropping off and picking up the kids from school. Some of us have even lost a tyre—or two—when we've been unable to dodge the pesky craters in our streets.

For this reason, *Platinum Bushvelder* reached out to one of Thabazimbi Fire and Rescue's (TFR) directors SJ Malan to find out how a community member can temporarily fix a medium-sized pothole at a cost that comes cheaper than a tyre.

What you will need to fix the pothole:

- Circular saw (optional)
- 115 mm or 230 mm diamond blade
- 25 kg tar premix

Prices including VAT at local hardware stores

- 115 mm diamond blade between R41,00 and R57,00
- 230 mm diamond blade between R148,00 and R175,00
- 25 kg tar premix between R100,00 and R136,00

How to go about it

1. Place cones or a warning triangle around the pothole to warn oncoming traffic. Ideally, have someone to help control the traffic.
2. Sweep the designated area with a broom to remove dirt and debris. This will ensure that the area is clear and safe for cutting.
3. Mark a circle around the pothole with chalk.
4. Use a circular saw with a diamond blade. Diamond blades are strong enough to cut into the tarred road. Depending on the size of your grinder, you will use either a 115 mm diamond blade, or a 230 mm diamond blade. If you don't have your own circular saw, find out if you can borrow one from a friend. If all else fails, you don't need to cut the circle, but it does make for a neater job.
5. Turn on the circular saw and bring the blade to full speed. Make sure that you use protective eyewear, a facemask, gloves, and earplugs when operating the saw.
6. Ease the blade into one end of your marked line, then slowly slide the blade along the cut line until you reach the other end of the line.
7. Remove the tar cuttings with a shovel.
8. Clear all debris from the pothole.
9. Dump the 25 kg tar premix into the hole.
10. Using a levelling tool or even a plank, spread out the tar evenly. Ensure that the hole is properly filled and that it is level with the rest of the road.
11. Beacon the area off for approximately 48-72 hours before allowing traffic to pass over the filled hole.

Lesedi needs a new wheelchair

Northam - Monene Sekhula experienced complications during the birth of her son Lesedi Sekhula. Approximately four months after his birth they noticed that something wasn't right as Lesedi couldn't sit up by himself. It was later suspected that Lesedi had sustained brain damage during birth, and because of this, he is unable to walk or talk. Over the years, Lesedi and his mother created their own form of sign language to communicate.

Today, Lesedi is 10 years old, but it has not been an easy road for him and his mother. *Platinum Bushvelder* interviewed Monene on Tuesday 4 April 2023 to find out what they need to make their lives a little easier. "Lesedi can only eat certain foods as he struggles to swallow. Even *pap* is a no-go for him—no matter how soft you make it. His digestive system is also not functioning properly, and taking a bath is no easy task," Monene said.

Monene would like to place Lesedi in a special needs school, but she is unemployed as she looks after her son full-time. Another challenge is that the special needs schools she has investigated cannot take him in because he cannot feed himself. The family is also facing another problem; Lesedi's wheelchair is broken, and he is in dire need of a new wheelchair.

Monene and Lesedi reside in Northam and need a helping hand. If you can assist them with nappies, medicine, food, or a wheelchair, contact Monene on 072 490 1314.

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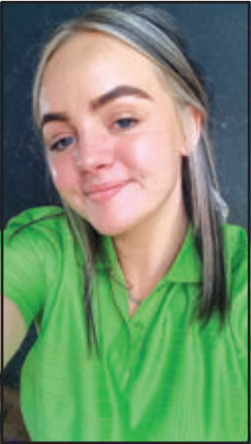
