Notorious accident spot claims another life

It is suspected that brake failure caused the truck to overturn at the Lephalale/R510 intersection.

Thabazimbi - At approximately 07:25 on Tuesday 18 April 2023, a truck towing a heavy load of bagged raw materials overturned across the road from the Thaba Junction at the Lephalale/R510 intersection.

Sadly, the driver, reportedly a Zimbabwean national, was declared dead at the scene. It is suspected that the truck's heavy load, along with the notorious downhill (all the way from Thaba Nkwe) overburdened the trailer's brakes and ultimately caused brake failure. The truck driver tried to negotiate a turn at the intersection, trying to avoid going

over the T-junction over the railway line, and overturned into a ditch next to the R510. Thabazimbi Fire and Rescue's Pierre Loots commented that it has been a longstanding plea to the Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) and SANRAL to add a sandpit/arrestor bed alongside the Thaba Nkwe downhill where trucks can turn in case of brake failure/breakdowns.

Platinum Bushvelder has reported on numerous accidents at this very spot over the years. The Thaba Nkwe downhill needs serious negotiating, since trucks carrying

heavy loads frequent it, and drivers who don't know this treacherous piece of road, often misjudge it.

According to Thabazimbi Department of Traffic and Law Enforcement acting manager, Isaac Pheto: "We are appealing to motorists and road users at large to be more cautious when approaching the corner of Warmbad Weg and Lephalale Road R510 (junction) near the Total garage, no matter what time of day. Vehicle owners are urged to ensure roadworthiness of their vehicles before operating on the public road. The accident scene in question needs

to be declared as a high accident zone. We will engage with the Department of Transport and Community Safety to join hands with the municipality to construct an arrestor bed in line with the regulation. Our traffic personnel will continue to enhance the free flow of traffic while the process unfolds and attend to public safety matters at large."

Attending to the scene were: Thabazimbi and Limpopo provincial traffic officers, Thabazimbi Fire and Rescue (TFR) personnel and other emergency services.

Alleged child abusers back in court

Thabazimbi – The three suspects who face charges of sexual assault, child neglect, and assault with the intent to inflict grievous bodily harm, appeared in the Thabazimbi Magistrates’ Court on Monday 17 April 2023.

A man was initially arrested with two other women on 26 January 2023 after it came to light that a child was sexually assaulted and that two children were brutally assaulted with a cricket bat.

On 8 February, the two women were granted bail of R1,000 each while the man was granted bail of R2,000 on the first charges, but he remained in custody after an additional charge of sexual assault was filed against him. He was released on 13 March 2023 on R2,000 for the first charge, and R500 for the second.

The trio’s next court appearance will take place on 19 May 2023.

TLM launches clean-up campaign

Thabazimbi – The Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) councillor Judith Mogapi launched a municipality-wide illegal dumps clean-up campaign on Thursday 13 April 2023 in a bid to create clean communities around the municipality.

The 10-day campaign kicked off at the Regorogile four-way stop park, where the councillor addressed the attendees before picking up some litter. They proceeded to clean illegal dumps at Regorogile Park. One of the areas they cleaned was causing problems with litter flowing into the road next to Regorogile’s old cemetery.

They will be cleaning Regorogile and its surrounds and

then head towards the Northam areas. “We call on all residents of our municipality to keep our environment clean and to dispose waste in black refuse bags. Moreover, to pick up litter when it’s incorrectly disposed of. No one should ever litter. All of us can take a minute to pick up litter and encourage others to do the same,” said councillor Mogapi.

Councillor Mogapi welcomed the assistance and partnerships from both SAMANCOR Western Mine and Siyanda-Bakgatla Platinum Mine. She further thanked the Community Work Programme, Expanded Public Works Programme, Marakele SANParks and all community members who participated.

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Cable theft leaves community in the dark

Thabazimbi/Ipelegeng – Thabazimbi Local Municipality (TLM) sent out a notice of an unplanned power outage in Ipelegeng on Thursday 13 April 2023.

According to their statement, several houses were left without power since the previous night due cable theft. Cable theft is exceedingly inconvenient and frequently renders residents without electricity for extended periods of time. All foundries, smelters, and scrap metal merchants should not buy cables that are suspected of being stolen. Theft of copper is an extremely risky crime that results in financial loss, particularly in the upkeep of infrastructure, accumulating costs of safety and security services, policing, court counsel, and sentencing. “We request the community to be vigilant of suspicious activities and report suspected cable theft to law enforcement,” said TLM communications manager Joshua Motsomane.

Thabazimbi - When Shona McDonald’s daughter, Shelly, was born with Cerebral Palsy, their family faced challenges most could never imagine. Unable to sit or move around independently, with no available devices, Shona drew on her sculpting background to design Shelly’s first mobility device. The customised postural support made Shelly’s care easier and safer and opened new possibilities for fun and learning. Underpinned by a belief that all children have the right, and ability, to be included Shonaquip Social Enterprise (SSE) was founded in 1992 with two team members working out of Shona’s garage. They have since only grown in strength. At the beginning of February, the SSE team headed to Thabazimbi. Here team members Joyce Mokgele, Bonolo Mothupi and Rebecca Mashatole—who are also parents of children with disabilities—took to the streets. They have been going door to door in Thabazimbi, Northam, Dwaalboom, Rooiberg, Raphuti, Chromite and Kromdraai, to find disabled children who need wheelchairs. After a child in need has been identified, the child is assessed and measured for his/her wheelchair, as they have different types of wheelchairs. These wheelchairs can be bought from SSE but thanks to funding, they are able to donate wheelchairs to those who are in dire need.

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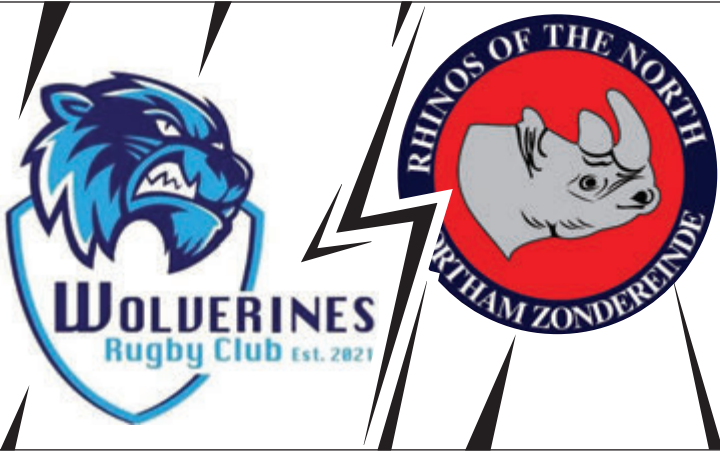
