

The response from the community has been overwhelming. People from all walks of life came together, offering a helping hand

in the search for Mac. This unity demonstrates how adversity can bring people closer together, having compassion for others.

Rooiberg/ Thabazimbi - In a display of community solidarity, people have been set into action following the disappearance of 23-year-old Mac Mc Alister. When the search for Mac started, he was last seen in the early hours of Monday 20 November 2023, which sparked concerns for his well-being.

In the meantime, the 2012 Toyota Hilux bakkie (which belongs to his employer) was found in Rust de Winter. Mac's mother shared that Mac apparently left the bakkie in front of a farm in Rust de Winter. The farmer contacted Mac's employer. Apparently, Mac sold his cellphone in Rust de Winter and got into a taxi with an unknown female. Lizell Mc Alister and Mac Mc Alister, the parents of Mac, have tirelessly continued their search for their son. Understandably, the ordeal they are experiencing is having a significant impact on them.

The young man deviated from his normal routine on Sunday 19 November. Mac, who resides in Rooiberg, left for work - on a farm in the area - at around 16:00. Later the same evening he spent some time with friends. However, alarm bells rang when he failed to show up for work the following morning. He was seen in Setaria at around 02:00 on Monday morning, when he dropped off a friend - at which time he apparently said that he is going to return to the farm.

Adding to the mystery, camera footage captured his vehicle, a 2012 Toyota Hilux extra cab with the registration CJG 665 L, on the R511 at the Assen Road turn-off at around 04:45 on Monday.

Described as 1.83 metres tall, weighing 75 kg, with short blond hair and blue eyes, Mc Alister was last seen wearing a white golf shirt, beige shorts, and he was barefoot. His concerned parents reported him missing at the Rooiberg Police Station (case number 1291/11/2023).

Additionally, the Thabazimbi Community Policing Forum (CPF) and Thabazimbi Fire and Rescue (TFR), along with numerous community members, initiated a search party on Wednesday morning at 06:00. The extensive search included farmlands in the Koedoeskop and Setaria areas, with the support of a helicopter and an information command centre in Koedoeskop. This incident not only highlights the distressing nature of Mc Alister's disappearance but also the strength and compassion of the Thabazimbi, Rooiberg and surrounding communities in times of crisis.

SUSPECTED FOOD POISONING CLAIMS LIVES OF TWO CHILDREN **IN BRITS**

Police in Brits have initiated an inquest following the tragic deaths of two children, aged three and 10. The investigation was launched after a suspected case of food poisoning occurred in Sonop, just outside Brits, on Friday, 17 November 2023. Reports indicate that a 32-yearold woman prepared a meal consisting of pap, chicken feet, and wheat for her family. Both the family and three neighbouring children ate the meal before going to bed.

In the early hours of Saturday, 18 November 2023, everyone that ate the meal started showing signs of illness, including vomiting. Despite the swift arrival of an ambulance, one child was pronounced dead at the scene. Others, including the woman who cooked the meal and the neighbor's children, were rushed to Brits Hospital for urgent care. Tragically, a second child succumbed at the hospital, and two more children were subsequently transferred to George Mukhari hospital for further treatment.

"Authorities are actively investigating the incident, including the collection and testing of food samples," spokesperson for SAPS, brigadier Sabata Mokgwabone said. This event adds to a growing list of similar incidents across the country, where children have fallen ill due to consuming contaminated food.





Under section 27 of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act 59 of 2008, "No person may (a) throw, drop, deposit, spill or in any other way discard any litter into or onto any public place, land, vacant erf, stream, watercourse, street or road, or on any place to which the general public has access, except in a container or place specifically provided for that purpose. The Act also provides for fines to be issued to people contravening the law.

Over the past week, *Platinum Bushvelder* spoke with two troubled residents, both fed up by the persistent rubbish issue in Northam, particularly the illegal stalls and littering in Ruby and First Street, which escalates the problem. Periodically, large amounts of this litter are cleared, only to rapidly accumulate again.

One resident appealed to the Thabazimbi Local Municipality for a stringent enforcement programme, urging law enforcement to issue fines to those guilty of littering or illegal dumping. He emphasised the public's role in helping law enforcement identify offenders.

Questions arise: Why is there a passive acceptance of this litter? Why is waste only periodically removed in large quantities? As a start - why permit people and businesses to litter and pollute?

After consulting another perturbed community member, who also expressed her concerns on social media, *Platinum Bushvelder* relayed these community grievances (whilst maintaining anonymity) to the Thabazimbi Local Municipality. In response, the Municipality shared photos of their refuse collection trucks at work in Northam's extension 6 and promised attention to Ruby and First Street thereafter. This second concerned community member queried, "Why does the councillor for ward 8 fail to acknowledge and report this situation to the municipality?"

The issue extends beyond mere uncleanliness. Growing evidence suggests that the environment significantly influences mental health.

Despite worrying unemployment rates, it remains crucial for business standards, encompassing safety, hygiene, and environmental stewardship, to be maintained, even in less formal settings.

Thabazimbi - Archery in Thabazimbi is a family-oriented and highly competitive sport. The Thabazimbi Archery Club aims to balance social aspects with a weekly gathering at the Koos Cronje Shooting Range. Every Tuesday from February until the end of November, archers gather for fun shooting and archery practice.

The Indoor season is a highly competitive aspect of target archery. Indoor rounds are normally shot at 20 yards at targets mounted on butts. Indoor events are held in school halls and sports

clubs across the country, combining to make archery a true year-round sport. The Thabazimbi Archery Club participates in the International Field Archery Association (IFAA) indoor standard round. This conducted indoors in a diversity of shooting styles with endless variations of equipment. Anyone may join, novice and experienced archers, and hunters alike. For the Individual qualification round, archers shoot 60 arrows at a distance of 20 yards. Each archer will shoot five arrows in four minutes on a five-spot face or a single face target.

Cubs will shoot at 10 yards. The archer may choose either the single spot or the five-spot target face. Indoor archery is lots of fun, but for safety reasons, has a

number of rules, such as:

- All arrows will be scored and recorded before touching or drawing any arrows.
- An arrow cutting through the line between two rings and touching the area of higher value shall be scored the higher value.
- Witnessed bounce outs or arrows passing completely through the target shall be re-shot.
- Hits on the wrong target will be scored as misses.
- An arrow dropped by an archer on the shooting line may be re-shot if it lies within 10 feet of the shooting line.

The last arrows for 2023 will fly at the Thabazimbi Archery Club on Tuesday, 28 November, starting at 17:45 for the Free State Indoor Competition, which will be held as a virtual competition. All scores across South Africa are submitted to the South African International Field Archery Association (SANIFAA). Winners will be announced on sanifaa.org. za.
