TRAGIC ACCIDENT CLAIMS TWO LIVES

occurred on the Northam-Brits road on Saturday, 17 February 2024, prompting a swift response from emergency services and bystanders.

According to an eyewitness, the cause of the accident is unclear. "I saw a massive dust cloud, a sure sign that something had gone terribly wrong. Then a truck sped past, and then all of a sudden, I saw a young child lying in the road," he said.

The witness quickly pulled over to offer assistance, discovering a Nissan that had been involved in a serious accident. Upon closer inspection, he found three adults in addition to the child, all of whom appeared to be severely injured, one in the road, one beside the road. and a woman trapped in the vehicle.

"They really got injured badly!" he recounted,

Northam - A devastating road accident having called for emergency services and specifically requesting the 'Jaws of Life' to free the woman trapped in the wreckage.

Another vehicle stopped to help. Despite the gravity of the situation, there was a glimmer of hope as the child and the woman trapped in the vehicle survived the ordeal. Sadly, the accident claimed the lives of two other individuals

Eagle Trauma Rescue was among the first responders to arrive at the tragic scene. The team worked diligently to provide immediate care, transporting the injured child to the provincial hospital for further treatment. The accident, involving a vehicle with a driver and three passengers, has left the community in mourning.

Thabazimbi – In a startling incident that could have ended much differently, a major collision between a Toyota Hilux and a Ford Ranger occurred at the intersection of 8th Avenue and Frikkie Meyer Street in Thabazimbi on Wednesday afternoon, 14 February 2024.

Miraculously, the occupants of both vehicles, a woman and two children in the Ford Ranger and a man and woman in the Toyota Hilux, sustained only slight injuries despite the severity of the crash. Images from the scene show the Toyota Hilux in a devastating state after it rolled several times, highlighting the dramatic nature of the

Emergency services, including Thabazimbi Fire and Rescue, Public Protection Services (PPS) Thabazimbi, Trauma Rescue, Thabazimbi Police, as well as the Thabazimbi Local Municipality's fire department and traffic officials, swiftly responded to the scene. Their quick action and coordinated response played a crucial role in securing the area and providing immediate assistance.

All individuals involved were transported to a local hospital as a precautionary measure to assess their injuries.

The community extends its heartfelt gratitude to the emergency services and volunteers for their dedication and swift response.


