PAWS Care Network's Sterilisation Drive in Swartklip

Swartklip – In an uplifting display of compassion and community spirit, PAWS Care Network, an organisation dedicated to animal welfare, recently hosted a spay and sterilisation drive. The event, held at Laerskool Platina in Swartklip on the 27th and 28th of April 2024, aimed to make a positive impact on the lives of animals and their owners, while promoting responsible pet ownership. Despite being held in Swartklip, the event drew support from various corners, with people traveling from Northam, Thabazimbi, Swartklip, Rooiberg, and other neighbouring areas to participate and support the cause. Dr. Jamiela van der Walt, the head veterinarian and co-founder of PAWS Care Network, expressed her gratitude for the overwhelming response. "Our goal was to sterilise and spay at least 100 cats and dogs to reduce the population of unwanted animals and prevent the spread of diseases," she said. "We are thrilled to announce that we exceeded our target, with about 200 animals that received the care they need."

The success of the event was not just in the numbers but also in the spirit of community care that was tangible throughout. The support from local guesthouses, who generously provided lodging for the PAWS team and veterinary students from Onderstepoort Veterinary Academic Hospital, and from Kapele Diesel, who facilitated sponsorships, was truly heartening. Equally inspiring was the dedication of the volunteers who selflessly gave their time and effort to ensure the event's success. A heartfelt thank you is also extended to Laerskool Platina for graciously hosting the event at their premises and for providing food throughout the weekend. "We are deeply touched by the outpouring of support from the community," said Dr. van der Walt. "Their kindness and generosity have made a significant impact on the lives of these animals."

The team from Onderstepoort Veterinary Academic Hospital comprised 12 registered veterinarians accompanied by final-year veterinary students providing invaluable assistance. The event also highlighted the importance of accessible veterinary services for those who cannot afford it. PAWS Care Network continues to provide post-operative care, ensuring that the animals are well looked after even after the event has ended. Dr. van der Walt emphasised the significance of such initiatives, stating, "Our mission is to make veterinary services accessible to those who would otherwise not have access, including individuals from informal settlements, pensioners, the unemployed, and those who cannot afford to travel to veterinarians in their town."

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LIFE IMPRISONMENT FOR 11-YEAR-OLD NIECE’S RAPIST

Thabazimbi/ Rooibokkraal – The Thabazimbi Regional Court has handed down a life imprisonment sentence to a 43-year-old man who brutally raped his niece in December 2020 at Snymanslaagte, Rooibokkraal.

The provincial commissioner of the South African Police Service in Limpopo, lieutenant general Thembi Hadebe, welcomed the verdict, praising the diligent work of the Thabazimbi Family Violence, Child Protection, and Sexual Offences (FCS) unit in securing the conviction. During the trial, it was revealed that on 11 December 2020, the accused lured his niece into his bedroom under false pretences. Once inside, he locked the door and subjected the 11-year-old girl to a horrific sexual assault before releasing her.

The victim’s ordeal came to light when her grandmother noticed blood stains on her underwear while bathing her. Upon questioning, the victim revealed the crime to her grandmother, who promptly informed the victim’s mother. A case of rape was then registered with the police. Colonel Malesela Ledwaba, reporting on the case, stated that the docket was transferred to the Thabazimbi FCS Unit and assigned to Sergeant Mohlatlego Modubi for thorough investigation. Through diligent work, the suspect was arrested, leading to his conviction on Tuesday, 30 April 2024, and subsequent sentencing to life imprisonment.
