

Beware the donkeys on the road!



I am writing to highlight a pressing issue affecting our community: the tragic fate of donkeys along the road between Thabazimbi and Northam. Every day, these poor animals — including pregnant jennies and foals — are being struck by cars and trucks.

This not only endangers the animals but poses serious risks to motorists as well.

Disturbingly, I've heard that certain individuals may be instructed to shoot donkeys to prevent accidents, though I cannot confirm this. There are also whispers of poisoning, which is equally concerning. Years ago, a local company ran a system where stray donkeys were kept in a fenced area for two weeks, giving owners time to reclaim them. After that, unclaimed donkeys were reportedly sent to a lion farm. Sadly, it seems this

initiative has long since ceased.

Even more unsettling are claims that these donkeys are transported to Lesotho in December, where they may be slaughtered for meat and skins. If this is true, it represents a grotesque act of animal cruelty.

We, as a community, must act! Can we reinstate the old system or find a better solution? Perhaps we can work with sanctuaries or advocate for more humane measures to keep the donkeys off the roads.

I urge fellow residents to come together and help end this cruelty. Our community is stronger when we stand for compassion and safety for all.

Significant strides have been made since the Provincial government's intervention, leading to noticeable enhancements in the efficiency and effectiveness of these critical services.

areas. He led the campaign 'Red Ons Dorp,' engaging with the community and addressing key agricultural issues impacting the region. Platinum Bushvelder had the privilege of sitting down for an interview with John Steenhuisen to discuss some of the critical challenges faced by the agricultural sector and his vision for the future.

Q1: What are the biggest challenges the agricultural sector in the Thabazimbi area is facing, and how do you plan to address them?

"The people are struggling with water, which is a huge problem in the area. Another issue is the application for mining licences, which pose a significant risk to both conservation areas and farmland. It's crucial that we preserve agricultural land and these conservation areas. We also face challenges with droughts and natural disasters, which are affecting farmers. Additionally, farmers need substantial support with accessing capital, particularly patient capital that helps them expand their operations and become more successful. Lastly, municipal infrastructure — like poor roads — hinders the ability to get products to markets and limits the tourism industry's growth. If the town isn't equipped to attract tourists to local game farms, the whole economy suffers."

Q2: How is the government supporting small-scale and emerging farmers in terms of training and access to markets and financing?


"We run a number of initiatives to support emerging farmers. At the lower end, we have the Pezie Presidential Stimulus initiatives, which provide vouchers for small-scale farmers to access essential inputs like fertilisers. For larger farmers, we offer blended finance schemes, where funds from the private sector, the Land Bank, and the department are pooled, giving farmers access to capital. The Land Bank, now back on its feet, provides crucial finance. Furthermore, the Comprehensive Agricultural Support Programme (CASP) helps by providing farmers with inputs like fertilisers, tractors, seeds, and feed. We also run the Ilima/Letsema programme to offer additional services. Unfortunately, we are limited by budget constraints when it comes to expanding our extension officer network, but we continue to seek innovative ways to reach more farmers."

Q3: What are your thoughts on the impact of climate change on agriculture, and what steps are being taken to help farmers adapt?

"Climate change is a significant problem in South Africa. This year alone, we've seen severe droughts, black frost, fires, and flooding. We need to help farmers adapt to these challenges by enabling new techniques and crops that are more resilient to climate change. We've introduced the Agro Energy Fund, in collaboration with the Land Bank, to provide farmers with capital to switch to alternative energy sources, helping them move off the grid. Education is crucial here — smaller subsistence farmers are hit hardest viclimate change, as they rely on their crops It's essential that we help them build resilience, adapt their methods, and promote sustainable farming practices. Regenerative farming, for example, works with nature to restore soil health and improve yields while reducing environmental impact."

Q4: What is your message to young people who are interested in pursuing a career in agriculture?

"We need young people to join the agricultural sector. The average age of our farmers is rising, and for many years, the debate over land expropriation without compensation discouraged young people from considering agriculture as a career. That is now behind us, and there are immense opportunities in this sector, especially as we look towards increasing food security in South Africa. We need young farmers to take over as older farmers retire. There is also a great need for veterinarians, with a significant shortage in the public sector, particularly in animal disease control. We've opened a new campus for veterinarians outside Onderstepoort, and we're collaborating with universities to send more graduates into this field. The agricultural sector offers numerous career opportunities, and it's vital that we encourage young people to join."





'n Oproep tot aksie

Thabazimbi – Solidariteit Helpende Hand het onlangs in gesprek met die SAVF in Thabazimbi vasgestel dat daar 'n groot tekort aan goedgekeurde veiligheids- en pleegouers in die dorp is. Dit veroorsaak dat kinders wat dringend sorg en sekuriteit benodig nie altyd in 'n veilige, geborge omgewing geplaas kan word nie, en dit vererger hul trauma en onsekerheid.

Om hierdie tekort uit te wis en die nood van die kinders te verlig, wil Solidariteit Helpende Hand in samewerking met die SAVF Thabazimbi 'n bewusmakingsveldtog in die Thabazimbigemeenskap loods. Ons is bewus daarvan dat die gemeenskap dikwels nie voldoende inligting het oor wat dit behels om 'n pleeg- of veiligheidsouer te wees nie. Ons doel is om die gemeenskap te bemagtig met kennis en 'n beter begrip van hoe hulle 'n veilige toevlug kan bied aan kinders in nood.

Kinders wat uit ouerlike sorg verwyder word, het dikwels ernstige trauma beleef weens fisieke, seksuele en emosionele mishandeling, verwaarlosing, gesinskonflik en geweld, ouers se alkohol- en dwelmmisbruik en onstabiele gesinsomstandighede. Die verwydering van 'n

kind onder die ouderdom van 18 is reeds 'n uiters traumatiese proses, maar wanneer daar onvoldoende veiligheids- en pleegouers beskikbaar is, word die trauma soveel erger. Volgens Belinda Lodewick. die

SAVF Thabazimbi se kantoorbestuurder, is dit noodsaaklik om aan die kinders 'n veilige en liefdevolle omgewing te bied om die negatiewe impak van so 'n verwydering te verminder.

Daar is veral 'n groot behoefte aan goedgekeurde veiligheidsouers en naweekouers vir kinders wat in die koshuis geplaas is. 'n Plek van veiligheid bied korttermynverblyf vir kinders terwyl Kinderhofondersoeke afgehandel word, gewoonlik oor 'n tydperk van minder as ses maande. As gevolg van 'n tekort aan goedgekeurde pleegouers, kan hierdie tydperk egter verleng word en dit is nie in die beste belang van die kind nie.

Gesinne wat as veiligheidsouers wil optree, moet vooraf goedgekeur word en bereid wees om op kort kennisgewing 'n veilige hawe aan kinders te bied. Wanneer 'n kind in lewensgevaar verkeer, moet die verwydering onmiddellik geskied, en 'n goedgekeurde veiligheidsplek is noodsaaklik vir hul beskerming.

In die lig van die toenemende aantal kinders in ons gemeenskap wat pleegsorg benodig, doen ons 'n dringende beroep op die inwoners van Thabazimbi om hul harte en huise oop te maak vir hierdie kwesbare kinders. Deur 'n veilige, liefdevolle huis te bied, kan jy as pleeg-, veiligheids- of naweekouer 'n reuse verskil maak in 'n kind se lewe en 'n fondament vir 'n beter

toekoms skep. Jou liefde kan die grootste geskenk van hierdie Kersseisoen wees.

Gemeenskapslede wat belangstel om meer oor pleeg- of veiligheidsouerskap te leer, kan met die SAVF Thabazimbi in verbinding tree.

Help pleegouers en veiligheidsouers om finansieel te oorleef

Wanneer kinders uit ouerlike sorg verwyder moet word, gaan dit met 'n groot mate van trauma gepaard. Die ontwrigting en trauma wat 'n kind as gevolg van ouerlike onstabiliteit ervaar, is intens en die kind word in baie gevalle van sy of haar kinderlike onskuld ontneem. Die kind se helingsproses om weer stabiliteit en sekuriteit te kan ervaar, is dikwels lank en moeisaam en daarom is intensiewe terapie in die meeste gevalle noodsaaklik.

Agterstande kom ook dikwels voor en hierdie kinders benodig in baie gevalle ekstra ondersteuning soos arbeidsterapie en spraakterapie. Hierdie tipe dienste bring uiteraard ekstra uitgawes mee en plaas finansiële druk op pleegouers.

Future of South Africa's Captive Lions in Question

Plan Sparks Fears of Industry Collapse

SA - The Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment (DFFE) has rolled out a Voluntary Surrender Programme for lion bones and derivatives, igniting a fierce national debate. While some see this as a necessary move to align South Africa's conservation practices with global standards, others warn it could devastate the captive lion industry, with long-lasting consequences for lion populations and livelihoods.

Voluntary Surrender Programme

Under the new initiative, the DFFE will oversee a programme allowing facilities to legally dispose of lion bone stockpiles. Facilities that opt in must:

- Sterilise their lions to prevent further breeding.
- Maintain high welfare standards for lions in their care
- Cease acquiring or accepting new captive
- Obtain the necessary Threatened and Protected Species (TOPS) permits.

Minister Dr. Dion George stated, "This programme balances sustainable use with the need to address ethical and conservation concerns while g51551gn5539.pdf safeguarding jobs for vulnerable individuals."

A Divisive Proposal

dismantle the already struggling captive lion industry, potentially leading to unintended consequences. Without the industry, they claim, captive lions may face neglect or abandonment,

while local communities reliant on lion breeding could suffer severe economic hardship.

Proponents, including conservationists and animal rights groups, contend that the captive lion industry damages South Africa's global reputation and ethical standing. They argue that the surrender programme offers a pathway to phase out an unsustainable and controversial practice while addressing animal welfare concerns.

Industry Perspectives

Those in the lion breeding sector warn that the collapse of the industry could result in:

- Increased pressure on wild lion populations due to illegal poaching.
- The loss of thousands of jobs in rural communities.
- A spike in unregulated activity, as abandoned lions or facilities may fall prey to black-market

Next Steps

The DFFE has stressed that participation in the programme is voluntary and that all information provided will remain confidential. Registration does not bind participants to the programme but allows them to explore exit options.






