HOLDING ONTO DRIVER'S LICENCE FOR A **R1,500 BRIBE**

This traffic cop's car is a familiar sight parked next to the road — but are they enforcing the law or exploiting it?



According to the driver, the officer left in a rush after he was tipped off by someone.

Thabazimbi - The R510 between Sandfontein, Northam, and Thabazimbi has long been a crucial transport route. A driver regularly using this route shared an unsettling experience.

On Friday, 18 February 2025, he was stopped by a traffic officer while en route to Thabazimbi. According to the driver, the officer had an aggressive attitude and falsely claimed that the vehicle was overloaded. "Refusing to discuss the matter, the officer confiscated my driver's licence and demanded a R1,500 bribe for its return", the driver said.

The driver contacted his employer. Recognising the severity of the situation, the driver's employer immediately contacted the police to report the extortion attempt. Reporting back to his employer on what happened next What happened next raises even greater concerns.

Shortly after the report was made, the same traffic officer returned, threw the driver's license at him. and remarked with an air of arrogance, "I hear you want to get me arrested. Here is your driver's license. Get out of here!" before driving off.

Who tipped off the corrupt officer?

The rapid change in the officer's behaviour begs the question: How did he know that the police had been called? Is it standard procedure for corrupt officials to be warned about complaints against them?

How deep does the corruption run?

Coincidentally — or perhaps not — the Thabazimbi Local Municipality issued a press release on 12 March 2025, announcing the temporary closure of the Thabazimbi Licensing Offices. The closure, which will last from Wednesday, 12 March to Monday, 17 March 2025, is due to an ongoing investigation by the Limpopo Department of Transport and Community Safety. According to officials, this step is necessary to ensure a comprehensive review of the system and to uphold the integrity of services.

Platinum Bushvelder reached out to the police for comment, who replied that they will look into the incident.

VAN DER WALT FAMILY STANDS STRONG AS ASSAULT TRIAL NEARS

Thabazimbi - The long-awaited trial of André A community that cares Hoffman, accused of the brutal assault on 32-yearold Leon van der Walt, has been postponed yet 2025, will now proceed on 9 April 2025 for plea and trial. The assault, which took place on 24 September 2024 at a restaurant where Leon worked as a waiter, left him unconscious and severely injured. His recovery has been slow and Christo and Aunt Wendy for their continuous painful, with persistent medical challenges such as brain swelling and debilitating headaches.

Hoffman, who was granted bail at R500 in November 2024, has had multiple delays in his legal proceedings. His attorney previously requested a postponement due to financial constraints, as Hoffman faces another legal matter in February 2025. Now, after yet another delay, the Van Der Walt family must wait even longer for justice to take its course

Despite the frustration and setbacks, the Van Der Walt family remains strong, bolstered by again. The case, originally scheduled for 7 March unwavering community support. Monique van der Walt, speaking on behalf of the family, expressed deep gratitude to those who have stood by them during this trying time.

"We want to extend our heartfelt thanks to Uncle support at every court appearance. Their words of encouragement and emotional strength have carried us through the toughest days," Monique

was praised for their understanding and support throughout this difficult period.

"A special thank you to our families for their support. Your love and strength mean the world to us," Monique added.

While the family is eager for justice, they acknowledge that the legal process is slow and often frustrating. "We are holding onto hope," Monique stated. "This case means everything to us. It's been an incredibly rough journey, but we won't give up."

As the trial date approaches, the Van Der Walt family remains determined, leaning on the strength of their community and the resilience they have built over months of struggle.

Thabazimbi - On Sunday, 9 March 2025, at approximately 14:15, Thaba Fire and Rescue (TFR) received an urgent call for assistance in a mountain rescue operation, about 165km from Thabazimbi on the

Demonstrating their unwavering commitment to saving lives, the TFR team and Wildmed Emergency Services swiftly loaded their specialised equipment within 30 minutes and arrived on the scene at 16:30.

Tragically, upon arrival, responders confirmed that the patient — a woman who had been hiking with her daughter and granddaughter — was deceased due to injuries sustained from a fall. Despite the heartbreaking outcome, the rescue teams worked diligently to recover her body, completing the operation by 20:00. The TFR and Wildmed Emergency Services teams returned to Thabazimbi at 22h40.

The woman had been hiking along a narrow ledge in the mountains when she slipped and fell. Her daughter quickly contacted emergency services, leading to the swift mobilisation of multiple rescue teams. Initial

attempts to conduct an airlift were hindered by the difficult terrain, forcing the teams to deploy rope rescue techniques instead.

The successful recovery mission was made possible by the coordinated efforts of multiple agencies: Thaba Fire and Rescue, Wildmed Emergency Services, EMS Waterberg, Mogalakwena Search and Rescue, Lephalale SAPS, as well as local community members. This response effort once again highlights the dedication of Thaba Fire and Rescue, proving that their assistance extends far beyond Thabazimbi whenever and wherever they are needed. A heartfelt thank you to Wildmed Emergency Services for generously providing their equipment – your support is truly appreciated!

Pierre Loots, CEO of Thaba Fire and Rescue, expressed his condolences: "Our hearts go out to the family of the deceased. It's never easy facing a tragedy like this, but we take comfort in knowing that we could bring her home with dignity. This rescue effort was a testament to teamwork, dedication, and the resilience of our emergency responders."




