Thabazimbi Archers Shine at World Bowhunter Championship

Thabazimbi – Archers from across the globe took aim in a test of grit, precision, and perseverance at the 2025 World Bowhunter Championship (WBHC), held from 29 April to 2 May 2025 at the scenic but rain-soaked Elgro River Lodge in Potchefstroom. Among the 450 participants from 27 countries, Thabazimbi's own archery club made South Africa beam with pride. Despite wet and challenging terrain, the Thabazimbi Boogklub delivered outstanding results. Local legend Gert Snyman not only clinched a gold medal, but also broke two world records – an incredible feat in a discipline where distances are unknown and the pressure is high. Snyman also serves as the President of SANIFAA (South African National Indoor and Field Archery Association) and played a major role in designing the championship's intricate four-track layout. HJ Swanepoel achieved a fantastic 4th place finish in the Adult Male Freestyle division, while young AJ Swanepoel showed immense promise, taking 5th in the Junior Male Bowhunter Unlimited.

Hennie van Staden and son Werdie (Lephalale) secured two golds between them, proving that archery talent runs in the family. Former club members also made their mark: Gary Bauer earned

bronze in Veteran Male Freestyle Unlimited, and Bianca Coetzee (Kleynhans), a former coach and teacher, missed the gold by just two points, claiming bronze in her category.

Adding to the celebration, several club members were awarded Protea colours, marking their dedication and excellence in the sport:

- Gert Snyman
- HJ Swanepoel
- Gary Bauer and Bianca Coetzee (ex-members)

The South African Protea team, composed of archers across disciplines — from traditional bows to high-tech freestyle gear — earned podium spots in almost every category. Their diversity and unity stood as a proud reflection of the country they represent.

Despite the mud and rain, the event was hailed a huge success thanks to the tireless efforts of volunteers and organisers, especially the team from Elgro River Lodge. Safety, logistics, and the unique challenge of river crossings (some tackled by rubber duck!) added to the adventure.

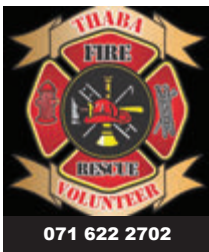


Tragic Collision in Koedoeskop Claims One Life

Koedoeskop – A quiet Sunday evening turned tragic when a collision between two Volkswagen vehicles occurred on 4 May 2025 at approximately 18h20 in Koedoeskop. According to Angelique Loots, director of Thaba Fire and Rescue, both vehicles — a VW and a Volkswagen City Golf — were struck on their left sides. The exact cause of the accident is still under investigation.

Thaba Fire and Rescue, Wildmed Emergency Services, Eagle Trauma Rescue, SAPS, PK Towing, and the Thabazimbi Local Municipality all responded swiftly to the scene.

One vehicle had two occupants who sustained injuries but were reported to be in a stable condition. Tragically, the other vehicle's sole occupant succumbed to their injuries on scene. "We extend our heartfelt condolences to the loved ones of the deceased," said Loots.

Flipped but Fortunate

Thabazimbi – A single-vehicle accident took place on Sunday morning, 4 May 2025, around 09h00 on the R510 near Ben Alberts. A Volkswagen overturned, landing on its roof. Miraculously, all five occupants sustained only minor injuries.

The cause of the accident remains unknown at this stage. However, emergency teams responded swiftly to the scene.

Thaba Fire and Rescue, Thabazimbi Local Municipality officials, Trauma Rescue, the South African Police Service, and PK Towing were all present, ensuring the safety and support of those involved.

"We're grateful there were no serious injuries. This could have ended very differently," said Angelique Loots, director of Thaba Fire and Rescue.

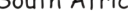

Leon's trial delayed again



Still standing strong – Monique and Leon van der Walt continue to show courage, despite ongoing court delays in the case against his alleged attacker.

Thabazimbi – Justice continues to inch forward for Leon van der Walt, who was brutally assaulted in September last year. On Tuesday, 7 May 2025, the case against the accused, Andrew Wynand Hoffman, was again postponed — this time to 26 June 2025 — for disclosure. Disclosure is the legal process where the State must provide the defence with all evidence in the case, including witness statements, reports, and any documents it intends to use during the trial. The Van der Walt family — Leon and his wife Monique — have shown extraordinary resilience throughout the drawn-out proceedings. The couple remains steadfast in their pursuit of justice, despite a series of frustrating delays. This postponement follows a previous setback in April when Hoffman's attorney withdrew from the case. At that time, the court gave a final warning against further stalling. Now, with the disclosure process underway, the long-awaited trial appears to be slowly approaching. The community continues to stand behind Leon and Monique, inspired by their strength and patience as they wait for justice to be served.
