“If it weren't for the incredible support from the public and our sponsors, we wouldn't have made it this far,” added Loots. “From the bottom of our hearts — thank you.”

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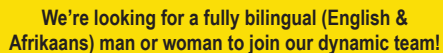

- On 15 July 2025, Dr George announced the imminent publication of a Lion Prohibition Notice, aimed at banning the establishment of new captive-breeding facilities.
- This follows recommendations from the Ministerial Task Team and aligns with updated Threatened or Protected Species (TOPS) Regulations under NEM:BA.
- The Notice has already passed the 30-day parliamentary window and is awaiting executive approval.
- Provincial MECs are now being engaged to facilitate implementation, with the minister planning further stakeholder announcements at upcoming forums like the G20 climate meeting in Kruger National Park.

or trophy hunting are separate from wild populations and do not contribute to wildlion conservation.

Economic arguments are also prominent: Hannes Wessels, of the Predator Breeder's Association, asserts the industry supports 8,000 jobs and supplies crucial rural income. He warns that closing the industry with no transition plan could devastate local economies. Meanwhile, animal welfare and conservation groups strongly favour the ban: World Animal Protection points to 8,000–12,000 captive lions across more than 300 facilities, many confined for canned hunts or used in the lionbone trade, posing serious welfare and conservation risks.

Earlier pledges dating back to 2021 promised to phase out the captive lion industry, but critics say enforcement has lagged. As of today, South Africa holds the world's largest captive-bred lion population.

Thabazimbi – In just seven months, Thaba Fire and Rescue has transformed into a stronger, more capable emergency service – thanks to tireless dedication, community support, and a shared commitment to saving lives.

"We've grown a lot over the past 6 to 7 months, and I'm very proud," said Pierre Loots, director at Thaba Fire and Rescue. "It wouldn't have been possible without the incredible support of our sponsors and the local public. The journey began in April, when six members successfully completed a Basic Grass and Wildland Firefighting course – a crucial step in tackling veld fires that threaten both people and the environment. In March, five team members were sent for the IC Type 5 (Initial Response Accident Commander) course – and all five passed with flying colours. "It's these kinds of qualifications that strengthen our ability to act fast and lead when every second counts," Loots noted. May saw the success of the now well-known "Vuurfees", a community-driven fire festival that raised awareness and rallied support for local firefighting efforts.

Most recently, in July, Thaba Fire and Rescue sent 11 members, along with one WildMed colleague, to complete a Trauma and Crime Scene Cleanup course – and once again, all participants passed. These skills are vital for handling sensitive incidents with professionalism and care. And then, on Wednesday, 30 July, the team received a truly game-changing gift: a firefighting truck donated by the Waterberg District Municipality.

Thabazimbi – At approximately 19:40 on Sunday evening, 3 August 2025, a serious collision involving two cars and a truck occurred on the R511 (Brits road), roughly 30 kilometres outside Thabazimbi.

The cause of the accident remains unknown at this stage. Emergency services were quick to respond, with Thaba Fire & Rescue arriving on scene alongside the Northam Platinum Fire Team, Provincial Ambulance Services, and the Traffic Department. Only three people sustained very light injuries — a relief considering the severity such multi-vehicle collisions often carry. “We’re grateful that everyone walked away with minor injuries,” said Pierre Loots, director of Thaba Fire and Rescue. “As always, we thank our team and all supporting services who worked efficiently under pressure.”

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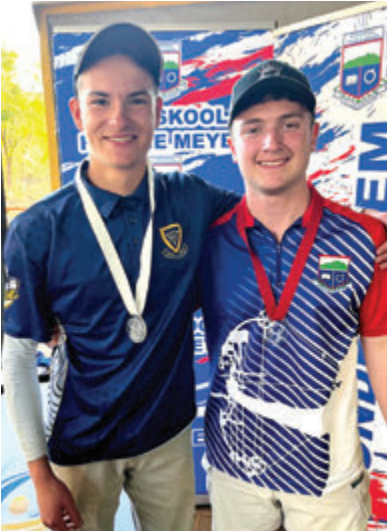
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Bulls-Eyes, Bushveld & Big Dreams!

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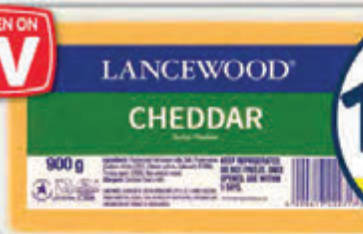
