Thabazimbi - With temperatures climbing, snake season has arrived in the Bushveld - and it's already proving to be an active one. Residents are urged to be vigilant, cautious, and above all, not to attempt handling snakes themselves.

"It's summertime, and we need to be vigilant - it's snake season," said Pierre Loots, director of Thaba Fire & Rescue. "This year, we're already seeing many mambas and puff adders so early in the season, which could become a real challenge."

Snake experts remind residents that these reptiles play an important role in balancing nature by controlling rodent populations. However, their presence also brings danger. In the Thabazimbi area, highly venomous snakes such as the black mamba, Mozambique spitting cobra, and puff adder are a reality. Their bites can be fatal if not treated swiftly.

Despite their fearsome reputation, snakes are not naturally aggressive – most will avoid confrontation if given the chance. Problems arise when snakes are cornered or when untrained people attempt to catch or kill them.

#### **!! SNAKE WARNING !!**

With the temperature rising, more snakes are starting to come out. Please be careful and be on the lookout for snakes. Do not try to kill or catch the snake - call the snake catchers.

Local rescuers and snake handlers, including Thaba Fire & Rescue and WildMed Emergency Services, are on call to assist when needed. "Let the experts handle them," Loots stressed.

As summer unfolds, residents are urged to stay alert, keep yards tidy to reduce hiding spots, and teach children to respect wildlife from a safe distance. In the words of one snake handler: "If you see a snake, don't panic - step back, give it space, and call for help."

### **Child Assault Trial Pushed to** September 22

Thabazimbi - The long-running child assault trial involving Ria Oberholzer, Petrus Oelofse, and Jesica Hull has once again been postponed. The case, already marked by repeated delays, will

now only continue on 22 September 2025. Earlier this month, proceedings stalled when Oelofse was reportedly too ill to attend court, forcing another reschedule. The accused — who face charges ranging from child neglect to sexual assault — remain out

on bail as the matter drags on in the Thabazimbi Magistrates' Court. The trio has been appearing since March 2024, when the charges were first laid. In June 2025, the trial was delayed to accommodate special assistive devices for a hearing-impaired witness, adding to the

Oelofse faces charges of sexual assault and child neglect, while Oberholzer and Hull are charged with child neglect and assault with intent to cause grievous bodily harm.



Kransberg to spread Wildsplaas before shifting back again with the changing winds.

At this stage, it remains unclear many how hectares have been reduced to ash. What is certain, however, is that the fire has now entered its second week without being contained.

"The fire has been raging without pause for more than a week now," said

on Tuesday, 9 September 2025. "High in the mountains it still burns fiercely, showing no signs of slowing."

#### **DIFFICULT TO ACCESS**

The blaze is tearing through rugged terrain where there are no roads, making direct firefighting nearly impossible. Currently, the fire is moving east towards Thabazimbi, burning dangerously close to Eskom's transmission powerlines.

"In the mountains, all we can do is watch and wait." Prinsloo explained. "Only when the fire moves down into more accessible areas can we actively

Authorities warn that strong winds could force the fire to change direction at any moment - running parallel to the powerlines towards Makoppa and Oom Hennie Briel's property, or back towards Kransberg, the same area devastated by fires two years ago.

### General background information

SIOC-CDT was established in 2006 by Sishen Iron Ore Company (Pty) Ltd to implement Northern Cape (JTG District and Tsantabane Local Municipality) and Limpopo province (Thabazimbi Local Municipality. The vision of SIOC-CDT is to ensure that ben have sustainable income and are empowered to thrive beyond the lifespan of the mine



A Community Representative Trustee shall be elected by community members and appointed to the SIOC-CDT Board of Trustees to represent the Thabazimbi beneficiary community.

### Who can be a SIOC-CDT Trustee?

- Any person who has not been disqualified under TPCA s6(1A), NPO Act s25A, or Companies Act s69
- Section 20(2) of the Trust Property Control Act, 1988 (Act 57 of 1988) stipulates that a trustee should be a person who has never been:
- x convicted of any offence of dishonesty or sentenced to prison without an option of a fine
- x sequestrated or liquidated or placed under judicial management x removed from officeinrespecttoanyappointmentasatrustee
- declared with a mental health disability or incapacitated
- In addition, the SIOC-CDT trust deed specifies the following criteria. A person does not qualify to be appointed as a trustee if they are:
- over 70 years of age
- working for government or parliament in any capacity
- The nominated person must:
- have a minimum of Grade 12 qualification reside within the municipal jurisdiction for which you are nominated

NB: Only female candidates are permitted to stand for nomination in these elections


