Thabazimbi - A Saturday afternoon fire on 13 September managed to save a card machine, one speaker, and a tablet. 2025 reduced the well-known Neon Moon entertainment venue to rubble, leaving only charred walls and bitter memories behind. Thaba Fire & Rescue, supported by Northam Platinum Zondereinde's fire team, Thabazimbi Local Municipality's Waterberg Fire Unit, Wilmed Emergency Services, and SAPS, fought the blaze for several hours. Despite their efforts, the building was completely gutted. Thankfully, no injuries were

The fire reportedly started just after 12:00, first smouldering and then erupting into full flames around half an hour later. While the official cause has not yet been confirmed, suspicions include a cigarette discarded near the grass-roofed section at the back of the property.

#### **Loss Beyond the Walls**

For owners and tenants, the destruction is devastating. Mandrazelle Jordaan, who owns the building, says it carried deep personal value: "My late father bought this property over 30 years ago. Much of his belongings, which can never be replaced, were lost in the fire.'

Tenant Hetta Nortier, owner of Neon Moon, explained that the venue lost everything from pool tables, sound systems, and stock, to treasured wedding décor and family photos. "We

The rest is gone," she said. Eleven families who depended on the venue for work are now without an income.

Two residential flats behind the premises were also destroyed, leaving tenants, including Ruben Nortier, with nothing but the clothes on their backs.

#### **Community Reactions**

On social media, reactions were split. Some residents expressed relief, complaining about noise, and late-night parties. Others mourned the loss of what they described as a "beautiful family-friendly venue".

#### **Thank You to First Responders**

Thaba Fire & Rescue director Angelique Loots thanked all who assisted: "From our teams on the roof to community members bringing water, everyone did their part. A special thanks to Northam Platinum Zondereinde's fire team!"

#### **An Uncertain Future**

Rebuilding is complicated. With no insurance and the property tied up in a family estate, there are no immediate plans to restore the building. Both Jordaan and Nortier stressed that their priority now is finding alternative employment opportunities.

#### **R2 Million Dagga and Codeine Bust on R510**





Forty tightly packed bales of dagga, worth an estimated R1.5

Thabazimbi - A major drug bust has put two foreign nationals behind bars after they were caught with a truckload of dagga and codeinebased medicines on the R510 near Lephalale.

On Saturday, 13 September 2025, members of Northam SAPS. Thabazimbi SAPS, and Zimbi Security swooped in on the vehicle following a tip-off. Their swift action uncovered 40 bales of Swazi dagga valued at R1.5 million, along with assorted codeine-based medicines and painkillers worth an estimated R500.000.

The suspects, identified as Cuthbert Derera (30) and Wishborn Fufa (39), were unable to account for the origin of the illicit goods. Both men were arrested on the spot and detained at Thabazimbi SAPS.

They made their first court appearance at the Thabazimbi Magistrates' Court on Monday, 15 September 2025, facing charges of possession of dagga and contravention of the Medicines and Related Substances Act. The case has been postponed to 22 September 2025 for a formal

#### **R510 ROAD A DANGER ZONE** - BUT SANRAL RESPONDS

Thabazimbi/ Northam - The R510 SANRAL's response between Thabazimbi and Northam has once again come under fire, with residents and road safety advocates raising concerns about its hazardous condition. As Platinum Bushvelder reported at the end of August 2025, a total of 38 accidents were recorded between July and August this year on this road. Motorists have pointed to potholes, a lack of shoulders, and inadequate road signage as the main culprits. The busy road carries heavy traffic daily, including community members, mining vehicles, and transport trucks making its safety a matter of urgency. In a press release on 4 September 2025, André Moss, Limpopo provincial leader for the VF Plus, said: "The R510 poses a serious threat to public safety. The fact that the contractor abandoned the project in November 2024, leaving the road in an unsafe condition, is unacceptable. Questions must also be asked about how the same contractor was awarded a new project elsewhere in the district despite failing to complete this one.

Following mounting pressure, the South African National Roads Agency (SANRAL) provided clarity on the status of the R510 project:

- the project stopped: SANRAL confirmed that the original budget was depleted, and the project was brought to an early close in November 2024. Additional expenditure required approval before new work could proceed.
- **Next steps:** A new procurement process is underway to appoint a replacement contractor. This will be finalised within
