SAPS Cripples Violent Syndicate

SEVEN SUSPECTS DOWN

Northam/ Rustenburg – A high-risk, intelligence-driven operation between SAPS Limpopo and SAPS North West has delivered a major blow to organised crime in the region, with seven notorious suspects arrested and an arsenal of heavy weaponry seized.

The takedown followed a fatal business robbery on Wednesday, 12 November 2025, during which a victim tragically lost their life. Rapid intelligence work linked the crime scene to a white Toyota Fortuner used by a syndicate long feared across Northam, Mogwase, and surrounding communities. Police traced and intercepted the vehicle near a local school in Northam, arresting the driver on the spot. Further questioning led investigators to Rethabile Village, where additional suspects were cornered and detained.

The multidisciplinary team involved Northam CIS, Rustenburg TRT, Mogwase CIS, Mogwase Vispol, and Northam Rural Safety — working swiftly and in coordinated precision.

What followed was a significant haul of illegal weapons and stolen goods. The police recovered:

- 1 x AK-47 rifle
- 2 x 9mm pistols (serial numbers removed, one belonging to SAPS)
- 36 magazines (AK-47 and 9mm)
- 70 x AK-47 rounds (7.62x39mm)
- 110 x 9mm cartridges
- Balaclavas, gloves, clothing used in robberies
- Stolen electronics and cigarettes
- Multiple cellphones and Toyota vehicle keys
- A Toyota Fortuner used in the robberies
- A stolen Toyota Tazz, abandoned at Smashblock sports ground

Provincial commissioner lieutenant general Thembi Hadebe praised the operation. All seven suspects — six men and one woman, aged 31 to 49 — will appear in court soon.

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No, Kruger National Park Is *Not* Being Renamed

SA – Rumours have been circulating wildly online about an alleged name change for the world-famous Kruger National Park — but the Department of Forestry, Fisheries and the Environment has stepped in to shut them down firmly. In a media statement issued, the Department confirmed that no name change has been authorised, no amendment has been made under the National Environmental Management: Protected Areas Act, and no notice has been issued in the Government Gazette. The park’s legal and official name remains Kruger National Park. Minister Dr Dion George was unequivocal: “There is nothing in progress to change the name of the Kruger National Park and I certainly have no intention of approving any request.” The Department emphasised that only the Minister has the legal authority to change the name of a national park, and such a process would require formal public participation and official publication — none of which has taken place. Officials further warned that spreading unverified claims fuels confusion and undermines public trust. South Africans are urged to rely on official government communication rather than social media speculation. As one of the country’s most treasured conservation areas — and a global tourism icon — the Kruger National Park remains exactly what it has always been: Kruger National Park.

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Bushveld 400 Set to Crown SA's 2025 Rally-Raid Champion

Thabazimbi/ Koedoeskop — It's the finale everyone's been waiting for. The sixth and last round of the 2025 SA Rally-Raid Championship will roar to life on 21 and 22 November at Koedoeskop School – and with only three points separating the frontrunners, the Northam Zondereinde Bushveld 400 promises one of the closest title fights in years.

Rally-Raid CEO Archie Rutherford says the season has been “razor-tight,” with races decided by mere seconds. All eyes are now on Toyota’s rising star Saood Variawa, Ford’s seasoned campaigner Gareth Wooldridge, and SA rally legend Giniel de Villiers, who still has an outside shot at the crown. The Bushveld 400 route will test every skill: narrow, winding tracks, dense vegetation, and scorching temperatures expected to climb into the 40s. Race director Evan Hutchison says drivers will need sharp navigation, cooler heads, and clever strategy. “One mistake could end a championship,” he warns.

A special highlight this year is the return to Koedoeskop after floods prevented the event earlier in the season – and the introduction of a brand-new spectator zone just 5km from the school, complete with shade, toilets, and multiple viewing points.

Event sponsor Northam Zondereinde says the partnership goes beyond racing. "This event brings communities together and stimulates real economic activity," says general manager: projects Danny Gonsalves. "It's about unity, upliftment, and shared value."

With the championship on the line, fans can expect drama, dust, and world-class racing. Those unable to attend can follow every split and update live on the RallySafe app.

On 22 November, South Africa will know its 2025 Rally-Raid Champion. Until then – it's anyone's race.

Application for Trial Release of Genetically Modified Organisms

The aim of the proposed trial release is to assess the tolerance of MON 80616 maize to PPO-inhibiting herbicides. MON 80616 maize was developed through *Agrobacterium*-mediated transformation of maize tissue. MON 80616 maize contains a PPO gene (*H_N90 PPO*) from *Enterobacter cloacae* that expresses a PPO protein that is insensitive to PPO-inhibiting herbicides and thus confers tolerance to these herbicides.

MON 80616 trial sites will be representative of the maize-growing regions of South Africa, situated on working farms in the following areas: Lichtenburg (North West), Groblersdal and Thabazimbi (Limpopo), Weenen (KwaZulu-Natal), Delmas (Mpumalanga), Heidelberg (Gauteng), Orania (Northern Cape), Bothaville and Bultfontein (Free State). The trial sites will encompass less than 1 ha and the environment immediately surrounding the sites may include other cultivated crops such as soybean, maize and sunflowers, as well as pastures and/or natural vegetation. Effective isolation measures will be implemented, and the sites will be strictly managed to prevent dissemination and unauthorised entry. All permit conditions will be stringently adhered to.

Genetically modified crops enable farmers to address multiple agronomic problems under complex farming conditions, by offering flexibility, simplicity, and cost-effective weed and insect control options. Extensive safety studies and multidisciplinary risk assessments provide science-based evidence that GM crops are safe and offer benefits to farmers. To date, numerous biotechnology-derived crops have been approved for food, feed, processing, and cultivation in South Africa.
